School Culture:

- Reduce suspension rate by 50 % from 145 students (March 2017) to 72 students by March 2018.
- Lower school-wide chronic absence rate to below 16.3% by June 9, 2018

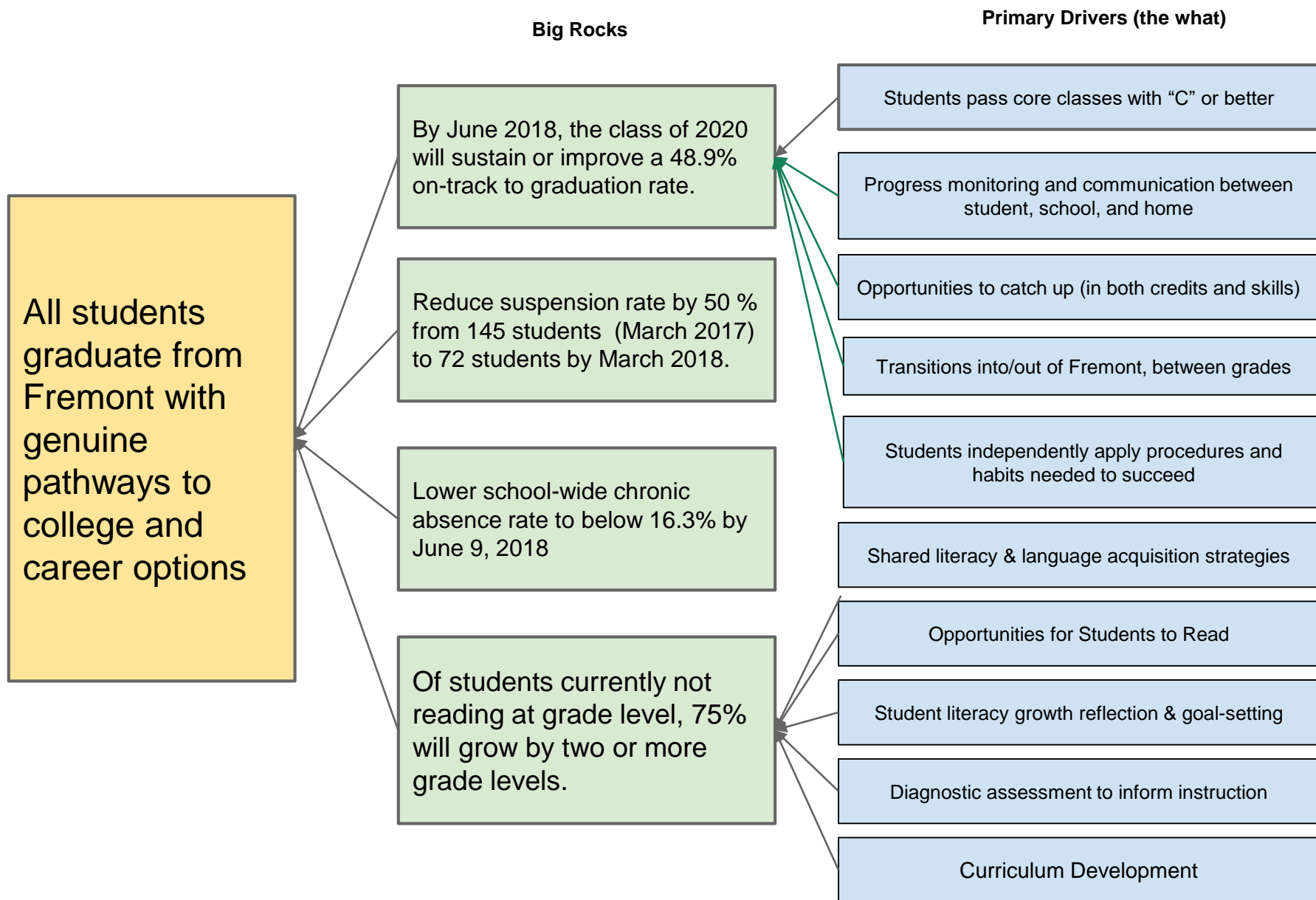
Literacy:

- Of students currently not reading at grade level, 75% will grow by two or more grade levels.

Graduation

- By June 2018, the class of 2020 will sustain or improve a 48.9% on-track to graduation rate (36.2% for whole school)

