Suspensions Comparative Report – Explanations & Documentation

Definition of suspension: For the purpose of this report, a suspension is defined as –

- Any discipline record that conforms to one of the state CDE reason codes of 1 thru 24 and does NOT have a disposition code indicating Expulsion

In addition:

- Suspension record must include a viable District ID number for the student
- Suspension record must include a valid 3-digit AERIES School Code

Only suspension records that have an actual incident date from between the 2 dates mentioned at the page top in one of the 2 school years of 07-08 and 08-09 were included.

All records duplicated in the Student Information System due to a student's moving to a new school have been excluded.

Columns 5 – 12: Counts in columns 5 – 12 are distinct students. A student is only counted once irregardless of how many suspensions he/she received

Columns 13 – 19: Counts in columns 13 – 19 are of suspension incidents, not distinct students

Data Source: All suspension information is the result of data inputted by each school site into AERIES in either 08-09 or 09-10. Any corrections in 08-09 data need to be implemented by the site itself in the suspension record in question in AERIES.

Student Population Counts: Population counts for 08-09 are calculated per school information from the end of year in June. Counts for 09-10 are from current student counts.

Counts for Defiance & Fighting: Counts of suspensions involving these issues were performed per CDE Suspension Codes –

- Defiance was counted on all CDE codes of "06"
 - Fighting was counted on all CDE codes of "10", "11", & "20"
- Suspensions were counted under these codes per the *first and primary reason* code entered into AERIES for the incident. All secondary reason codes were not taken into account due to the need to count each suspension only once.

To insure each suspension is counted only once, only the first (primary) reason code for each incident is counted.

ADA \$ Loss: Based on figure of \$32.17 per day. Computed using suspension number of days inputted into AERIES.
