

ADOPTION OF DEVELOPER JUSTIFICATION
STUDY AND FEES

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on Wednesday, February 13, 2013, at 6:15 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in The Great Room, LaEscuelita Education Center, 1050 2nd Avenue, Oakland, CA 94606-2212, the Governing Board of the District will hold a public hearing to consider the adoption of a Resolution to approve the School Facility Fee Justification Report for Residential, Commercial and Industrial Development Projects ("Study") prepared by School Facility Consultants for the District, and approve collecting Level One Statutory Fees on development projects within the boundaries of the District for the purpose of funding the construction or reconstruction of school facilities pursuant to Education Code section 17620. This fee will apply to new commercial and industrial construction, to new residential construction, and, to the extent of increases in assessable space, to other residential construction as provided by law.

Any interested party may make an oral or written presentation at the Public Hearing.
