WHEREAS, the Commission, at its Regular Meeting on May 5, 2026 reviewed and affirmed its findings of named high schools’ implementing Measures N and H to date and, consequently, determined and adopted Measure H Education Improvement Plan Implementation and Budget 2026-2027 School Year (Allocation - Measure H and Measure H Strategic Carryover) for each school named in attached Exhibit “A” as stated, and up to 10% of Funds for Administrative Purposes and hereby recommends approval of same by the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Commission, at said meeting also adopted the 2026-2027 Education Improvement Plan and Assessment for each school named in attached Exhibit “A” and hereby recommends approval of the same by the Board of Education,
