A. Call to Order

Chairperson Chris Dobbins called the meeting to order at 5:01 P.M.

Mr. Rakestraw, Board Secretary announced to the Committee Legislative Files 09-1458 and 09-1459 were withdrawn from the Committee Consent Report.

Director London requested Legislative Files 09-1460, 09-1461, 09-1462, 09-1463, 09-1464, 09-1467, 09-1476, 09-1572, and 09-1573 be pulled from the Committee Consent Report for further discussion. Chairperson Dobbins agreed to Director London's request saying the Committee would vote to approve the Committee Consent Report without the nine items and after further discussion on the items take a separate vote to approve those nine items.

Samantha Blackburn, Consultant for the Complimentary Learning Department gave the staff report for the School Health Centers. Ms. Blackburn said the School Health Centers will provide health care to students at no cost. She said the School Health Centers are an efficient way to bring health care to where the children are everyday. A third party payer will be billed for the services provided. In Alameda County the centers receive some of their funding from the Tobacco Settlement Funds and Measure "A" Funds.

Committee Discussion

Director London asked how long was Kaiser Permanente's commitment to the project and who's paying the staff's salary. Ms. Blackburn said Kaiser Permanente's commitment to the healther centers is for three years contributing \$1 Million per year; staff would be paid by Alameda County, and third party billing/reimbursement.

Superintendent Mayor noted the School Health Centers are staffed by the health care agencies not District employees.

Chairperson Dobbins wanted to know what kind of drug rehabilitation and teenage pregnancy services will be available. Ms. Blackburn said age appropriate and developmentally appropriate reproductive health care with the emphasis being prevention.

After hearing the staff report on the Student Health Centers, the Committee voted to approve Legislative Files 09-1460, 09-1461, 09-1462, 09-1463, 09-1464, 09-1573.

Legislative File 09-1467 - Director London said she received an explanation for the item

and she moved adoption. The Committee voted to approve.