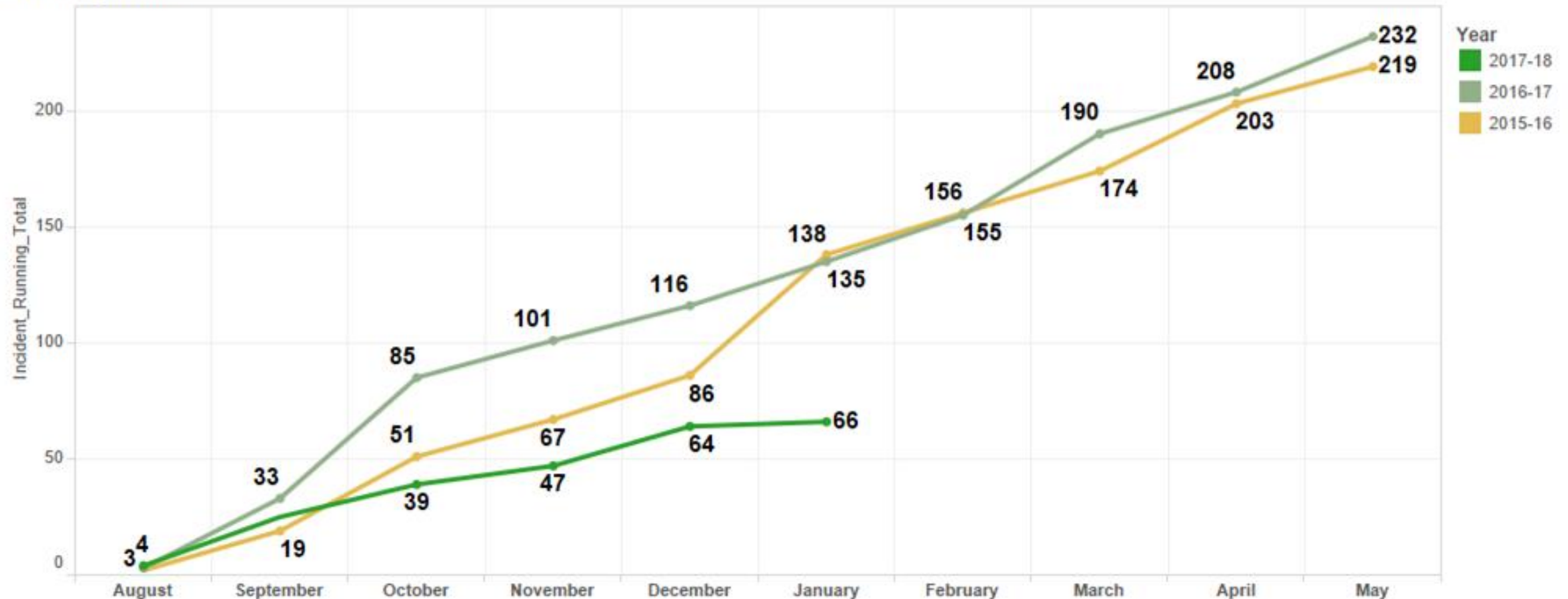

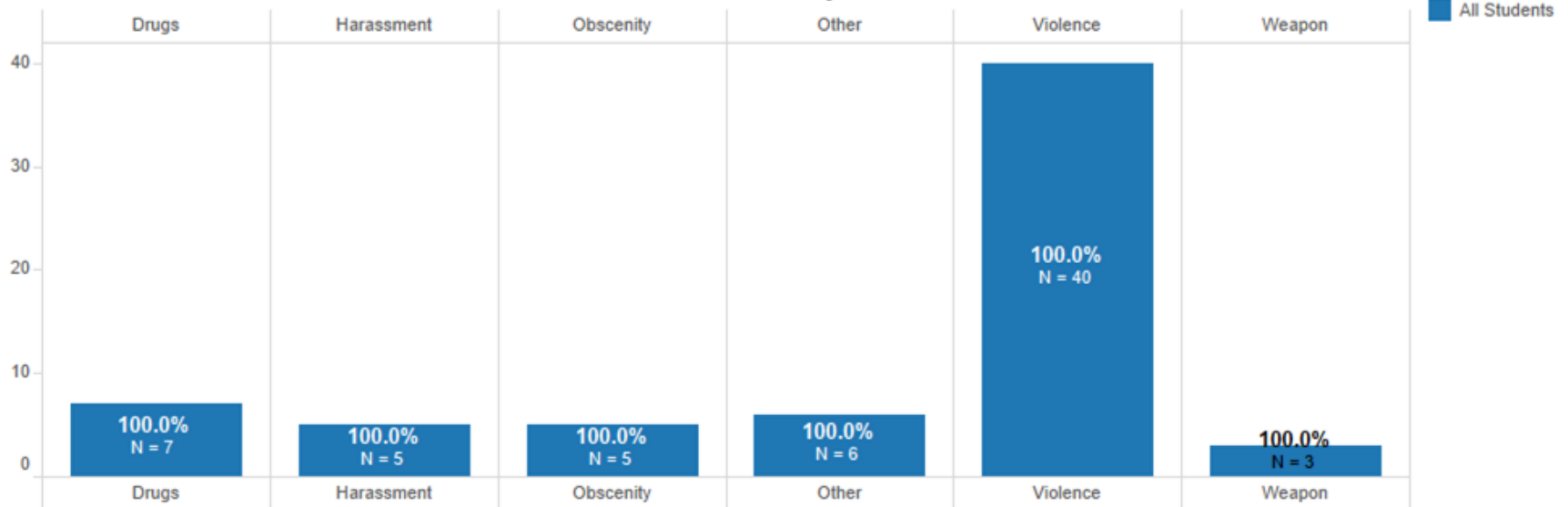

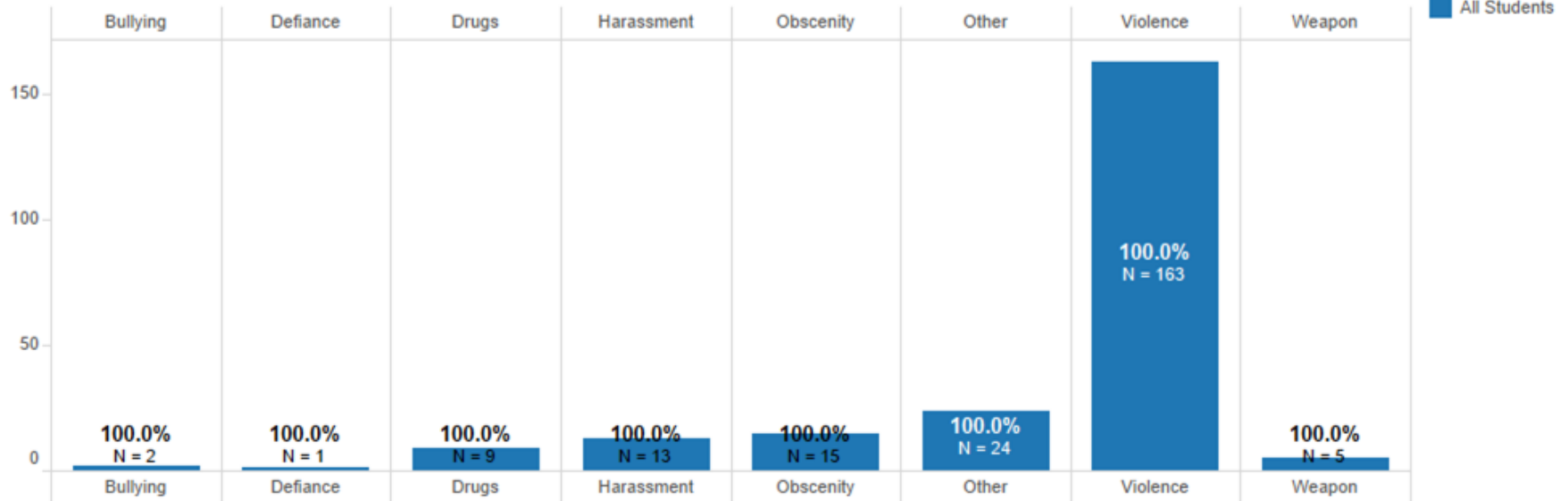

OSS at Fremont for All Grades: Percent and Number of Incidents by Offense Class

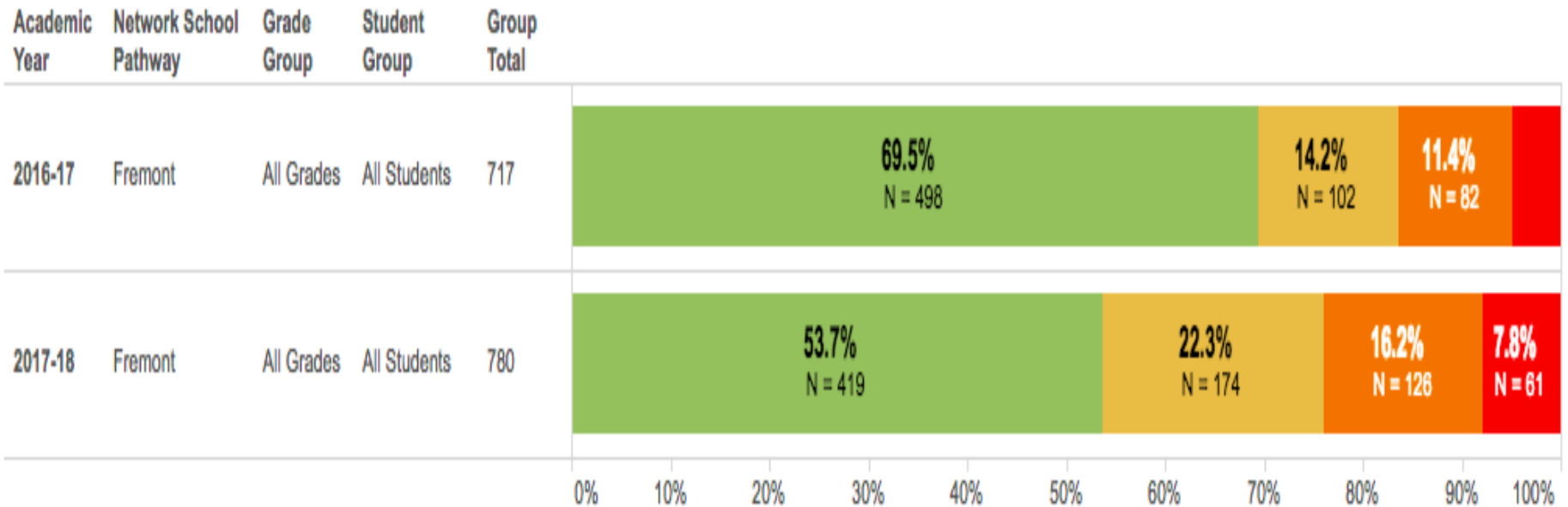

