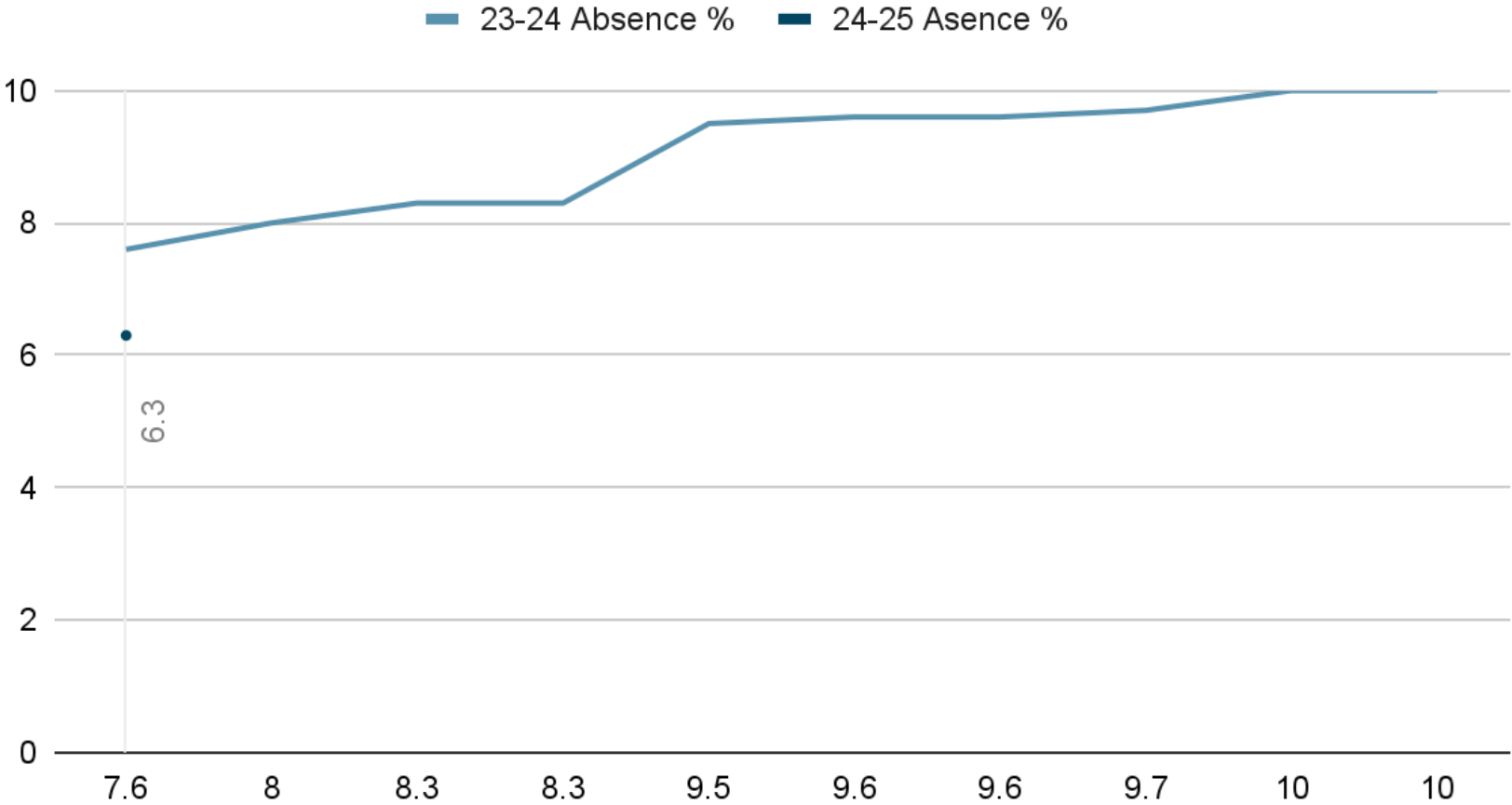

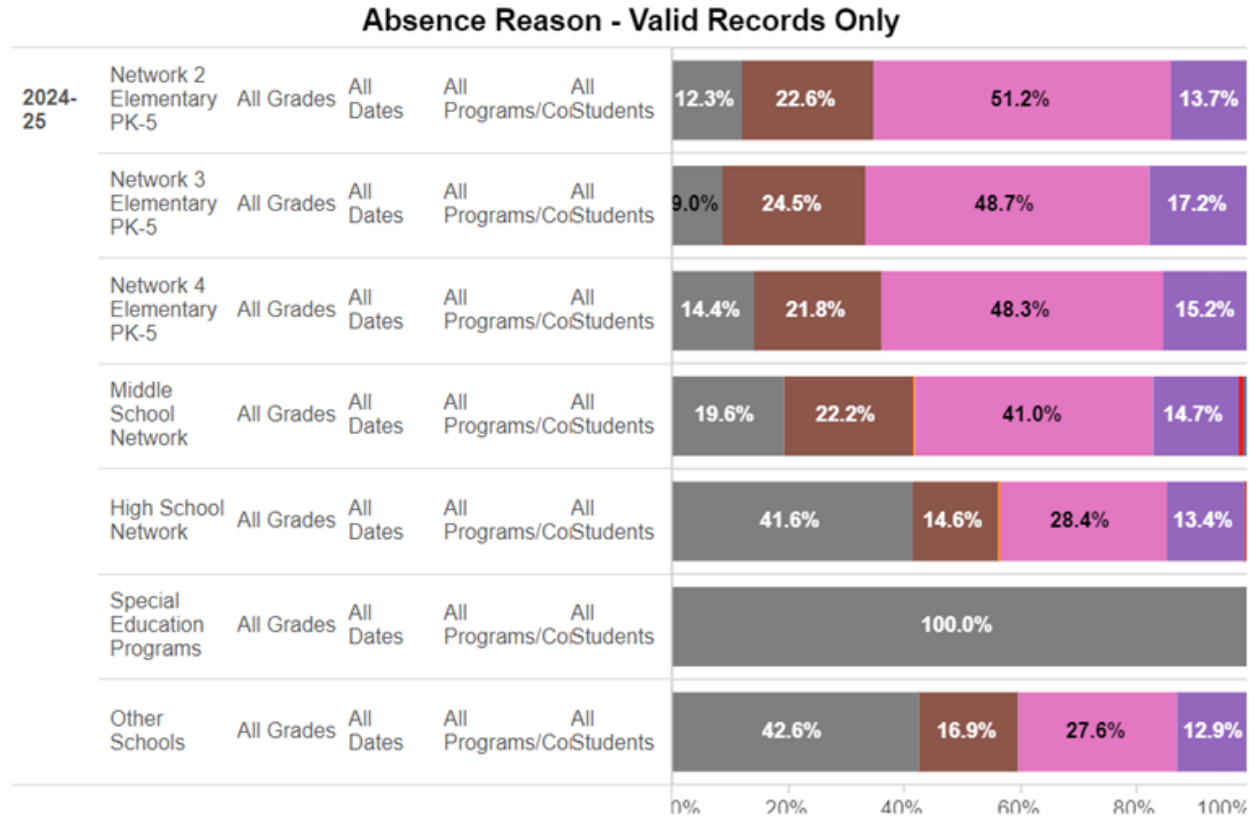

