**Subject** Resolution No. 1920-0243 for submission of a “Request for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions” California Department of Education (CDE) Form J-13A and Affidavit of Governing Board Members to regain Student Average Daily Attendance (ADA) due to schools closure and material decrease in attendance

**Action Requested** Approval by the Board of Resolution No. 1920-0243 for Submission of Request for “Allowance Of Attendance Due To Emergency Conditions” (Form J-13A) and Affidavit of the Governing Board Members of a request to disregard days in the computation of attendance due to district-wide school closures, material decreases during the month of October 2019 due to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) outages and poor air quality, sewer line repair at Joaquin Miller Elementary School on January 23, and McClymonds High School closure of February 20, 21, and 24 for toxic underground water testing.

**Background** Education Code Section 41422 permits a District to maintain Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) apportionments and credit Instructional time without regard to the fact the school(s) were closed due to the nature of the emergency.

When one or more schools were closed because of the conditions described in Education Code, California Department of Education (CDE) permits districts to claim ADA credit and maintain LCFF by submitting Form J-13-A.

- During the month of October 2019, PG&E announced that they would shut down electric power due to the high wind weather conditions in Oakland.
- On January 23, Joaquin Miller Elementary School was closed due to sewer repairs.
- On February 20, 21, and 24, McClymonds High School was closed due to toxic underground water testing.

The J-13A Form, along with the Governing Board Members Affidavit, will be submitted to the Alameda County Office of Education (ACOE) and subsequently forwarded to the CDE for approval. The request, if approved, will maintain the District’s ADA funding by using of the estimated days of attendance in the computation of LCFF apportionments for described schools.

**Discussion**

Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) is submitting a request to the ACOE for “Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions” because of PG&E outages, sewer repair, and toxic water testing; ACOE will then forward the request to the CDE for approval. If the Request is approved, the District’s LCFF apportionment will be maintained and instructional time credited.

The apportionment lost by the District during this time is as follows: Friday, October 4, Monday, October 7, Tuesday, October 8, Wednesday, October 9, Thursday, October 10, Friday, October 11, Tuesday, October 15, Wednesday, October 16, Friday, October 18, Monday, October 21, Tuesday, October 22, Wednesday, October 23, Thursday, October 24, Friday, October 25, Monday, October 28, Tuesday, October 29, Wednesday, October 30, Thursday, October 31 and Friday, November 1; a total of 19 days.

**Recommendation**

**WHEREAS**, Education Code Section 41422, among other reasons, permits a school district to request allowance of reduction of one (1) day in the computation of Average Daily Attendance (ADA) lost due to school closure under an emergency condition(s); and.

**WHEREAS**, Approval of such Request authorizes Oakland Unified to disregard this day in the computation of ADA (per EC Section 41422) without applicable penalty and obtain credit for instructional time for the day and the instructional minutes that would have been regularly offered on those days pursuant to EC Section 46200.

**WHEREAS**, During the month of October 2019 due to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) outages and poor air quality, sewer line repair at Joaquin Miller Elementary School on January 23, and McClymonds High School closure of February 20, 21, and 24 for toxic underground water testing, the District will lose revenue in the computation of attendance due to district-wide school closures and material decreases.

**WHEREAS**, The apportionment lost by the District during this time is as follows: Friday, October 4, Monday, October 7, Tuesday, October 8, Wednesday, October 9, Thursday, October 10, Friday, October 11, Tuesday, October 15, Wednesday, October 16, Friday, October 18, Monday, October 21, Tuesday, October 22, Wednesday, October 23, Thursday, October 24, Friday, October 25, Monday, October 28, Tuesday, October 29, Wednesday, October 30, Thursday, October 31 and Friday, November 1; a total of 19 days.

Over the past several years, fire season has become more troublesome. This week, we are facing a challenging set of circumstances. Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) says due to gusty winds and dry conditions in the forecast, they will be taking proactive measures by shutting down power. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of this week, PG&E is planning to turn off power for public safety in some parts of the Bay Area because of fire danger. The utility says it could happen in Oakland, which could affect some schools located on specific power lines. This is part of the utility's new **Public Safety Power Shutoff** protocol. To learn more about the planned power outages visit: [www.pge.com/ppsupdates](http://www.pge.com/ppsupdates).

Based on the plans so far from PG&E, it appears that about ten schools could have their power shut off. The power would be turned off not just at the schools, but also in the surrounding neighborhoods.

### **How to Stay Informed about Outages at Specific OUSD Schools**

If we learn that the power at your school will be turned off, we will:

- Send out a robocall to all students, families and staff at the affected schools sometime Tuesday evening, October 8, to let you know that your school will be affected.

- Post information to our social media channels (@OUSDnews [Twitter](#) and [Facebook](#)).
- Disseminate information to school sites to share with families.

If you do not receive a call, you can assume your school is open as usual on Wednesday, October 9.

Also, each day we will send out additional messaging regarding the next day's plans for affected schools and update our website and social media sites. Unfortunately, this situation could stretch into several days if the weather patterns persist.

OUSD has no control over these power outages but wants to ensure everyone is prepared. As is always the case, the health and safety of our students and staff is paramount.