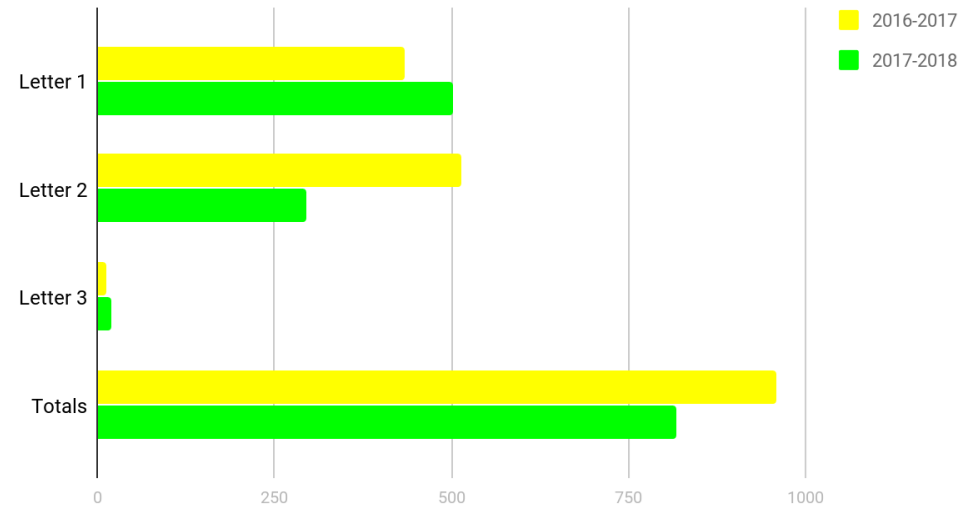

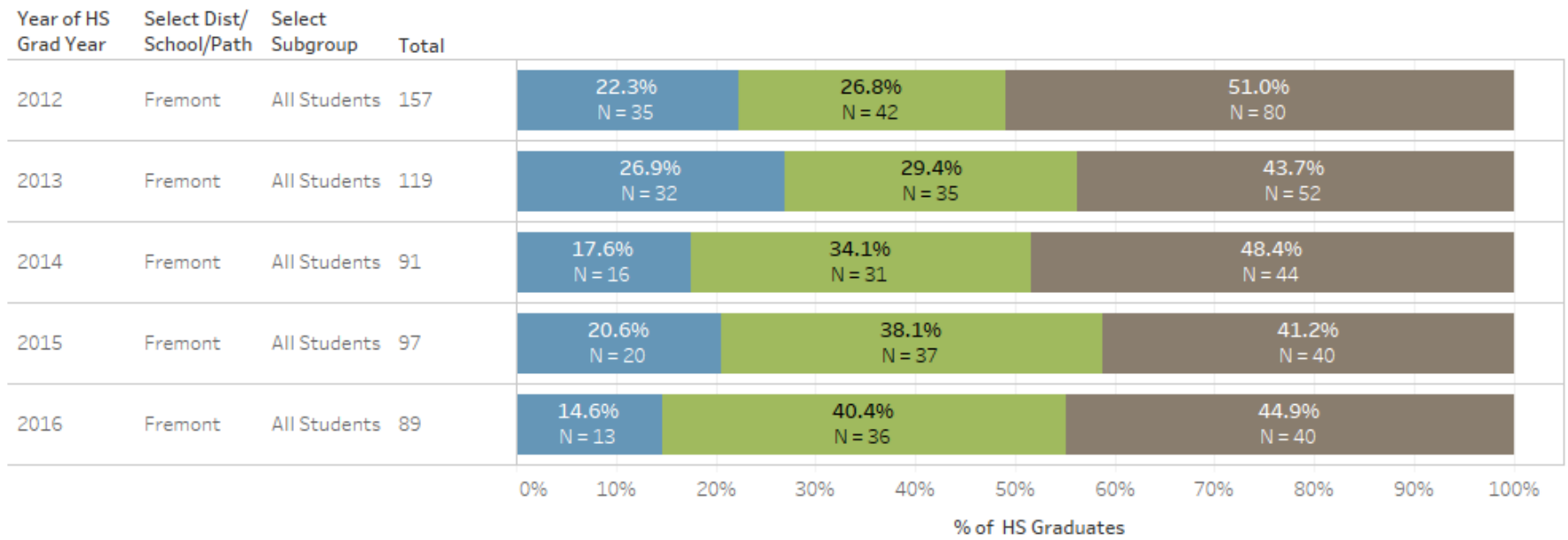

HS Graduates Enrolling in College Within 1 Year of HS Graduation



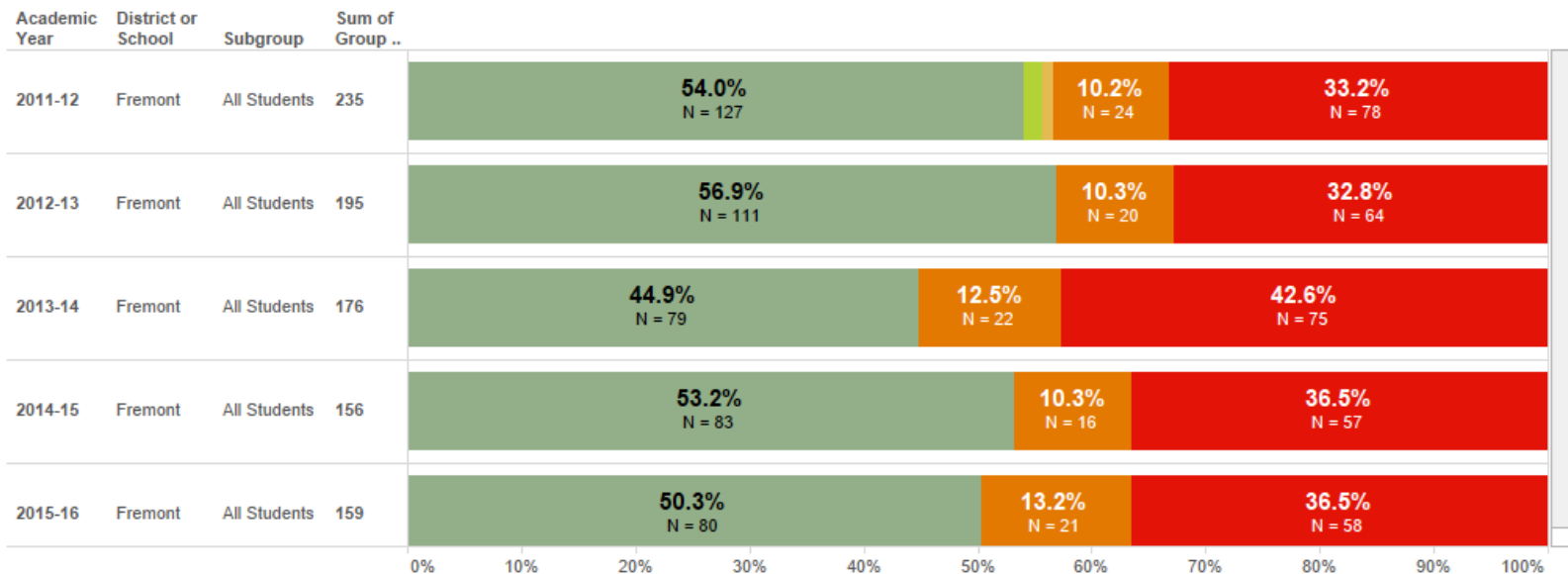

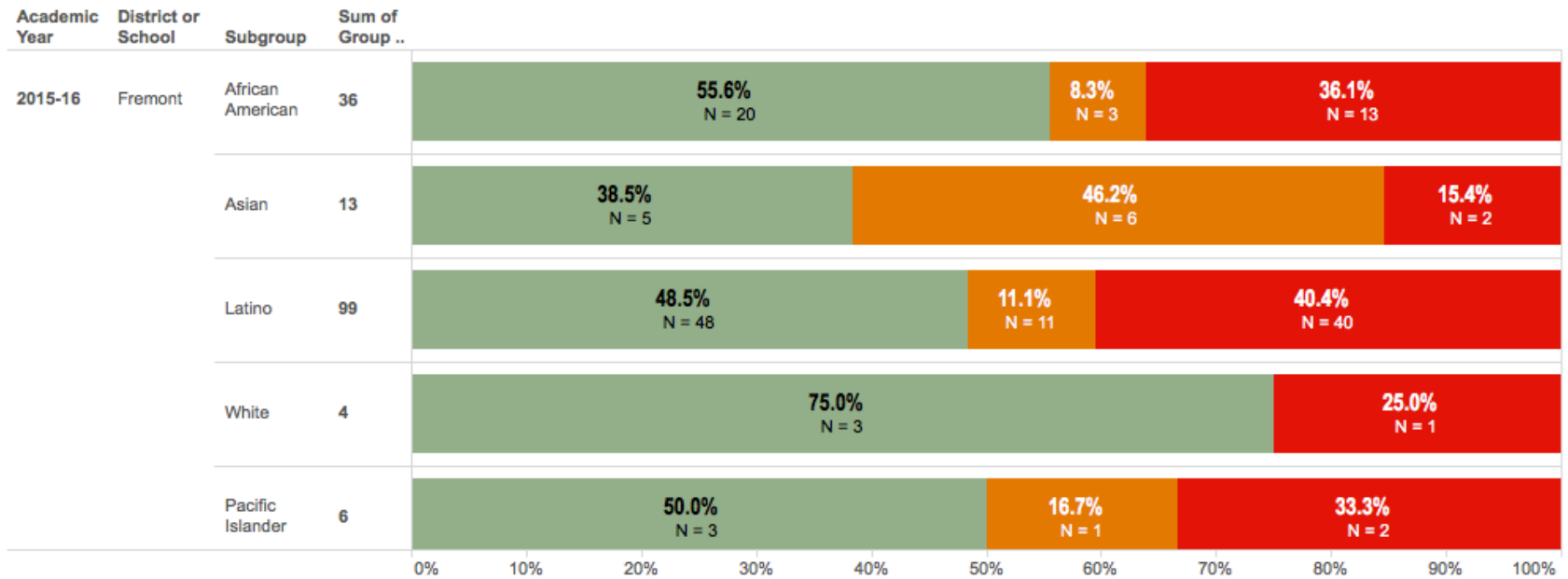

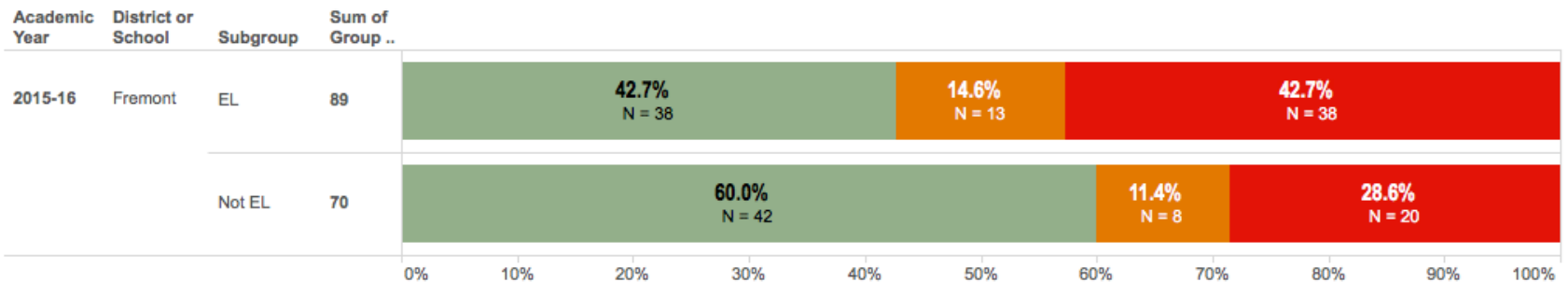