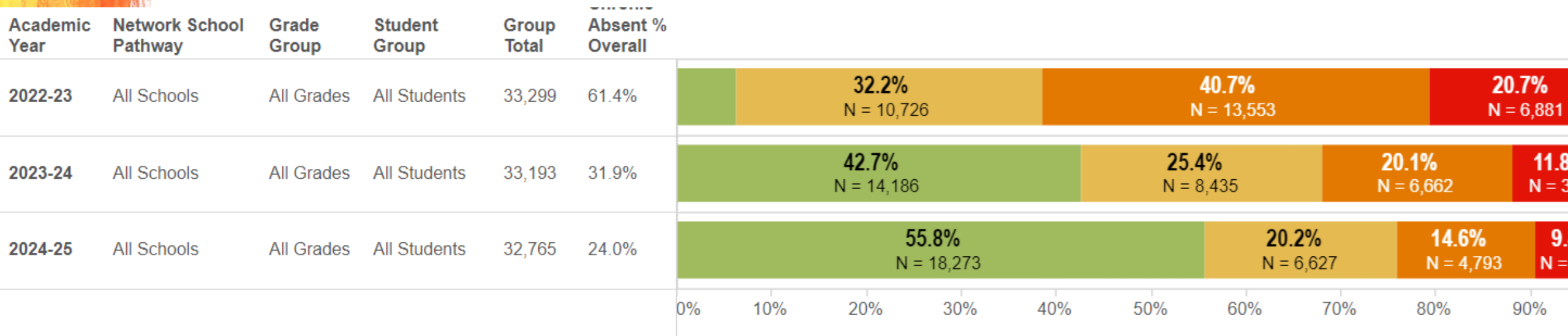

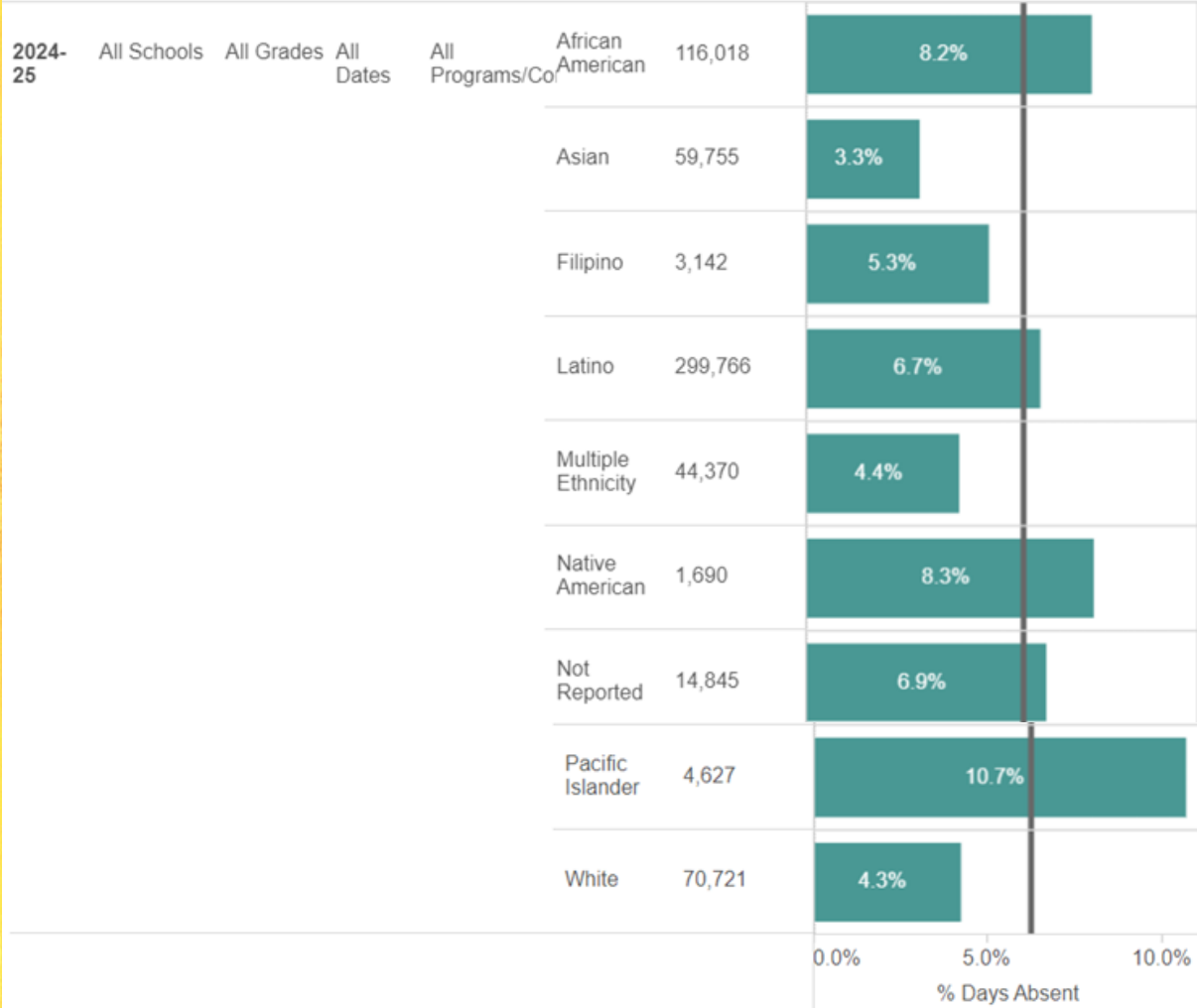


