Chairperson Swayne said staff did an excellent job in choosing the photographs for the Annual Report. She said she believes the report to be accurate and the audit report lists items to be dealt with.

Committee Member Holland wanted to know when was the report made available to Committee Members?

Chairperson Swayne said several drafts had been provided to Committee Members. She said this is the final version for approval by the committee tonight.

Committee Member Holland wanted to know why some of the expenditures had no dollar figure, just a blank space.

Staff Response from Michael Ezra - There were no expenditures for those projects, but the project had been approved by the Board.

Staff Response from David Colbert - These expenditures will appear in an Annual Report for another year.

Committee Member Jean Moore wanted to know if the totals on the page with the audit review and findings and the first paragraph on the annual review and expenditures which totaled \$29,784,000 was the same as the total on the last page?

Michael Ezra said "yes."

Committee Member Teng asked for the definition for Local Business and Local Contractors on page 3 of the Annual Report under the heading of Supporting the Local Economy?

Staff Response - David Colbert said it is a combination of Oakland residents and Oakland businesses.

Committee Member Teng had a question regarding the audit review and findings, last paragraph, last sentence - It states bond proceeds is not to be used to pay administrative salaries and the Annual Report list \$2,400,00 payments to District staff.

Vice Chair Patricia Williams said she believes that statement means not to pay overhead administrative costs. She said you need staff to manage the project and these are legitimate expenditures.

Public Comments

Mike Hutchinson said there is a Board Policy regarding local hire that identifies what is considered a local vendor and the required level of local employees. Mr. Hutchinson questioned how the expenditures are listed, some were left blank and some had a dash and he wanted to know what did it mean when left blank? Mr. Hutchinson the numbers for Glenview Elementary School project keep growing and the citizens need oversight. He said he too questioned why Measure J Funds are being used for administrative costs in the

Facilities Department for staff to manage the funds and suggested deferring this question to General Counsel if there is a legal question.

- -Would like to see the Master Plan for Fremont High School. She asked the principal what were some of the things he would like to see at the school. The list included a stadium, playing field and American with Disabilities Act compliant gym.

The garden beds had not been there long and perhaps that's why no flowers have been planted.

Staff Comments

David Colbert said the work at Fremont High School has been ongoing for 3-4 years and within the next few months there will be community meetings regarding what will take place on the Fremont campus and the committee will be notified of the meetings.

Chairperson Swayne said the District is trying to determine how many students will actually attend Fremont High School so that the school is not over built or under built.

Public Comments on All Non-Agenda Items Within the Subject Matter Jurisdiction of the Committee - November 10, 2014.

Mike Hutchinson said when construction for LaEscuelita was first proposed, the cost was \$28 million and now the costs are up to \$89 million and counting. He said this is an example of a project out of control. He said there is now a complex that includes a high school, television studio and health clinic. Mr. Hutchinson said the Glenview community was told by Tim White and other District staff that because renovation was a certain percentage of what replacement costs would be, they decided upon total replacement of the building. He said the entire school does not need to be replaced if the savings of replacement would allow the District to do other things in other neighborhoods.

I. Introduction of New Legislative Matter

Vice Chair Williams requested information regarding the overall State audit for the District and its effect on the cost of bonds. Chairperson Swayne said she will ask staff to make a presentation at the next committee meeting.

Because there was not a quorum of Committee Members presents at today's committee meeting to approve the 2012-2013 Annual Report, Chairperson Swayne suggested convening a Special Committee Meeting on December 2nd.

Committee Member Moore recalled when some of the current members joined the committee, they approved reports for fiscal year they were not members on the committee and wanted to know if the current members could approve the 2012-2013 Annual Report.
