Public Hearing and Adoption of Specific Waiver Request of Education Code Section 46206 for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 pertaining to sufficient instructional minutes at Brookfield Elementary School, Marshall Elementary School, and students promoted from those schools and attending Madison Middle School,

Alliance Middle School, and Elmhurst Community School.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Conduct Public Hearing and adopt a Specific Waiver Request of Education Code Section 46206 for Fiscal year 2005-2006 pertaining to sufficient instructional minutes at Brookfield Elementary School, Marshall Elementary School, and students promoted from those schools and attending Madison Middle School, Alliance Middle School, and Elmhurst Community Middle School.

BACKGROUND:

Education Code 46206 stipulates that the State Board of Education may waive the fiscal penalties for a school district that fails to maintain the prescribed minimum length of time for the instructional school year.

Per the 2005-2006 audit, two schools were short in instructional minutes for the school year. This oversight was due to a change in the leadership structure at both schools and miscalculation of instructional minutes. Both schools' bell schedules have been modified to add instructional minutes to the subsequent school years to ensure that the schools make up the lost time. A new system of establishing instructional minutes at schools has been put in place to ensure that all schools fulfill minimum instructional minutes requirements. The Oakland Unified School District is requesting that the State Board of Education waive the full penalty for the schools listed below with the following approved new school site schedules:

EC 46201(a)(3) Apportionment Penalty = \$262,242 for both Brookfield and Marshall Elementary Schools

Brookfield Elementary School provided 450 minutes less than the 54,000 minutes required in FY 1986-87 for grades 4 and 5 per the 05-06 audit.

Approved Schedule: The instructional times have been made up in two subsequent school years at Brookfield Elementary and the feeder middle school Madison Middle School (i.e. 2006-2007 and 2007-2008) for both the affected grades and affected students.

Marshall Elementary School provided 150 minutes less than the 54,000 minutes required in FY 1986-87 for grades 4 and 5 per the 05-06 audit.

Approved Schedule: The instructional times have been made up in two subsequent school years at Marshall Elementary and the feeder middle schools - Alliance Middle School and Elmhurst Community Middle School (i.e. 2006-2007 and 2007-2008) for both the affected grades and affected students.

The United Administrators of Oakland Schools, Building and Construction Trades Council of Alameda County, and the Brotherhood of Teamsters supported the waiver and all other bargaining units were neutral.

RECOMMENDATION:

Conduct Public Hearing and adopt a Specific Waiver Request of Education code section 46206 for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 pertaining to sufficient instructional minutes at Brookfield Elementary School and Marshall Elementary School.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Granting the waiver by the California State Board of Education will insure that the District will not be required to return \$262,452 in instructional minutes or day funding for Fiscal year 2005-2006.

RESOLUTION OF THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE OAKLAND UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Resolution N. 0809-0177 Request for Specific Waiver of Penalties – Shortfall of Instructional Minutes-Fiscal Year 2005-2006

WHEREAS, the State of California Controller's Audit of the Oakland Unified School District for the Fiscal year 2005-2006, dated 7/23/2008, found that two District schools had a shortfall of instructional minutes required to maintained during said fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the District developed a school by school remediation plan which it implemented during school years 2005 – 2007 which makes up all of the shortfall of instructional minutes for the two schools cited in the fiscal year 2005-2006 audit; and,

WHEREAS, any District suffering a shortfall of instructional minutes in any fiscal year is subject to financial penalty for failure to maintain the required instructional minutes; and,

WHEREAS, the District is subjected to \$262,452 in penalties for the shortfall of instructional minutes for the schools cited in the Fiscal Year 20005-2006 audit; and,

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 46206 permits the California State Board of Education to waive fiscal penalties for a school district that fails to maintain the prescribed length of instructional minutes in a fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the District believes that it should request the California State Board of Education for a Specific Waiver of Penalties, as delineated herein, upon showing ao good cause, for the shortfall of instructional minutes for the two schools cited in the Fiscal year 2005-2006 audit; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Education* has met the statutory prerequisites requirements including holding the required Public Hearing on the District's Request for Specific Waiver of Penalties – Shortfall of Instructional Minutes – Fiscal Year 2005-20006,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the District's Request for Specific Waiver of Penalties – Shortfall of Instructional Minutes – Fiscal year 2005-2006 for schools delineated therein, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as though fully set forth, and authorizes its submission to the California State Board of Education.

