This provision survives termination of this Agreement.
- 16. Copyright/Trademark/Patent/Ownership. CONTRACTOR understands and agrees that all matters produced under this Agreement shall become the property of OUSD and cannot be used without OUSD's express written permission. OUSD shall have all right, title and interest in said matters, including the right to secure and maintain the copyright, trademark, and/or patent of said matter in the name of OUSD. CONTRACTOR consents to use of CONTRACTOR's name in conjunction with the sale, use, performance and distribution of the matters, for any purpose and in any medium. These matters include, without limitation, drawings, plans, specifications, studies, reports, memoranda, computation sheets, the contents of computer diskettes, artwork, copy, posters, billboards, photographs, videotapes, audiotapes, systems designs, software, reports, diagrams, surveys, source codes or any other original works of authorship, or other documents prepared by CONTRACTOR or its Sub-CONTRACTORs in connection with the Services performed under this Agreement. All works shall be works for hire as defined under Title 17 of the United States Code, and all copyrights in those works are the property of OUSD.
- 17. Waiver: No delay or omission by either party in exercising any right under this Agreement shall operate as a waiver of that or any other right or prevent a similar subsequent act from constituting a violation of the Agreement.
- 18. **Termination:** OUSD may at any time terminate this Agreement upon written notice to CONTRACTOR. OUSD shall compensate CONTRACTOR for services satisfactorily provided through the date of termination. In addition, OUSD may terminate this Agreement for cause should CONTRACTOR fail to perform any part of this Agreement. In the event of termination for cause, OUSD may secure the required services from another contractor. If the cost to OUSD exceeds the cost of providing the services pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall pay the additional cost.
- 19. Conduct of Consultant. CONSULTANT will adhere to the following staff requirements and provide OUSD with evidence of staff qualifications, consistent with invoicing requirements outlined in Section 8, which include:
 - 1. Tuberculosis Screening
 - 2. Fingerprinting of Employees and Agents. The fingerprinting and criminal background investigation requirements of Education Code section 45125.1 apply to CONTRACTOR's services under this Agreement and CONTRACTOR certifies its compliance with these provisions as follows: "CONTRACTOR certifies that CONTRACTOR has complied with the fingerprinting and criminal background investigation requirements of Education Code section 45125.1 with respect to all CONTRACTOR's employees, subcontractors, agents, and subcontractors' employees or agents ("Employees") regardless of whether those Employees are paid or unpaid, concurrently employed by OUSD, or acting as independent contractors of CONTRACTOR, who may have contact with OUSD pupils in the course of providing services pursuant to the Agreement, and the California Department of Justice has determined that none of those Employees has been convicted of a felony, as that term is defined in Education Code section 45122.1. - 21. OUSD's Evaluation of CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR's Employees and/or Subcontractors. OUSD may evaluate the CONTRACTOR's work in any way that OUSD is entitled to do so pursuant to applicable law. The OUSD's evaluation may include, without limitation:
 - Requesting that OUSD employee(s) evaluate the CONTRACTOR and the CONTRACTOR's employees and subcontractors and each of their performance.
 - 2. Announced and unannounced observance of CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR's employee(s), and/or subcontractor(s).

- 22. Limitation of OUSD Liability. 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TAO SHI

Professional Experience and Background:

Mr. Tao Shi started studying the Er Hu, a traditional Chinese string instrument, at age seven. In 1984, he won the First Performance Award in the National Folk Instrument Contest. In 1990, he earned his bachelor degree with honors from the prestigious Nan Jing Normal University, where he double-majored in Er Hu and piano. During his career as an Er Hu performer, Mr. Shi has won national awards on many occasions in China. He has also dedicated himself to music education. In 1996, for example, he was in charge of developing a series of teaching materials for both elementary and high school, which was adopted for use nationally in China.

Since making the Bay Area his home in 1999, Mr. Shi has performed as an Er Hu soloist and appeared widely in local community performances. In July 2000, he gave a successful Er Hu recital at Yerba Buena center. In May 2001, he played the Er Hu as a special guest on the occasion held at Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption for the remembrance of the victims of the Nan Jing Massacre. At the end of 2002, Mr. Shi and his students from the Purple Silk Music Education Foundation's programs were invited by TV Channel 32 to perform classic Christmas songs by using Chinese traditional instruments. In April 2004, Mr. Shi performed the Concerto "Parting of the Newly Weds" with the Pro Art Symphony Orchestra.

Currently, Mr. Shi is pursuing a career in music education. He has been invited to be an instructor of Er Hu and piano in Purple Silk's programs at Lincoln elementary school and Laney College in Oakland, and the Clarion Music Center in San Francisco. He also maintains a private teaching studio. He now teaches vocals with Purple Silk's core program, the Great Wall Youth Orchestra and Chorus, a free weekend program for 1-12 grade students held at Laney College.

Responsibilities Related to the OCFP-AIS Residency:

Mr. Shi has served as a Music Coach for the Purple Silk Chinese Music Program at the International Community School, and Lincoln School . In this capacity, he had received training from Ms. Sherlyn Chew in pedagogy and curriculum development and provide individual and small group instruction for students in traditional Chinese string instruments and piano. He also performed and demonstrated the playing of these instruments for participating students. He coordinated instruction with the other PSMEF artists assigned to these sites, as well as with the on-site classroom teacher, Victor Siu
