We are seeking funding of \$36,500 to partially fund salary and benefits for one Education Pioneer Analyst Fellow to help to develop and pilot School Quality Review process for the Office of Quality Community School Development (QCSD). School Quality Review Pilot, 2011-12 Starting in November 2011, Oakland Unified School District began piloting a research-based School Quality Review process -- based on School Quality Standards developed and selected in consultation with community and youth, and other school districts across the country. These standards were formally approved by our school board in June 2011. The school quality review process evaluates the extent to which schools live up to our School Quality Standards. In

order to measure this, we must take into account multiple perspectives, and to evaluate both the inputs (schooling process) and outputs (results).