Reason for Waiver Request:

Per the 2005-2006 Audit, two schools were short in instructional minutes for the school year. This oversight was due to lack of knowledge and oversight with regard to the details of calculating instructional minutes. Each school's bell schedule has been modified to add instructional minutes to the school day in order to make up for the lost time during subsequent school years. Oakland Unified School District instituted a new online school year calendar, instructional minutes/bell schedule instrument the following year that ensures that schools develop and input a schedule that includes sufficient instructional minutes to meet minimum requirements.

Oakland Unified School District is requesting that the State Board of Education waive the full penalty for the schools listed below with the following approved new school site schedules:

EC 46201(a)(3) Apportionment Penalty = \$262,452 for both Brookfield and Marshall Elementary Schools

Brookfield provided 450 instructional minutes less than the 54,000 instructional minutes required in FY 1986-87 for grades 4 and 5 per the 2005-2006 Audit.

Approved Schedule: The instructional time has been made up in two subsequent school years at Brookfield Elementary and the feeder middle school Madison Middle School (i.e. 2006-2007 and 2007-2008) for both the affected grades and affected students.

Marshall provided 150 instructional minutes less than the 54,000 instructional minutes required in FY 1986-87 for grades 4 and 5 per the 2005-2006 Audit.

Approved Schedule: The instructional time has been made up in two subsequent school years at Marshall Elementary and the feeder middle schools of Alliance Middle School and Elmhurst Community Middle School (i.e. 2006-2007 and 2007-2008) for both the affected grades and affected students.

FINDING 06-43---Insufficient grade 4-5 Instructional minutes (30000) (40000)

Our review of the district's instructional minutes for grades 4 and 5 disclosed that its instructional minute offering was deficient as follows:

Grade Level	School Site	Actual Minutes	Required Minutes	Deficient Minutes
Grade 4-5	Brookfield	53,550	54,000	450
Grade 4-5	Marshall	53,850	54,000	150

These deficiencies occurred because of errors made in calculating instructional time.

Education Code section 46201(a)(3) requires that in the 1986-87 fiscal year:

... schools offer at least 54,000 minutes of instruction in grades 4-8 inclusive.

Education Code section 46201(d) states:

For each school district that receives an apportionment pursuant to subdivision (a) is the 1926-87 fiscal year and that reduces the amount of instructional time offered below the minimum amounts specified in either paragraph (3) of subdivision (a) or paragraph (1) of subdivision (b), whichever is applicable, to the 2003-02 fiscal year, or my fiscal year thereafter, the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall withhold from the district's revenue limit apportionment for the average duly attendance of each affected grade level, the sum of that apportionment multiplied by the percentage of the minimum offered at that grade level that the district falled to offer.

The district did not meet the instructional minutes requirements for grades 4 and 5. Therefore, a penalty assessment will be applied as follows:

The penalty for not meeting the instructional time requirement is \$262,452. The penalty was calculated on the attendance reported for grades 4 and 5.

This is a repeat of prior year Funding 05-30.

Recommendation

The district should pay the State \$262,452 for not meeting the instructional time requirement for all grades 4 and 5 during fiscal year 2005-06. The district should ensure that instructional minute calculations are performed correctly.

District's Response

The District concurs with this finding of 450 deficient manutes reported for Brookfield School (Grades 4-5).

Effective Fiscal Year 2006-2007, Technology Services created a webbased bell schedule tool to assist achool site administrators to develop schedules which more the minimum minister required by the California Education Code. Fiscal Services and Technology Services continue to the support site administrators in the use of the bell scheduling book and monator bell schedules to ensure that all schedules meet Some minimum requirements.
