




#### **Grade K i-Ready Diagnostic Reading** Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison








### **Grade 3 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading** Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison



### **Grade 4 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading** Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison




#### **Grade 5 i-Ready Diagnostic Reading** Spring Mid-Above & Fall-Spring Growth 3 Year Comparison






