Kyla Johnson-Trammell made the presentation of the Superintendent's Report.

Johnson-Trammell provided updates on District Priorities, Fiscal Vitality, Quality Community Schools and Organizational Reliance.

The District is seeking support from the Sweetened Soda Beverage Tax Advisory Board for funding of a variety of health and wellness programs including monies to support the reinstatement of the supper meal program.

The Student Welcome Center purchased and distributed 130 Chrome Books to school sites to support reaching the goal of 100% participation of transition grade students in the enrollment options process.

Graduation Rates Increase - The District is celebrating the just-released news that the 2017-2018 graduation rates show strong progress over the previous year's, which had already shown dramatic improvement.

EBMUD is continuing to sample water at Child Development Centers. The expanded sampling program is a slow process as all samples must be procured prior to any staff or students arriving to the site (generally 4-5 in the morning).

Retention and recruitment includes incentives to attract top talent.