Graduation Rate - Ethnicity & EL



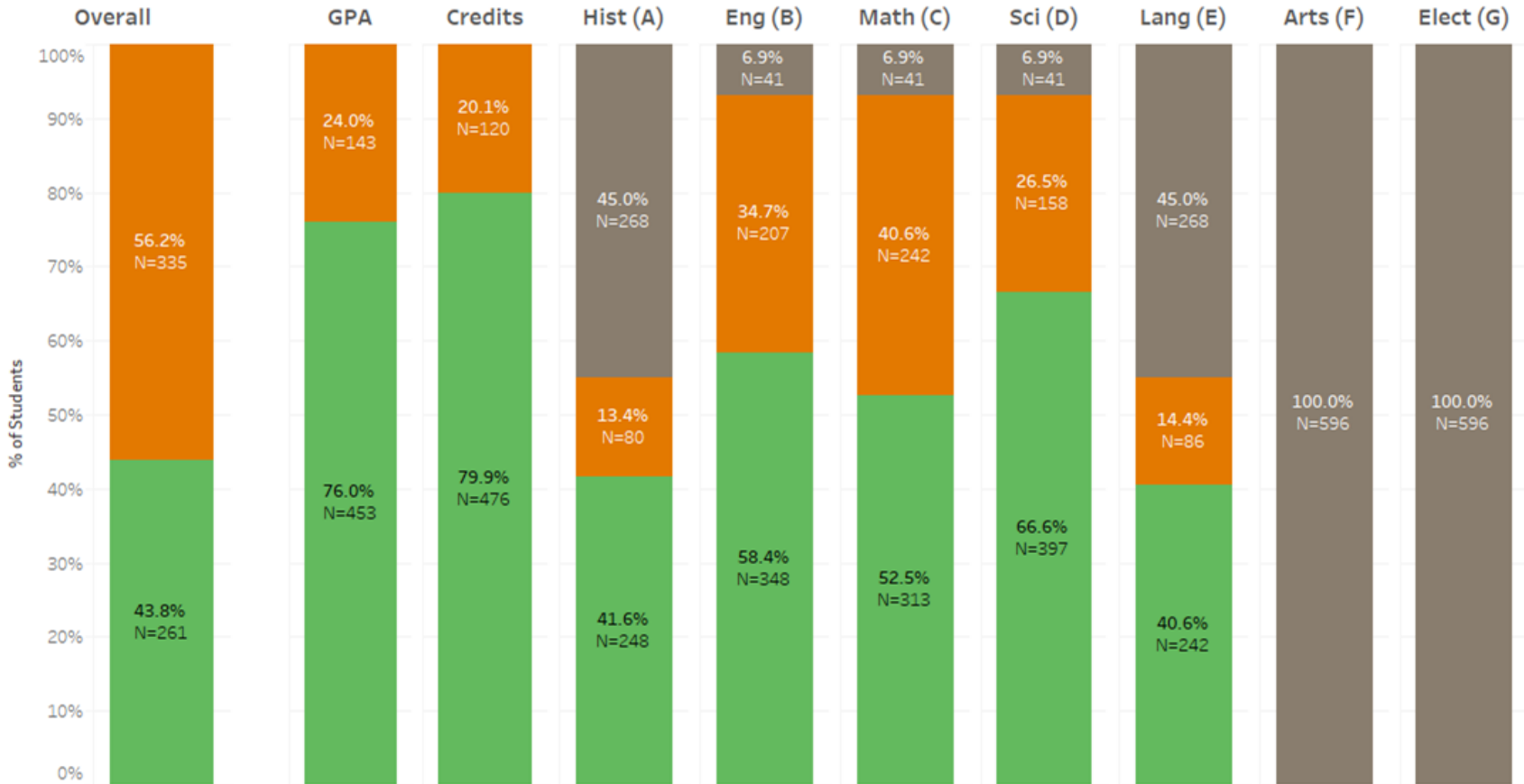

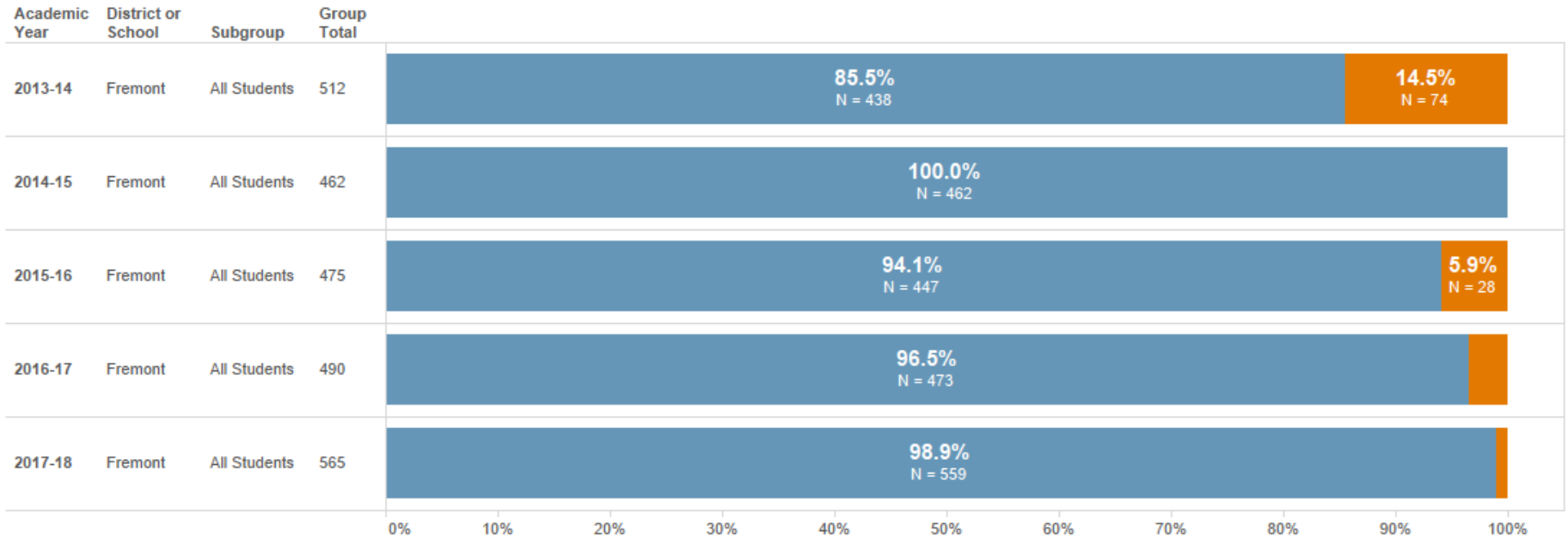

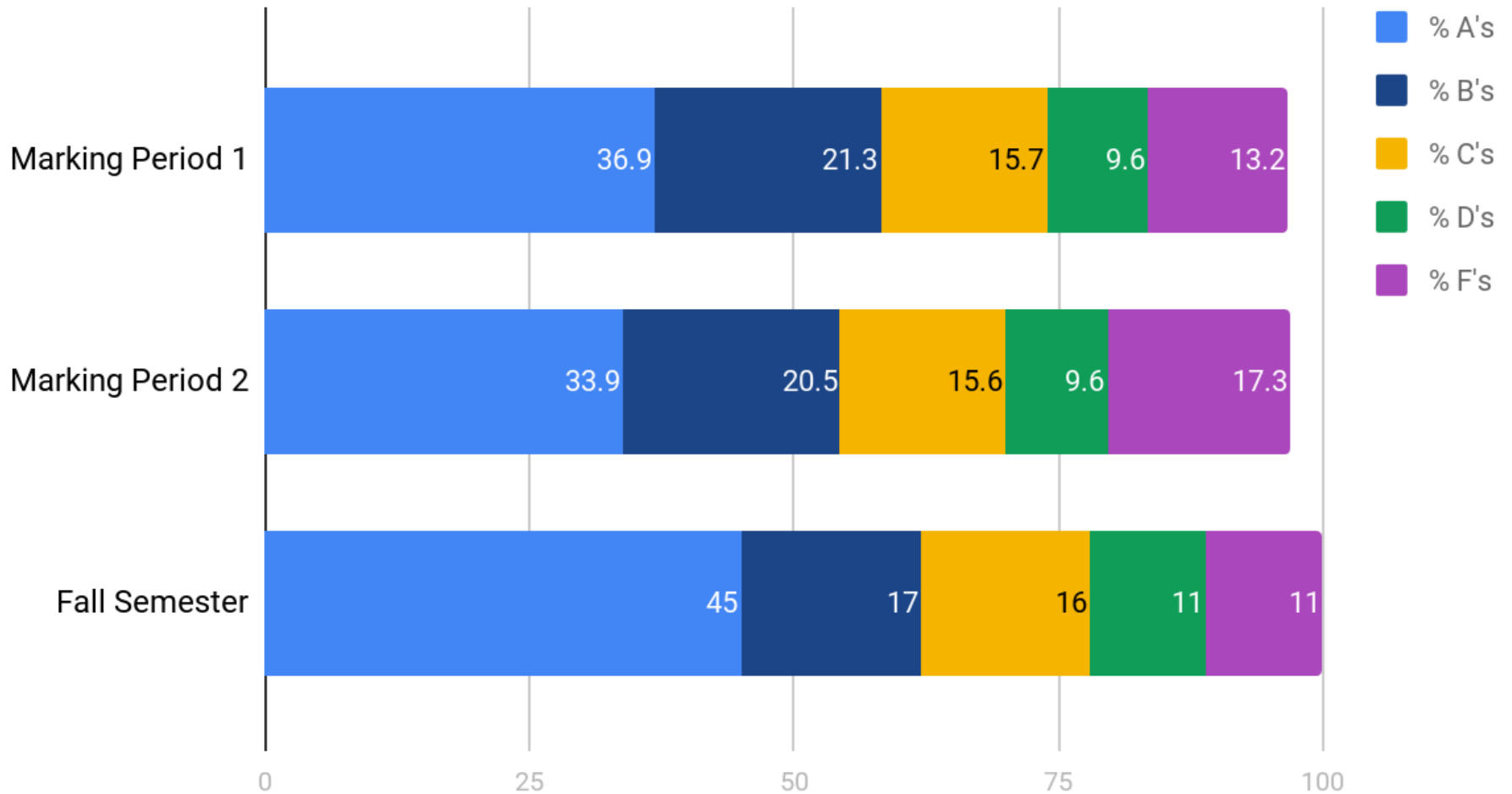

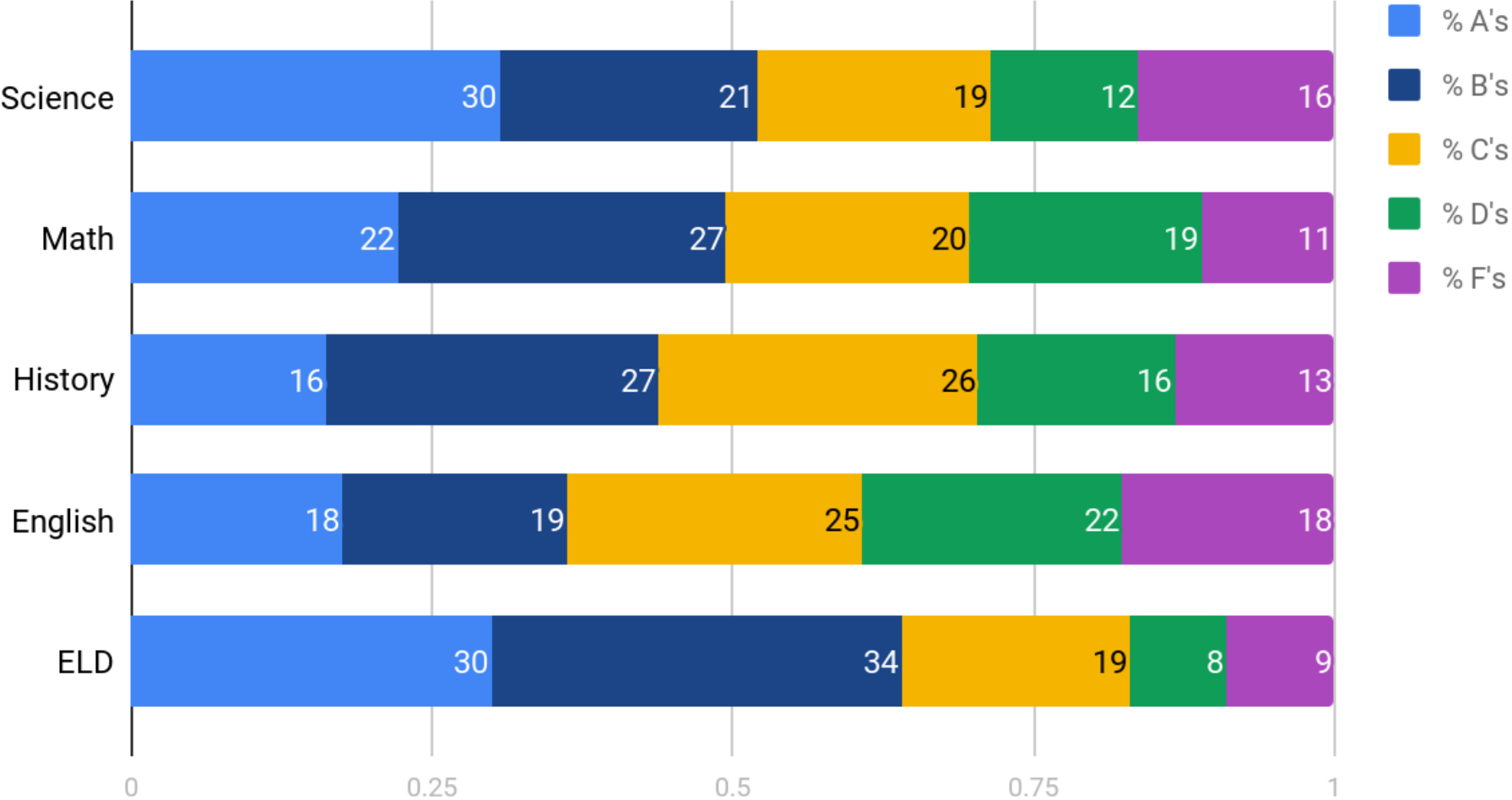

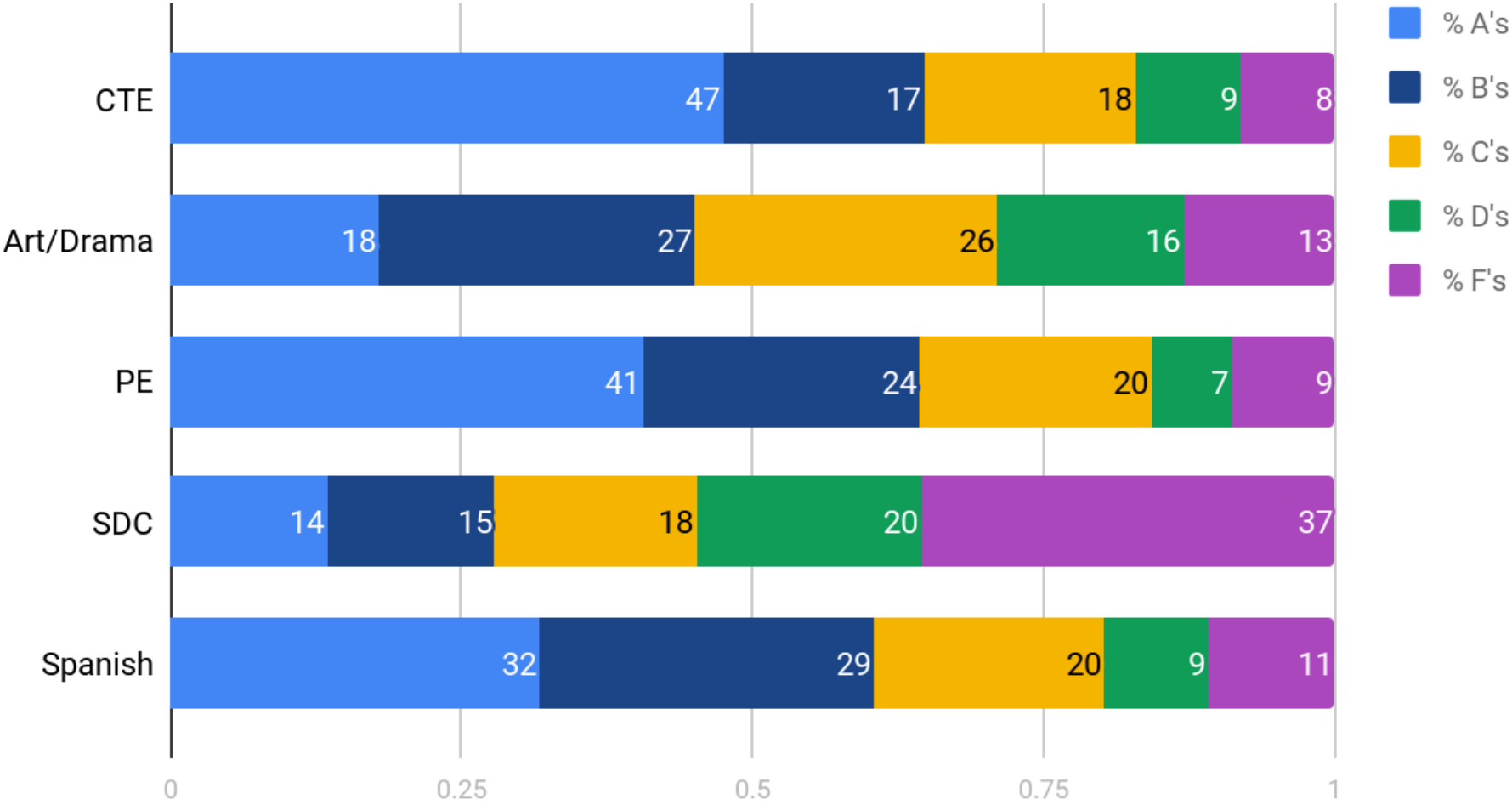