Absence Rate by Ethnicity

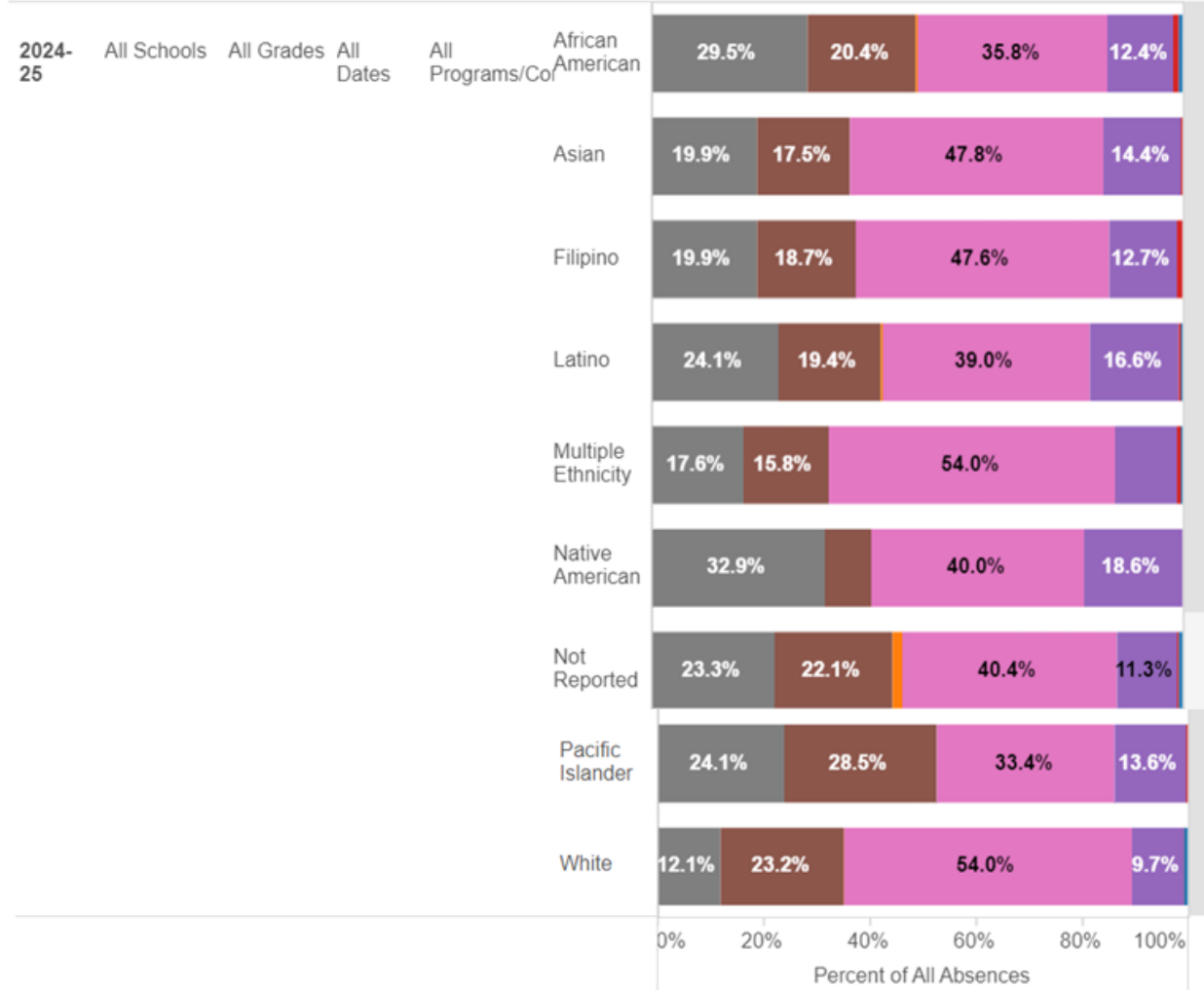

