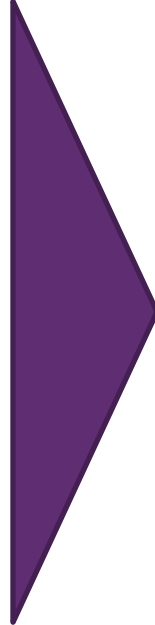
Aspire College Academy (ACA)

Aspire serves over 12,000 students in 34 schools across CA... 3 regions, 9 cities.



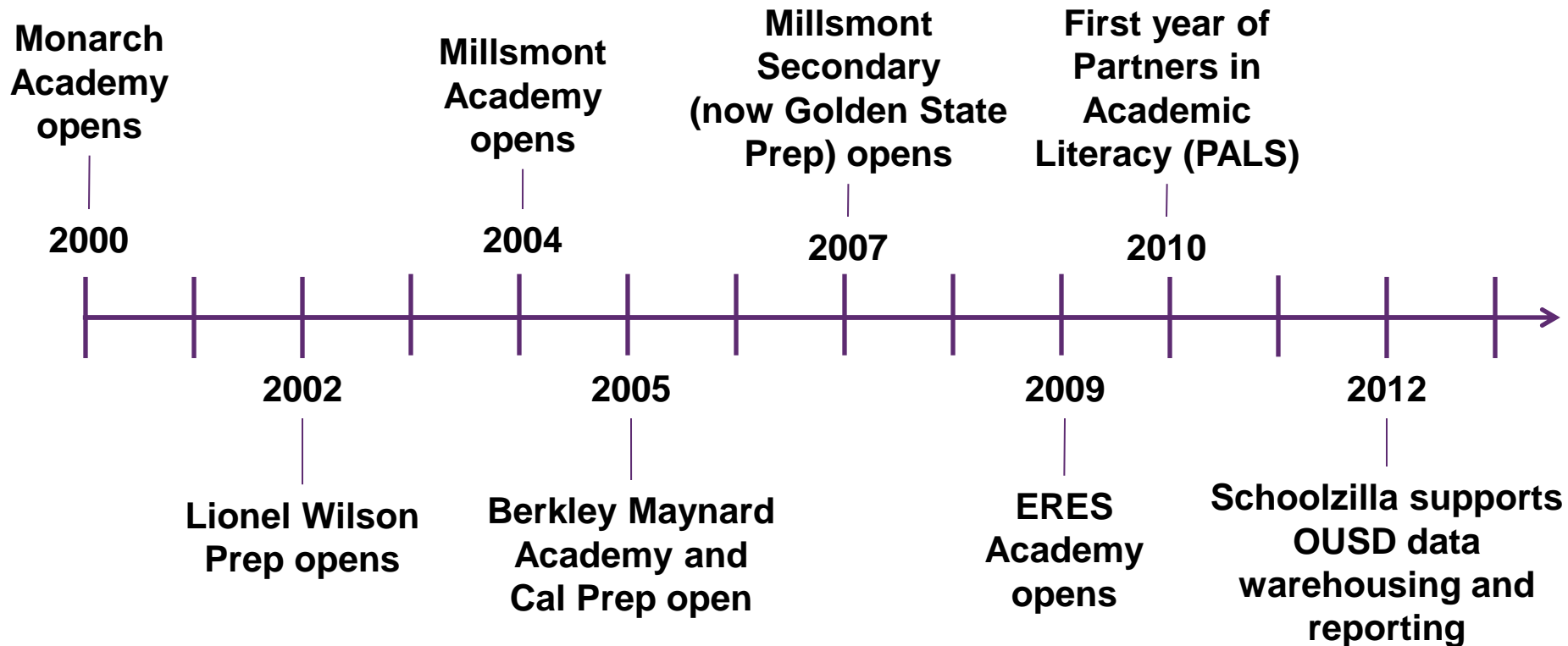
- Aspire is the **top-performing** school system of its kind

ACA's Principal Hernandez will continue this collaborative relationship, as a New Leader who regularly collaborates with New Leaders across the region, including many in East Oakland