Whole School Grades Analysis

Semester Grades by Department





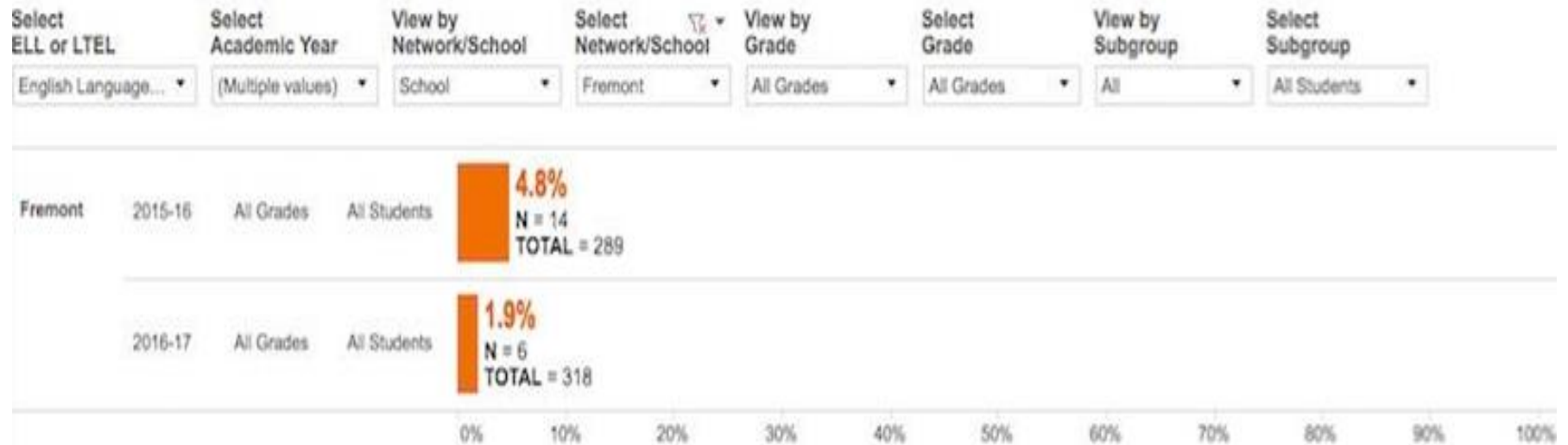
2018-19 Big Rocks Overview

What will we do better? (*New Goals*)

English Learners: 70% of students are reclassified by the end of 12th grade.

- 429 of our students are English Learners
