How will this grant contribute to sustained student achievement or academic standards?	The Shoo the Flu program contributes to sustained student achievement because it is employing a health preventative strategy with predictable outcomes by vaccinating students against the flu virus. The OUSD nurses will conduct seasonal flu vaccinations at selected OUSD elementary schools and Early Childhood Education sites during the Fall 2015 Shoo the Flu program; subsequently reducing absenteeism related to the seasonal flu virus.
How will this grant be evaluated for impact upon student achievement? (Customized data design and technical support are provided at 1% of the grant award or at a negotiated fee for a community-based fiscal agent who is not including OUSD's indirect rate of 5.94% in the budget. The 1% or negotiated data fee will be charged according to an Agreement for Grant Administration Related Services payment schedule. This fee should be included in the grant's budget for evaluation.)	Daily attendance is correlated with student achievement. We will monitor school sites' attendance and reported illnesses during flu season.
Does the grant require any resources from the school(s) or district? If so, describe.	Yes, OUSD nurses will have to attend a 2-hour training, conduct flu vaccinations, and attend a 1-hour debrief session. We expect their involvement will add additional credence to this vaccination program among school staff, students, and parents/guardians.



Dear Mr. Sarikey,

I am pleased to inform you that Shoo the Flu, LLC is committed to financially supporting Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) nurses to conduct seasonal flu vaccinations at OUSD elementary schools and early childhood education sites during the Fall 2015 Shoo the Flu program. The OUSD Health and Wellness Unit expects up to 20 OUSD nurses to volunteer to support up to 3 Shoo the Flu vaccination clinics this fall. The final value of their stipend will be based on the following activities:

- A 2-hour training (overview of Shoo the Flu and practical vaccination module)
- Attendance vaccinating at 1 to 3 Shoo the Flu Vaccine Days, present from the beginning to end of each clinic.
 - Attendance at 1 clinic is \$150
 - Attendance at 2 clinics is \$300
 - Attendance at 3 clinics is \$450
- A 1-hour group debrief/evaluation meeting

The exact figure of our commitment will be finalized once all participating nurse activities are tallied but it will not exceed \$9,000.

This is a new and exciting dimension to our Shoo the Flu collaboration and we are looking forward to having OUSD nurse volunteers participating. We expect their involvement will add additional credence to this vaccination program among school staff, students, and parents/guardians.