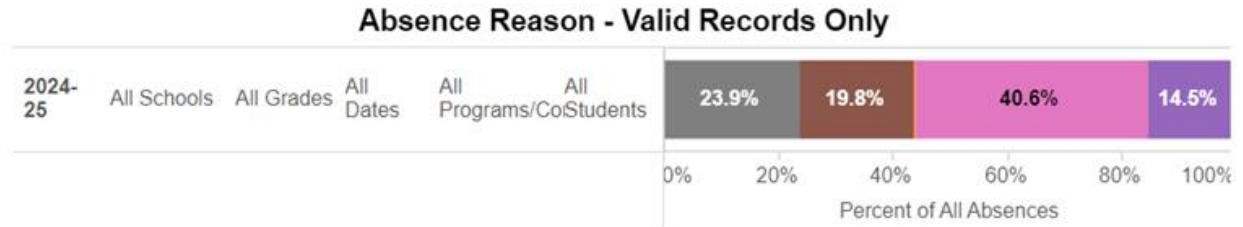

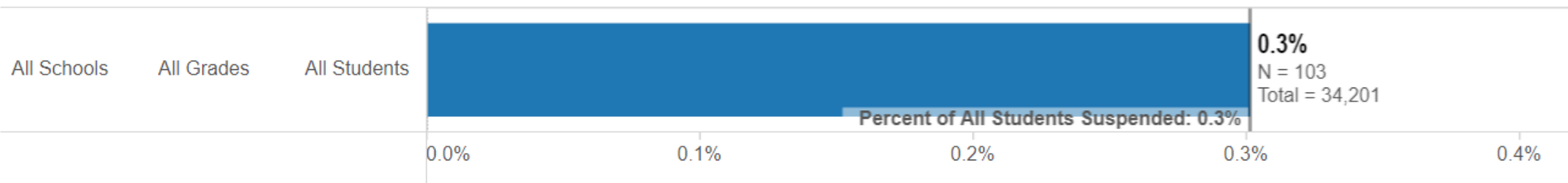