- Of 318 students tested only 6 were able to pass the reclassification criteria (SRI & CELDT).
- 177 students have not made any growth for 2 years or more.

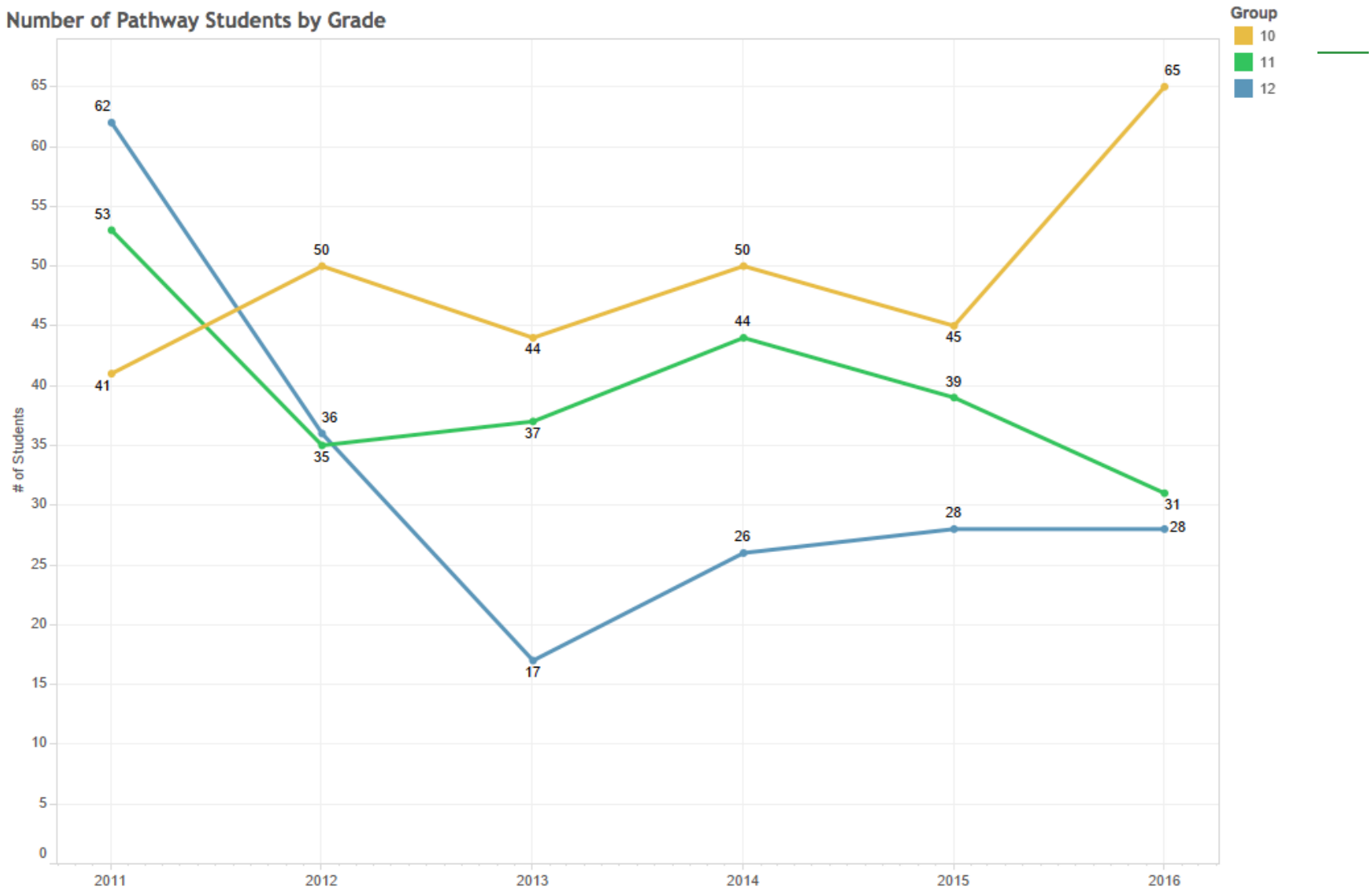
- What are your current literacy strategies?

