- 95% Free and Reduced Lunch, 95% First Generation to College, 16% SPED, 32% EL

# Our Pathway

**Information Technology and Digital Media Pathway:** The Unity Pathway of Information Technology and Digital Media offers technical training in computer programming, digital literacy, and digital media, with technical certification opportunities upon completion of sequence. >90% of students take the introductory Pathway course in 10th grade, and >90% of students take the concentrator courses in 11th grade.

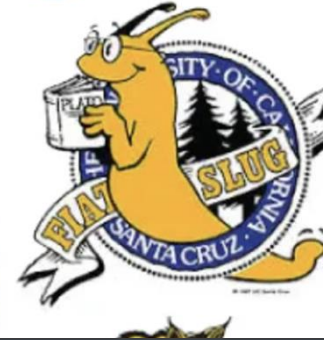
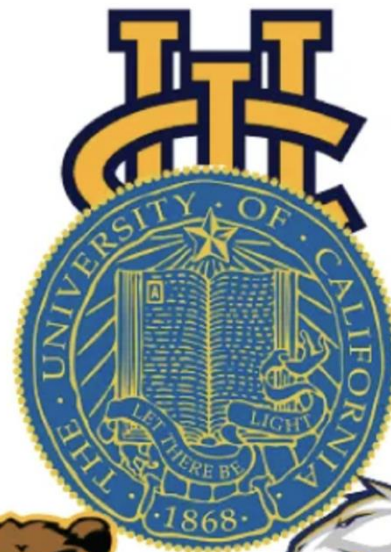

The 90% of seniors who completed AP Computer Science Principles last year are receiving college acceptance letters now.



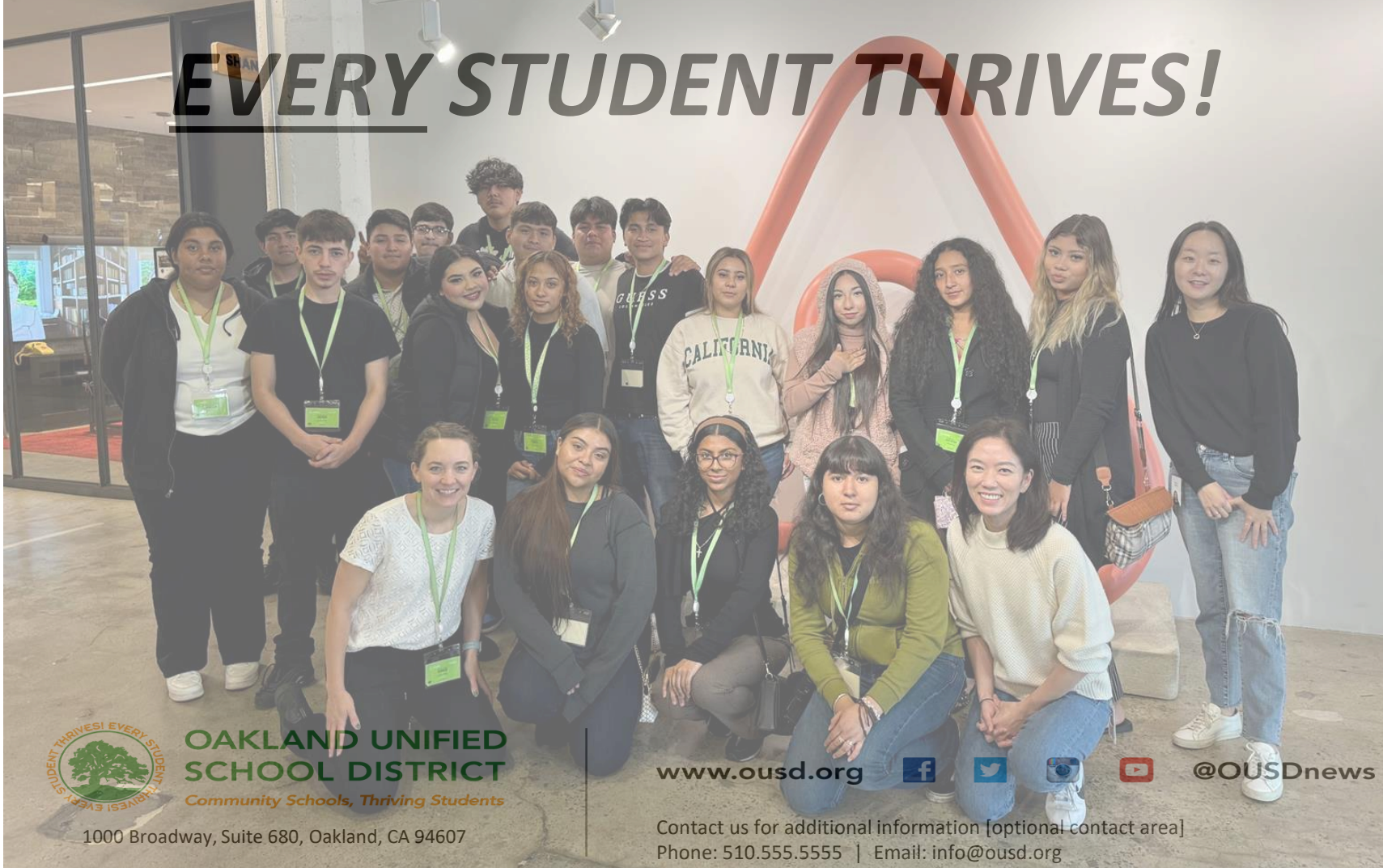
