**Ask of the Board** Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2425-0051 - Local Assignment Option Permit – California Commission on Teacher Credentialing – Named Employee for School Year 2024-2025.

1. Shira Bannerman, 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Special Education Teacher, Urban Promise Academy.

**Background** California Education Code 44258.3 shall allow districts to assign teachers outside of their area of credential authorization in a departmentalized setting. A teacher, with their consent, can be assigned to a position outside their credential authorization upon local verification that the teacher to be assigned has adequate knowledge of the subject to be taught.

**Discussion** The Board of Education may approve Local Assignment Option Permits for a certificated employee to work. The current request is for one (1) Local Assignment Option Permit, Special Education teacher to provide instruction in the District as an Art teacher.

1. Shira Bannerman, Special Education Teacher, Urban Promise Academy, Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. Shira has been working as a Mild/Moderate RSP teacher at Urban Promise Academy. Shira studied Fine Arts at the School of Visual Arts in New York City. This art background, paired with her teaching skills, make Shira an excellent candidate for the art position at Urban Promise Academy.


