WHEREAS, in keeping with the Oakland Unified School District's commitment to the improvement and development of its K-12 facilities, District staff has prepared the listed New Project Budget, Project Number and Key Code with an attached detailed explanation of the budget component costs; and

WHEREAS, authorization and approval of the scope of work to remove all of the existing asphalt and replace with new asphalt paving (including base material). All paving areas shall be designed to parking lot standards. Scope shall include striping for parking and playground designed to parking lot standards. Design Professional shall include as part of Basic Services the services of a Geotechnical Engineer and a Utility Location Company. Utility Locator shall provide field underground utility marking and mapping of utility line depths (using non-destructive means where possible). Design Professional shall provide fee for additional services to design concrete duct banks at locations where shallow utilities are encountered and relocation or lowering is not feasible; and


