OVERVIEW & OBJECTIVE,

Sixteen OUSD district schools, ten charter schools, and the Measures N and H Administrative 10% have unspent Measures N and H funds from the 2023-2024 fiscal year. MetWest High School submitted their 2023-2024 Measures N and H Carryover Plans at the January 14, 2025 Measures N and H Commission meeting. These plans articulate the context that contributed to the carryover, the amount and percentage of Measures N and H funds being carried over, and a clear budget for the carryover funds.

Per Measures N and H Commission policy, approval from the Measures N and H Commission is required for all Carryover Plans. Measures N and H staff have reviewed the submitted 2023-2024 Measures N and H Carryover Plans and provided feedback to the school sites, which was addressed before submission to the Measures N and H Commission.

This expenditure will benefit all students (197 students), specifically our African-American and ELL students, equating to 108 students. Budget: \$47.50 per hour x 72 hours + 25% Benefit Costs = \$4,275.00 x 5 teachers = \$21,375.00.

Conference Expenses: Conference expenses for MetWest staff to attend approved professional development conferences to continue their expansion of knowledge around Pathway Development & Linked Learning implementation. This expenditure supports students in the Pathway by ensuring all staff can support students as they explore the pathway, internships, and be college and career ready.
