GENERAL PURPOSE FUND TRANSFER TO DISTRICT'S CHARTER SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the District's 32 charter schools have not been formal beneficiaries of revenues from the District's parcel tax or other local discretionary funds which puts the charter schools at a disadvantage vis-à-vis their peer schools; and

WHEREAS, the District supports all students who are served in Oakland public schools, including charter and traditional schools, there is potentially an equity problem in this situation with regard to the eight thousand students served by charter schools in Oakland; and


WHEREAS, local students enrolled in the District's charter schools are by-and-large thriving academically in those settings; and

WHEREAS, the District unsuccessfully attempted to put a measure on the ballot to provide new revenues to the District and to also remedy the inequitable funding between the traditional and charter schools; and

WHEREAS, although a more permanent solution to this funding inequity is desired, an interim measure is required,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the State Administrator approves a one-time transfer of funds from the District's General Purpose Fund to each of the District's charter schools in the equivalent amount of \$60.00 per pupil enrolled in the charter school, as set forth in the schedule attached as Exhibit A, for a total of approximately \$449,520.00.