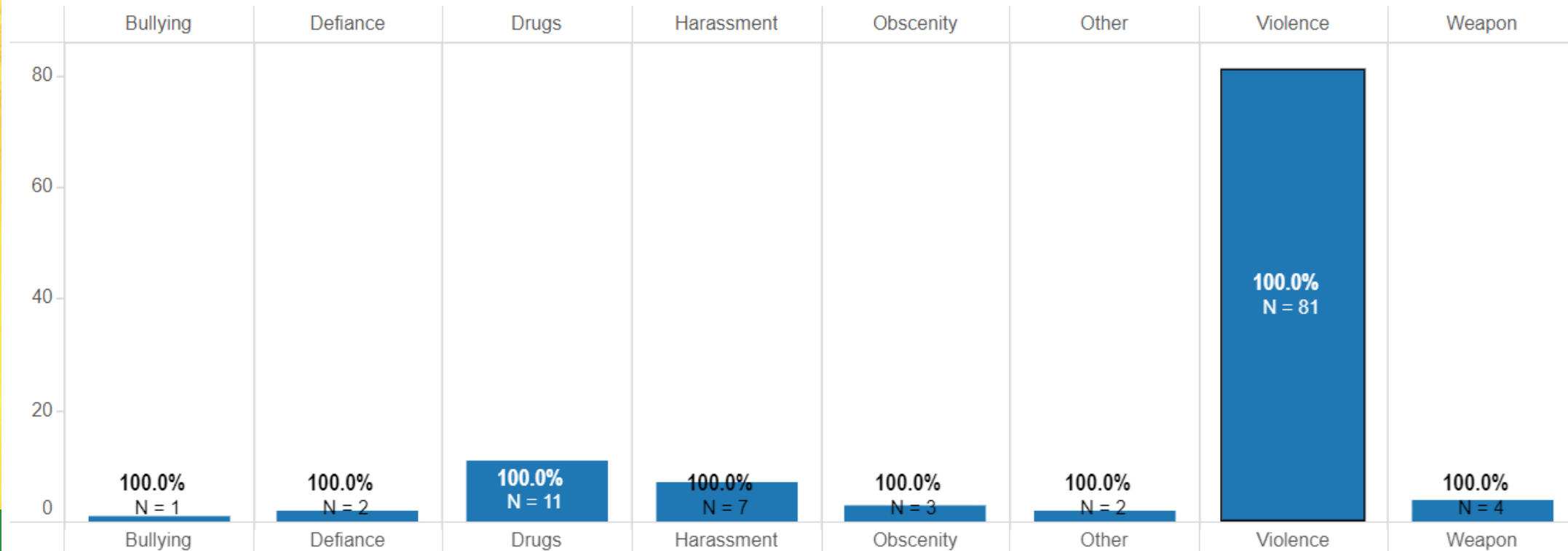

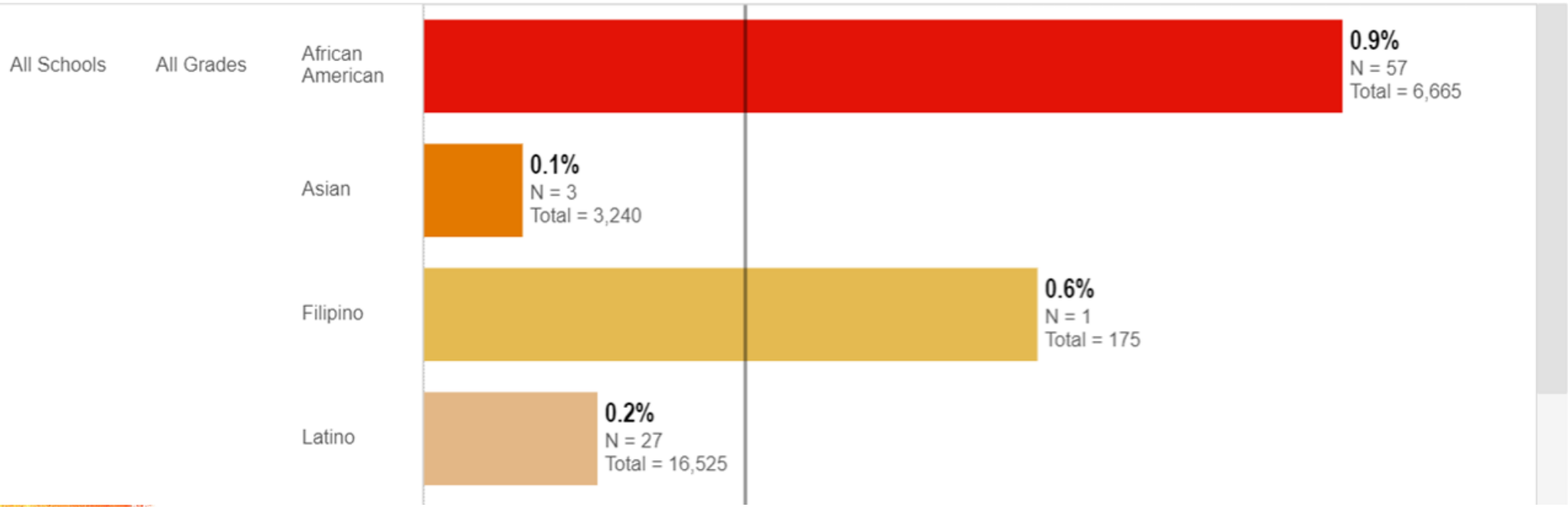

