 (i) Mathematics.

 (ii) Science.

 (iii) History-social science.

 (iv) English language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program; and consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board [of education] for foreign language or health course(s). And sufficiency of laboratory science equipment ... applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive. aligned to the content standards adopted

Parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders are urged to participate in the hearing.
