


Our mission is to provide a rigorous college preparatory education and character development program that will prepare students from underserved communities to succeed in college and beyond.



ELA Distance from Standard (Over Time)





In response to our higher need student population, OCHS has:

- Contracted with IXL and Lexia as supplemental programs to increase student mastery on targeted skills
- > Built a regular calendar of STEM-based extracurricular activities
- > Hired a Director of Instruction to implement instructional coaching
- Monitored student progress in monthly data meetings
- > Secured additional professional development opportunities



Oakland Charter High prepares students for postsecondary success, both college or career.





College Enrollment Rates (Fall Semester After Graduation)





Chronic Absenteeism Rates (Over Time)



In every year of the charter term, students at OCHS outperformed the District in both ELA and Math proficiency. Students grow at above average rates in both subjects.



OCHS's cohort graduation and CCI rates exceeded the District, State, and Resident Schools in every year of its charter term.



OCHS has maintained **consistently low suspension** rates year over year, with an average rate of 2.9% during the charter term.
