Reflections on 2023-24

- Launched New Education Pathway
 - Hired Dean of Education; Taught concentrator course; Ran education internships
- Higher CA Dashboard Ratings
 - Improved in English, Math, & EL Progress; Top rating in College/Career Indicator
- Solidified Work Based Learning Scope & Sequence
 - Includes advisory lessons, site visits, enrichments, internships, and certifications
- Deepened Family Engagement
 - Expanded family meetings; Family leadership institute; Community School services











Academic Mentor Program

- Assist faculty and RSP staff with academic support, including pathway classrooms
- Support college & career preparation
 - Chaperone offsite Dual Enrollment classes
 - Support Certifications & Enrichment classes
 - Lead college campus & career site visits
- Co-lead advisories & tutoring spaces
- Receiving expanded professional development
 - Classroom routines, EL & IEP support
 - College stipends through grants (in addition to regular pay)

 - Continue PD for faculty & academic mentors; Improve WBL & DE access
- Student Portfolios & Defenses
 - Roll out schoolwide portfolio system; Revamp defenses to highlight pathway elements

 - Analyze & act on current data; Engage Linked Learning Alliance
