*Good evening board members, Superintendent, students, families and community,*

The All City Council Student Union Governing Board is delighted to share with you all what we have been up to and what we are planning in the next couple of weeks:

Last Wednesday, we held our first Central Office Redesign engagement with students leaders. ACC met with district leadership to give guidance and input on the 4 main drivers. One thing was clear to us as students, we need to be at the center of all the drivers and that means we need to be at the table. We need to be included as partners in curriculum design, in facilities, in budget and finances, in school expansions, mergers, etc, in hiring, in evaluation and feedback, in trainings, in academic standards and credit recovery, in attendance, in culture and climate, and any protocol, policies and practices. We are hopeful and look forward to the next engagement. We will put out the date to hopefully have more students join us.

The 22nd Annual Oakland Middle School Peer Resource & Ethnic Studies Conference that took place on April 26th was not only a well executed day, but very fun indeed for both the middle schoolers, teachers, staff, and community. We hosted over 200 people - workshop presents from 18 different community based organizations and OUSD Departments, volunteers, staff, and teachers and students from 13 middle schools - including: Alliance Academy, Claremont, Edna Brewer, Elmhurst Community Prep, Life Academy, Melrose Leadership Academy, Montera, Oakland Sol, Roosevelt, United for Success, Urban Promise Academy, Westlake, and West Oakland Middle School. All students, teachers, staff, and chaperones participated in one of the 20 student led Restorative Justice Community Building Circles; including 64 Peer RJ Leaders. The circles created a unique opportunity for Oakland youth leaders to build with each other. Students also had the opportunity to attend 2 of a list of 22 workshops on High School Readiness, College Readiness, Ethnic Studies, Healthy Living, and Leadership. We are proud to have had 50% of our workshops led by middle and high school students and 100% of our RJ circles be lead by middle school students. We want to shout out our amazing All City Council middle school leaders who MC'd the entire event and who spent the whole school year in the re-designed the vision for the conference, workshop topics, circle agendas, and this years' theme: **Improvement comes from Youth Movements: The World, Oakland & Yourself.** Thank you to our powerful KeyNote Student Speakers: Anissa Phuong, Dewey Academy & AYPAL Leader; Lihn Le, Edna Brewer ACC Student Leader & Peer RJ Leader; Burlin Tre Germany, Metwest

And thanks to our distinguished guests, beautiful motivational speeches, and cultural performers: Cassie Eskridge, Mills College Associate Dean of Students; Mara Chavez-Diaz, Mills College Assistant Professor of Ethnic Studies and OUSD Alumni; Christopher Chatmon, OUSD Office of Equity Deputy Chief; and Maritza Bernal, Mills Student and OUSD Alumni from Oakland International and former RJ leader. Thank you to our Middle School Network Superintendent Mark Triplet for attending and participating in the event, joining students in circle, having lunch with students, and enjoying the day with us. Thank you to Mills College for their partnership in hosting this year's conference! We are also happy to shout out that during the conference students had the opportunity to bring student voice to revisions on the OUSD's Physical Education Policy and also participate in the renown Skyline's Professional Drama class taught by Ms. Awele in "A Place to Belong".

On May 1st, our ACC Governing Board came out to participate in May Day, "March and Strike for Immigrant and Worker's Rights - Oakland Sin Fronteras International Worker's Day Mobilization!". We came out in continued support for our State, City, and School District to stand up for "Human Rights and Sanctuary for all". There were many students, staff, families, community organizations uniting as one. One of the lead chanters of the march was our beloved Student Director Yota Omosowho. Student Director Chavez and the ACC crew marched and chanted and connected with different students and people. We hope to see more of you out there next year.

Be prepared for this following date, The ACC High School Youth Action Summit and Elections, (10th year), will be taking place on Friday, May 17th, 8:30-3pm at the First Unitarian Church of Oakland. This day will be electing the future ACC Student Members and also identifying next steps for the ACC Campaign - Making A-G Real.