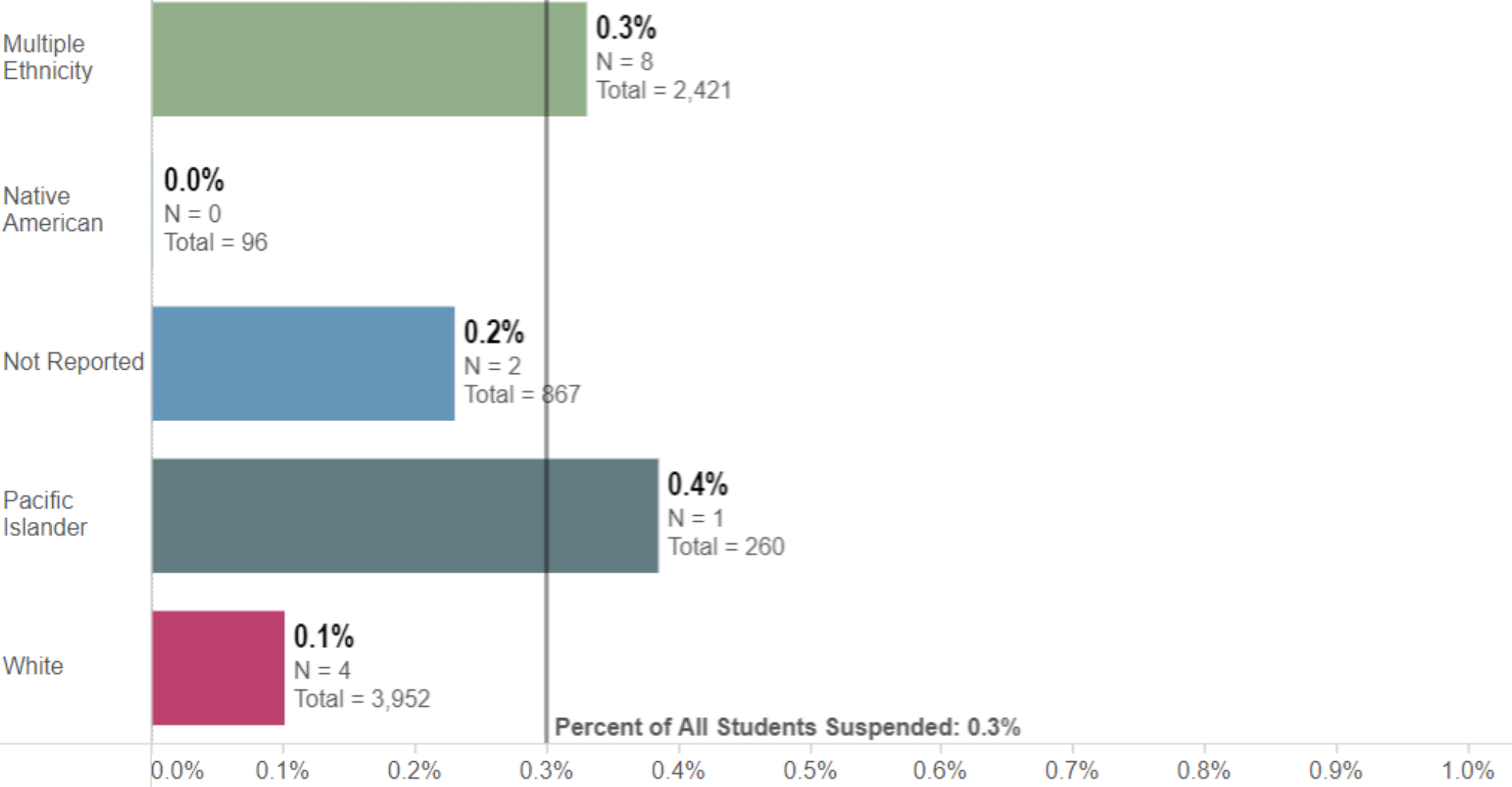

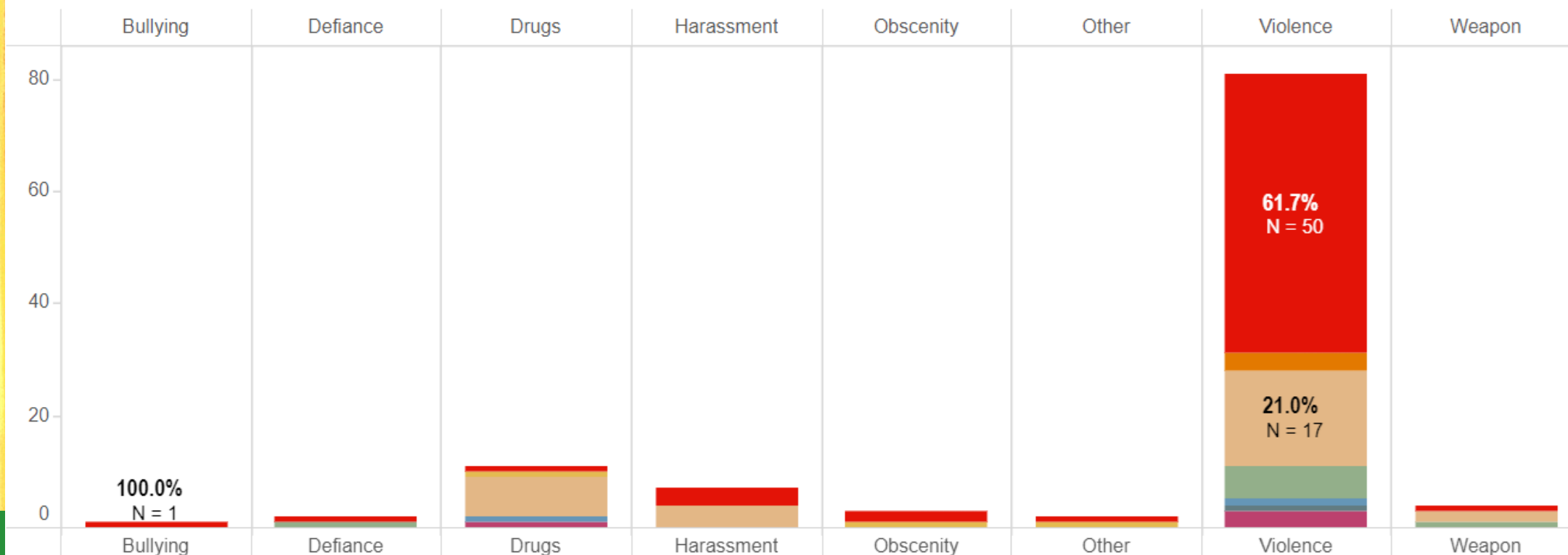