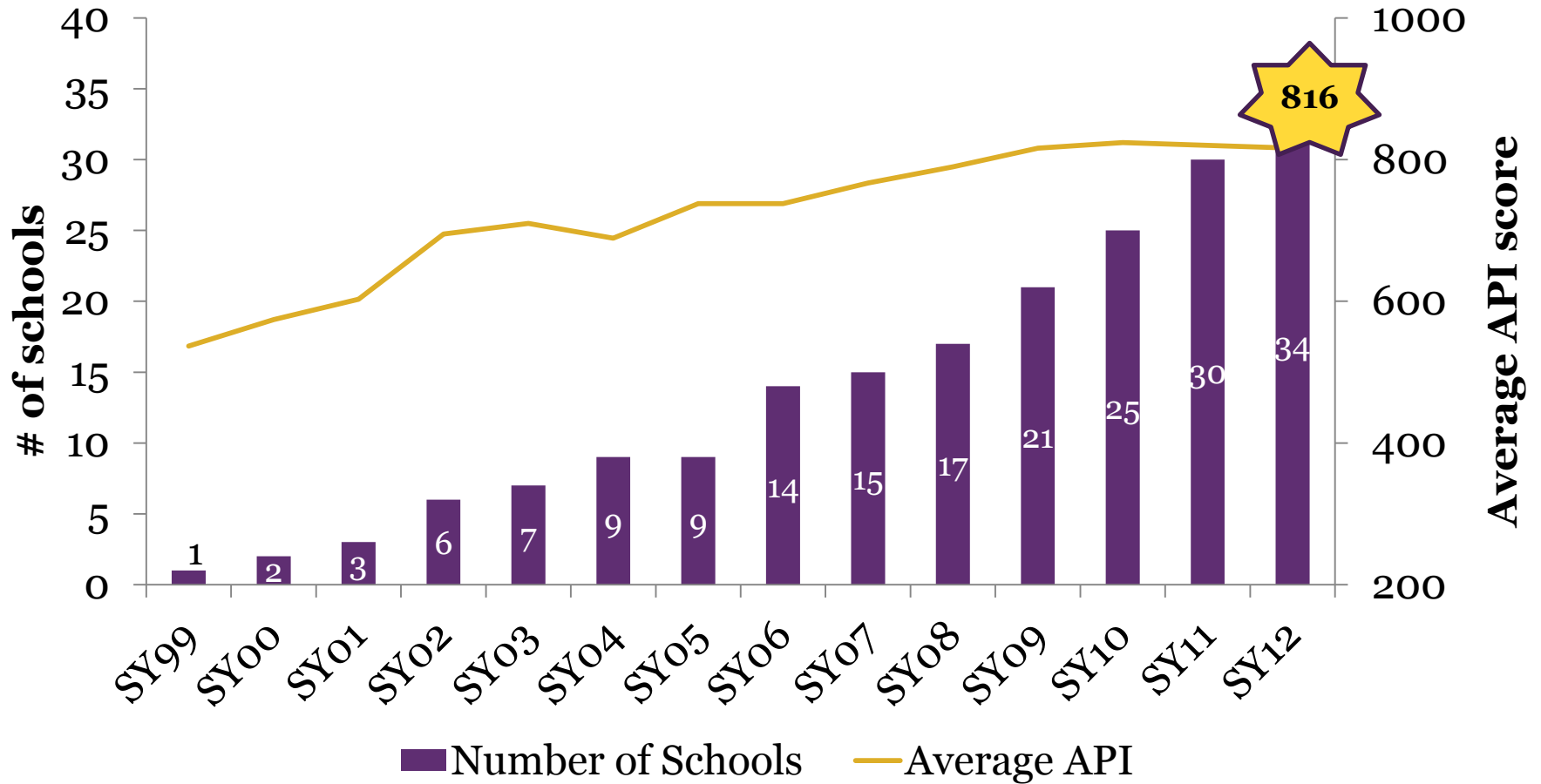
Program Highlights

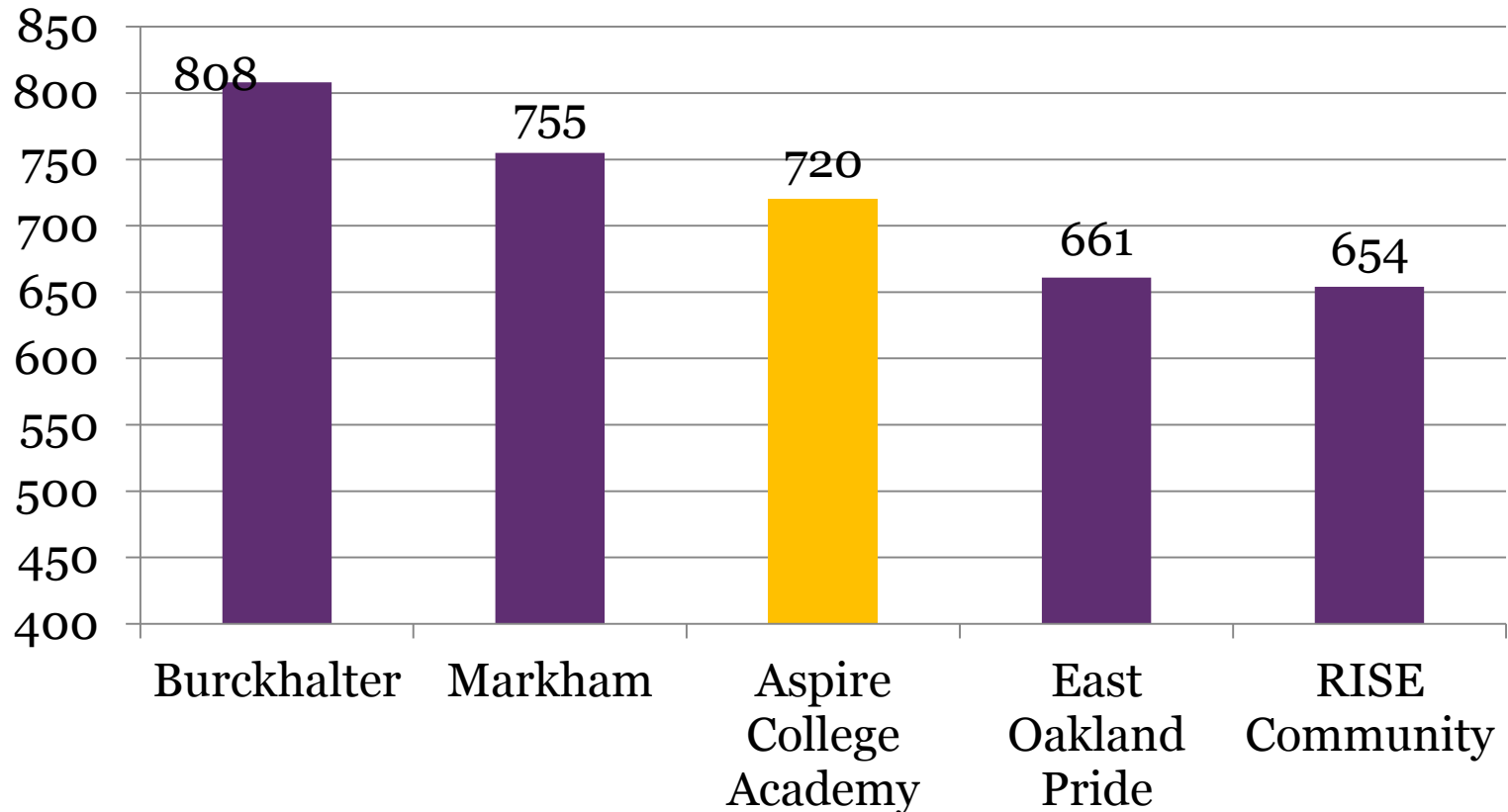
*As a new school, we concentrate very heavily on student culture and staff climate in addition to academic rigor

