Ask of the Commission Approve the allocation of \$1,070,435.36 of the surplus annually for the next three years and revisit during the 2024-25 school year to make any adjustments to surplus distribution for the final three years of the measure.

**Background** 

The Middle School Network and staff are requesting that Staff is requesting the G1 Commision to approve a proposal to begin spending down the \$6,422,612.14 dollar surplus that has accumulated during the first 6 years of Measure G1. Specifically, the request is to approve allocating \$1,070,435.36 of the surplus annually for the next three years: 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25 based on the same per pupil formula. This allocation will result in a surplus allocation annually for the next three years, ensuring that half of the current surplus gets allocated by 2025. We revisit the amount of surplus remaining during the 2024-25 school year to make any adjustments to surplus distribution for the final three years of the measure.

## Proposal for Commission Regarding the Student Surplus of \$6,422,612.14

Staff is requesting the G1 Commision to approve a proposal to begin spending down the \$6,422,612.14 dollar surplus that has accumulated during the first 6 years of Measure G1. Specifically, the request is to approve allocating \$1,070,435.36 of the surplus annually for the next three years: 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25 based on the same per pupil formula. This allocation will result in a surplus allocation annually for the next three years, ensuring that half of the current surplus gets allocated by 2025.

Currently, there is a surplus of \$6,422,612.14. To fulfill the intent of Measure G1 to positively impact students, OUSD staff recommends the following:

- 1. The surplus will be evenly distributed over the remaining six years of the measure, beginning with the 2022-23 school year. This would amount to approximately \$1,070,435.36 per year, or \$131.84 more per student.
- 2. We revisit the amount of surplus remaining during the 2024-25 school year to make any adjustments to surplus distribution for the final three years of the measure.