OSS at All Schools for All Grades: Percent and Number of Incidents by Offense Class

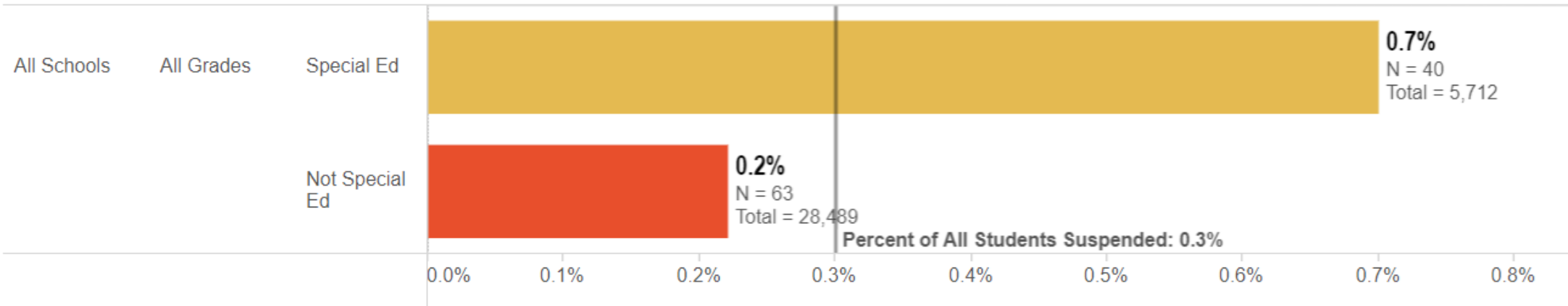

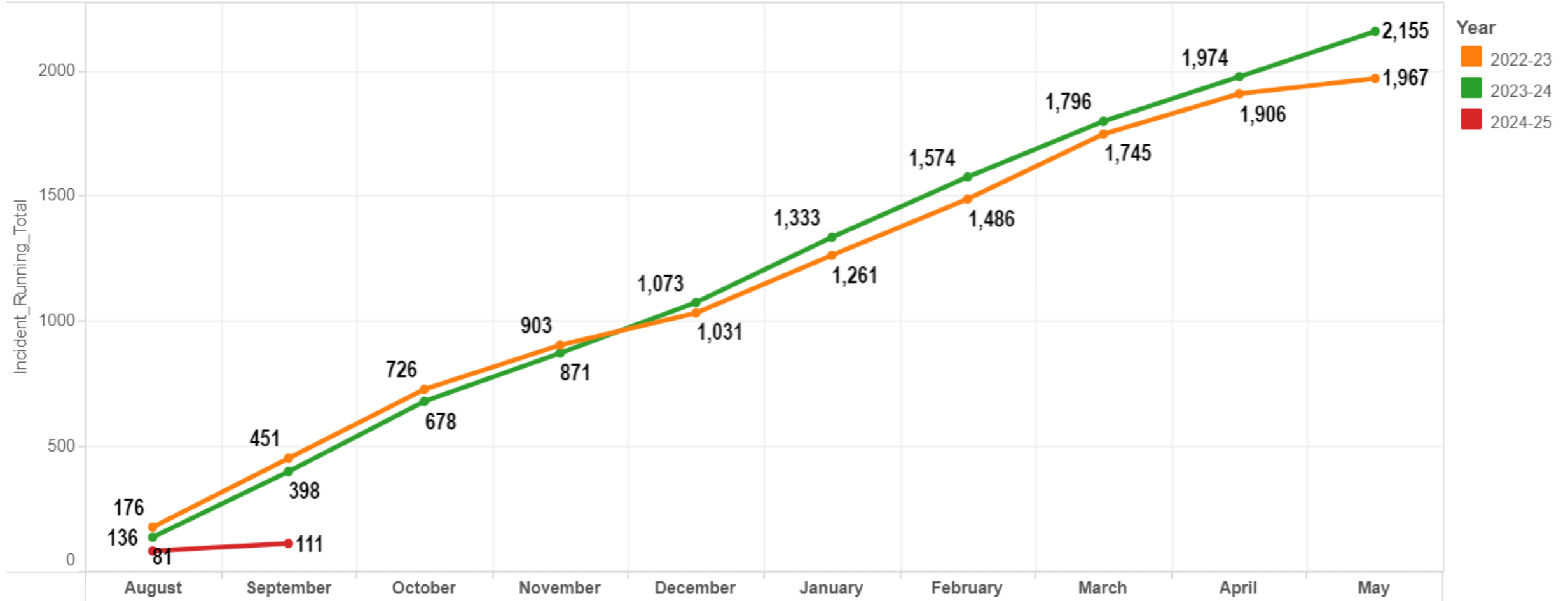