 - School-wide focus on literacy through PD and collaboration; non-English teachers investing in improving literacy outcomes for students

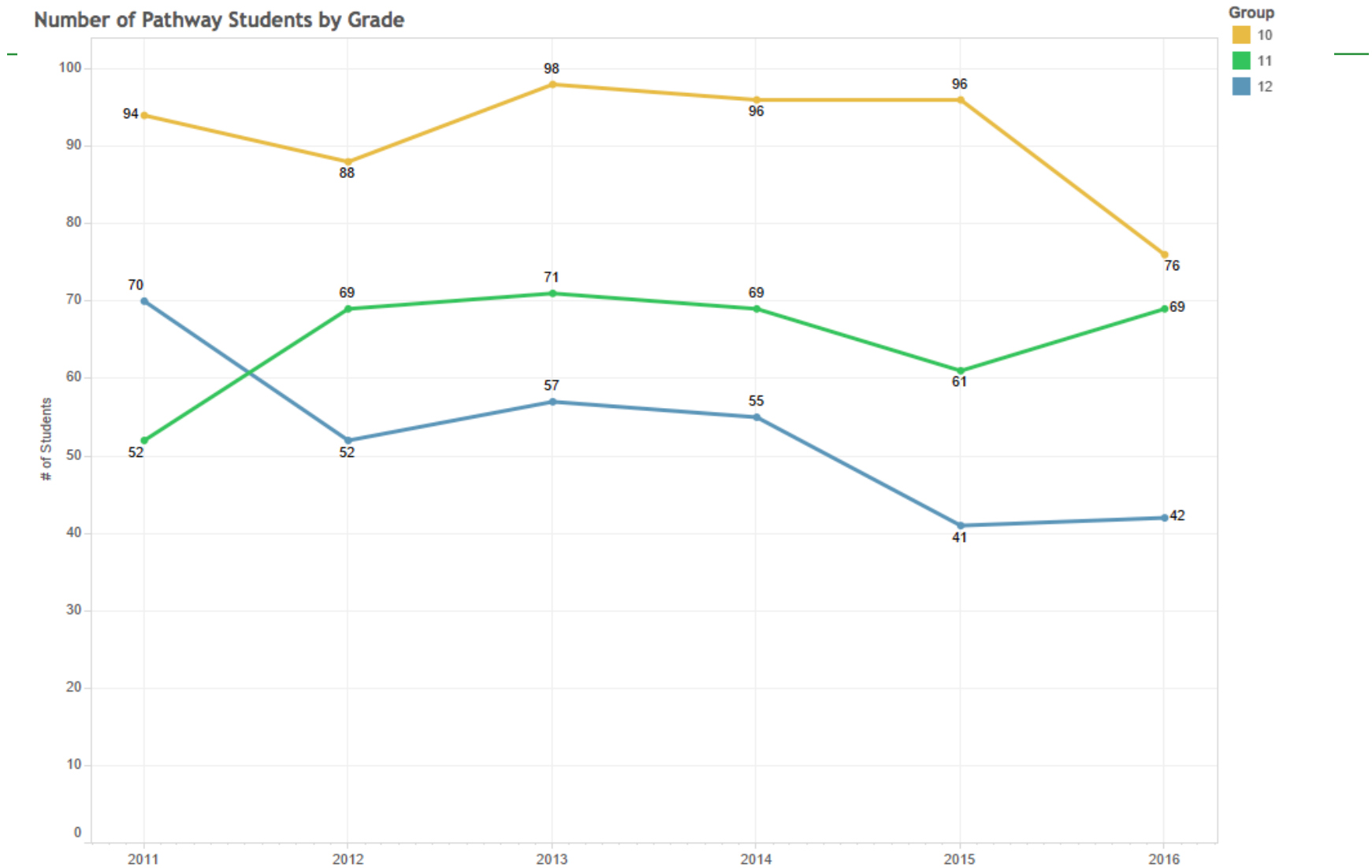
Pathway Enrollment - Media Academy

Number of Pathway Students by Grade



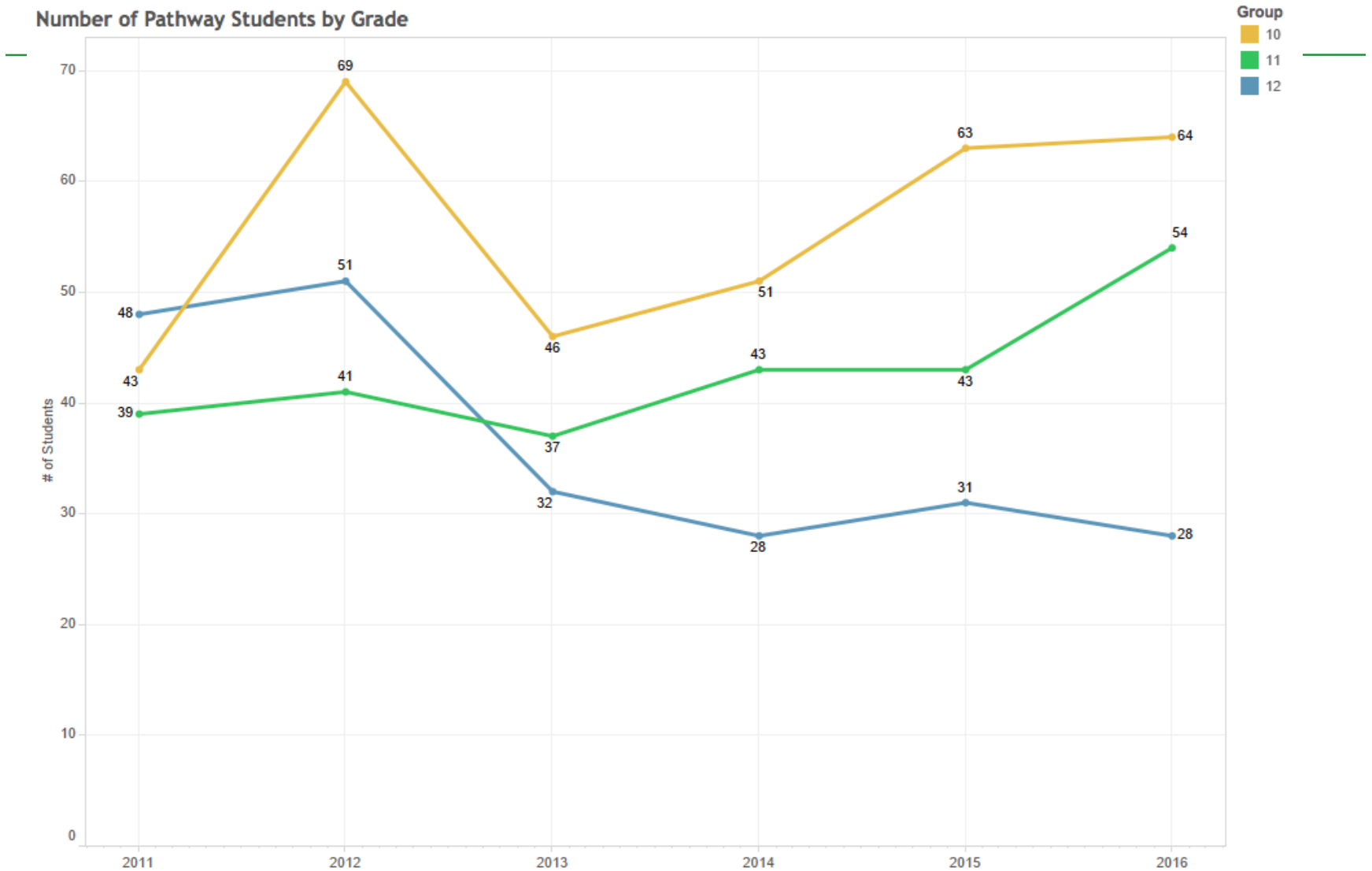
Pathway Enrollment - Architecture Academy

