Cate Boskoff, Facilities Counsel, provided the New Member Orientation. Ms. Boskoff reviewed the Brown Act Requirements.

#### Brown Act

Purpose – To keep the public informed of the actions, debates and view of locally elected representatives and advisory committees that are standing committees having continuing subject matter jurisdiction or fixed meeting schedules – Government Code 54952.

#### What constitutes a meeting?

Anytime email messages are sent, text messages or correspondence among the committee in which a majority of the committee is copied, that's a meeting.

Secretary Rakestraw noted when the committee is together attending an affair, as long as committee members don't substantively talk about District business in relation to the committee it's okay.

Ms. Boskoff said once a sub-committee is formed but not regularly scheduled does not have to be Brown Act Compliant.

Secretary Rakestraw noted a majority of the committee should not get together informally and talk about anything substantively regarding duties on the committee without it being a noticed meeting.

Jean Moore wanted to know the District's policy or the Brown Act policy regarding recording of committee meetings.

Ms. Boskoff said all public meetings are capable of being videotaped or audio taped.

Secretary Rakestraw said the District records all substantive meetings of any Body that's meeting. He noted the Measure B Committee is a high public interest committee. The District also has the capability for mobile telecast and broadcast over the internet or by television from a remote location.

Chairperson Williams said the General Waiver will allow for Andrea Dawson and Christopher Vernon [whose terms ended in June] to serve an additional term on the committee.

Secretary Rakestraw said one of the requirements for seeking a waiver to term limits, the committee will have to support the request for the extension of terms. Currently State Statue only gives a maximum of two consecutive terms to appointees. In order to seek an additional term, the District will have to seek a waiver from the State Board of Education. If the committee supports this waiver, the matter will go to the Board for approval on September 12th.

Odest Logan wanted to know how long would the waiver extend the terms?

Secretary Rakestraw said the terms are two years from June 11, 2012.

Renee Swayne said it was her understanding that the new bond will have a new committee.

Secretary Rakestraw said there will be a new Measure J Committee if the bond measure passes. He said that does not preclude the Board from assigning the responsibility of carrying out the duties of that committee to an existing committee as it did with Measure A.

#### Committee Site Visits Report of July 13, 2012 and August 3, 2012

Presentation of Committee Site Visits Report of July 13, 2012 and August 3, 2012.

Randy Horne, Facilities Department described the site visits as "a very aggressive summer program". He said all the sites opened up and students were not disrupted.

#### Highlights

- Approximately 30 projects summer only and summer plus [projects scheduled to go beyond the start of school].
- Projects ranged from fire alarm replacements, new football field at Madison Middle School and new construction at Montclair Elementary School and Calvin Simmons Middle School.
- Approximately \$36 million of work was done across the summer.
- Coordinated with over 100 venders with many Oakland vendors.

#### Committee Member Comments

Lisa Young asked Mr. Horne the percentage of local vendors used.

Mr. Horne said the District's policy is 20% but he thinks the number is upward of 30% to 40% local participation. He noted the lease leaseback projects demand a high percentage of approximately 50% to 60% local participation.

July 13th - Webster Elementary, Stonehurst CDC, Sobrante Park Elementary and Madison Middle School

Webster Elementary School, kitchen upgrade.

Stonehurst CDC, new classroom building and kitchen area.

Sobrante Park Elementary, new play structure and new artificial surface.

Madison Middle School, new artificial multi-use field.

Chairperson Williams noted at the Stonehurst site visit, the project manager worked closely with the neighbors to inform them of the construction and address any concerns.

Renee Swayne spoke of vandalism she heard had occurred on the Madison Middle School campus and wanted to know what funds will the repairs come out of.

David Colbert, Facilities Department said Measure B funds.

August 3rd - La Escuelita Elementary, Sankofa Elementary and Oakland High School

La Escuelita Educational Cente, State Superintendent of Public Instruction spoke regarding investing in school infrastructure.

Sankofa Elementary, work was done on the north side of the building upstairs and downstairs with new lighting and painting. Next summer the south side will be completed. This project had 60% local vendor participation.

Oakland High School project had most of the work completed. The new restroom in Building G will be completed in about one week.

Piedmont Elementary project is work in collaboration with the City of Oakland.

Renee Swayne said with the bond measure on the November ballot, she wishes the District would let the community know the good work being done with Measure B funds.

Odest Logan suggested a media tour to see some of the site work.

Renee Swayne said all the site work is impressive and well done.

Chairperson Williams said the site visits are very important and shows the work being done in the District.