We've continued to improve as we've grown in scale



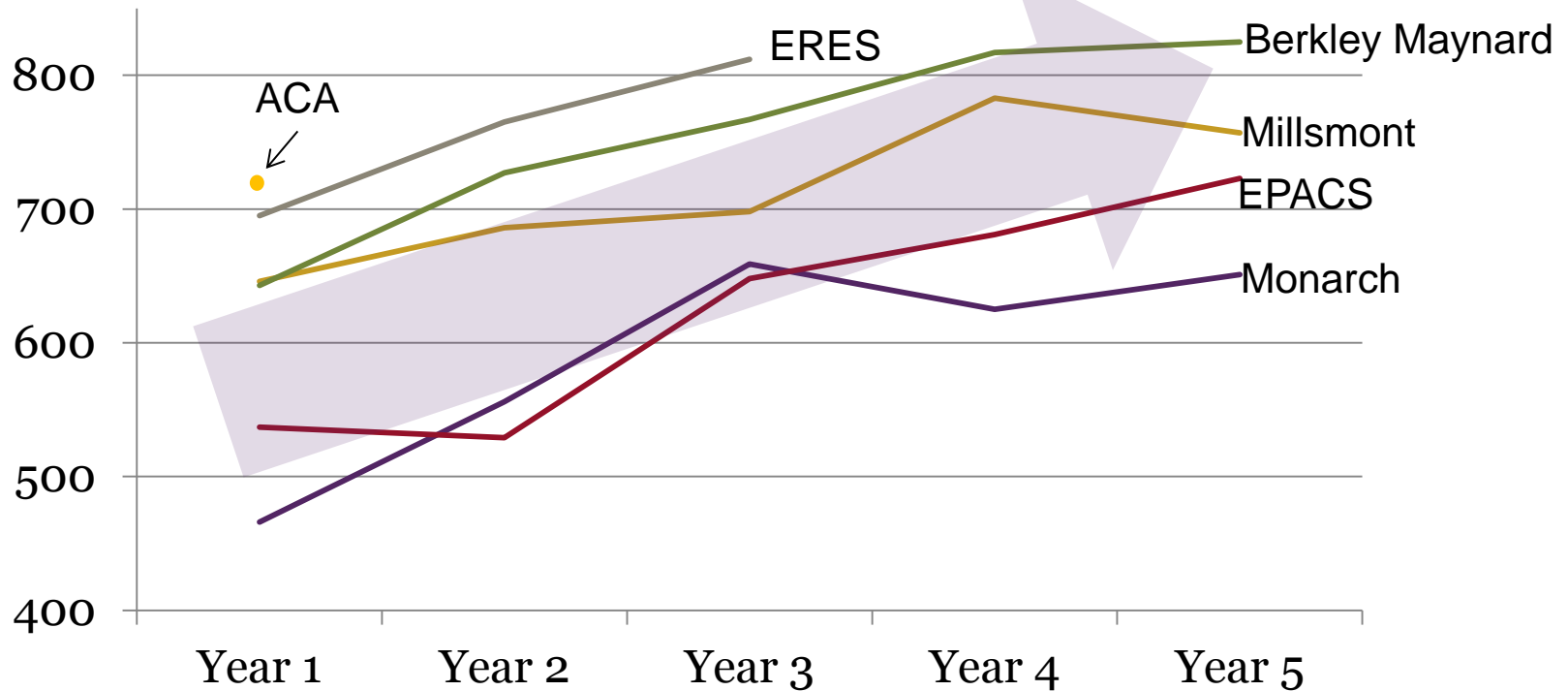
After its first year, Aspire College Academy (ACA) achieved an API of 720

Based on internal benchmarks, ACA students are on average performing better this year than last year

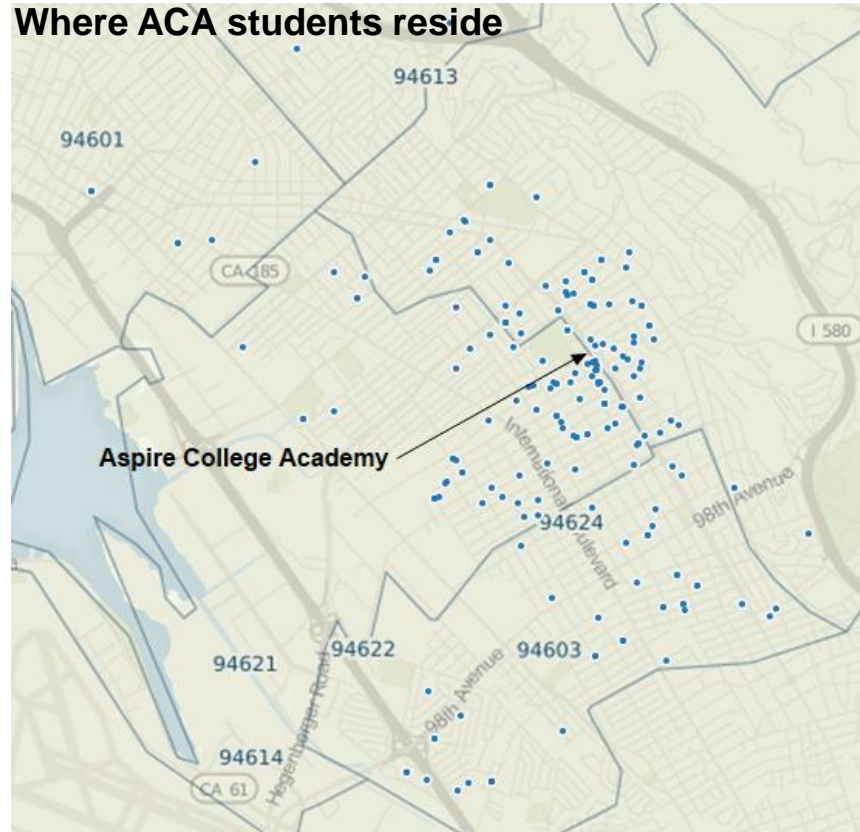
ACA Campus – 8030 Atherton Street



Student Population

- ACA – 240 students, grades K-5
- 87% of students receive Free/Reduced Lunch
- 69% Hispanic, 30% African-American
- 43% ELL, 3% Special Education