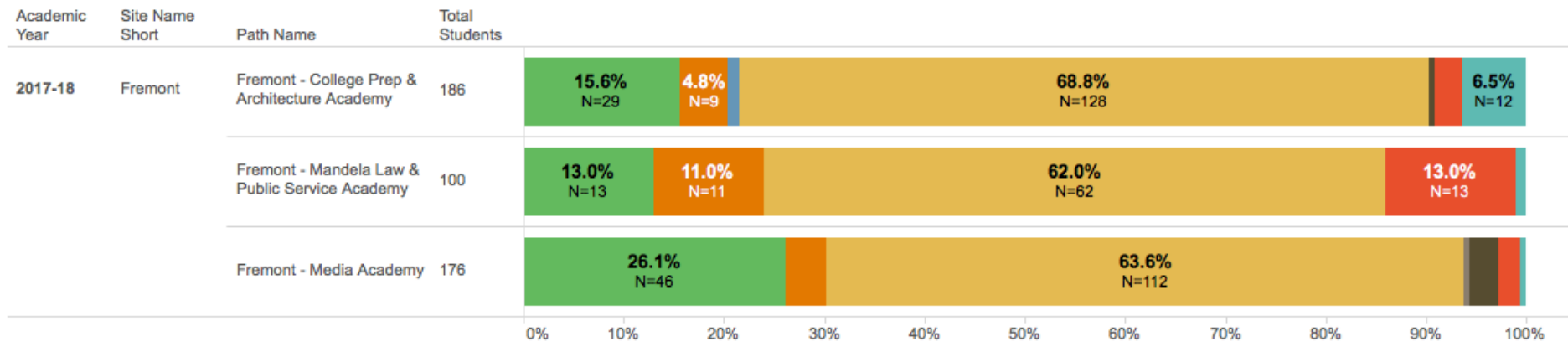

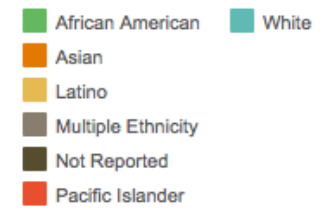
Pathway by Ethnicity - Grade 10, 11, 12



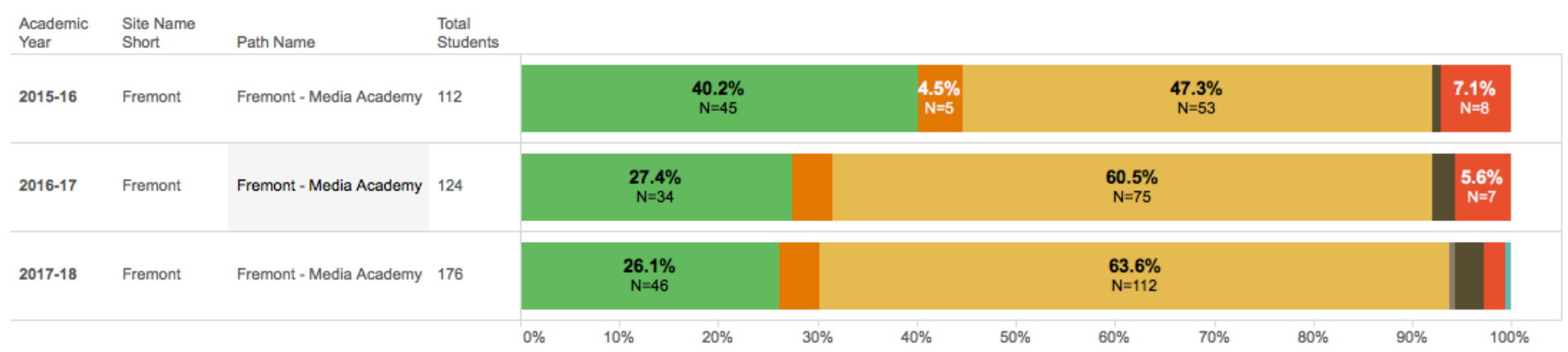

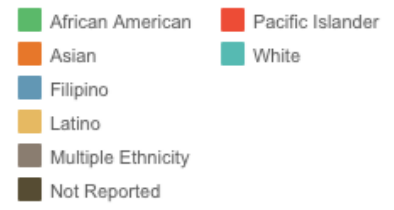
Pathway by Ethnicity - Grade 10, 11, 12



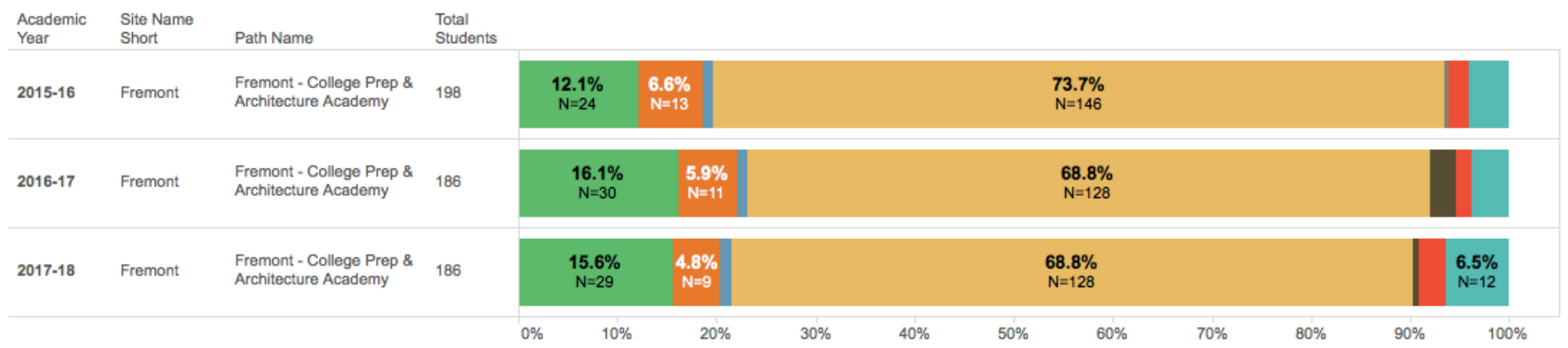

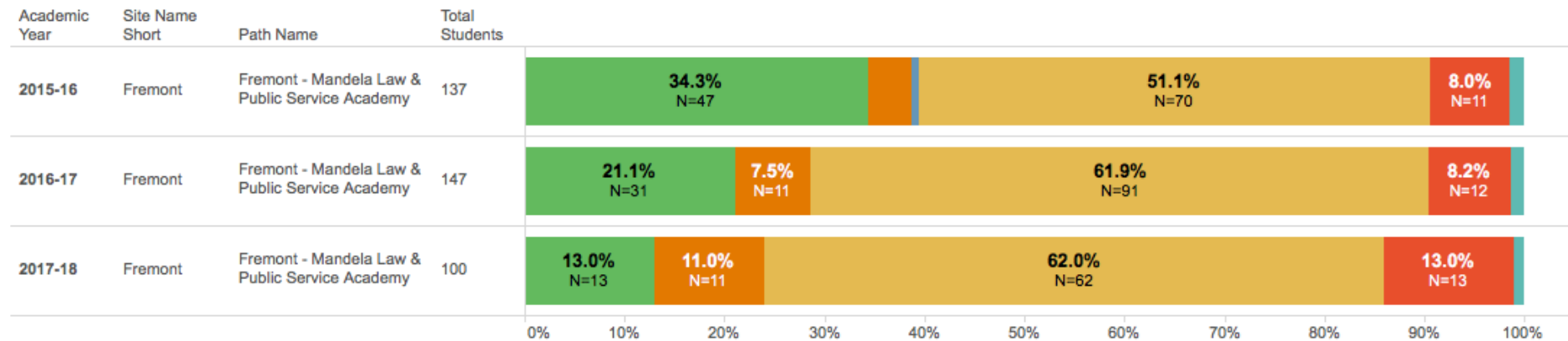

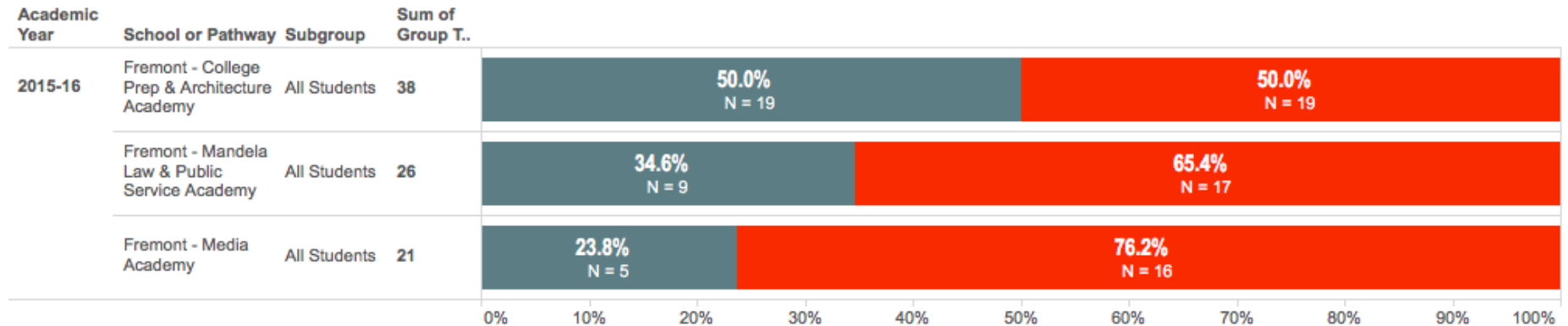
A-G Completion by Pathway - 12th
