Jean Moore asked about the Committee receiving and reviewing Deferred Maintenance Proposals and reviewing cost saving measures of the District and wanted to know how previous Measure "B" Committees addressed these two tasks.

Ms. Boskoff said since the inception of Measure "B" no Committee Members have done the two tasks.

Mr. Love said he did not believe there are any Deferred Maintenance Projects funded under Measure "B" and that is probably why the Committee does not perform that task.

Ms. Boskoff said early on in the Bond program there was some Deferred Maintenance but right now there are not any. She said Deferred Maintenance Projects can be funded by Measure "B".

Randy Horne said projects such as Fire Alarm Replacement and Intrusion Alarms is work done in coordination with the Buildings and Grounds Department to update and maintain. He said a list of those projects can be prepared for Committee Members.

Jean Moore said if the Committee does receive that information, would that be something included in the Annual Report?

Andrea Dawson said Fire Alarms and Intrusion Alarms are already included in the Annual Report.

Ms. Boskoff said regarding the cost saving measures, she was not sure if the document refers to value engineering designs savings or cost saving measures that relate to decisions on how to deal with solar projects. She said she can get that information to Committee Members.

Renee Swayne asked about the District Facilities Master and wanted to know if it is part of the Committee's purview?

Ms. Boskoff it is not under Measure "B" because the Facilities Master Plan is looking forward at what might be in the future Capital Program.

Andrea Dawson said she thinks Director Gallo's point is that some of the projects have more than one phase of construction. She talked about Jefferson Elementary Schools. She said some of the community and public might not understand how that happened. She said it was a result of previous determinations of the Facility Master Plan and the Board of Education to go to a small school model. She said the District is having outreach in each District and wondered how people are notified of the meetings. She said she received a robo call regarding one of the meetings.

Chairperson Williams said whether or not the Committee is part of the discussion informing the Committee is appropriate. She said the outreach for the next Bond Measure Committee Members can be good advocates for the community why the Bond is important.

Ms. Boskoff said because of the limited charge of the Committee, to be a major stakeholder in the process is not appropriate.

David Colbert said he can provide the Committee the current list of the meetings for the next five weeks. He said if a presentation was made to the Committee, it would be the same presentation in the various regions.

Randy Horn said the main purpose of the meetings is to inform and provide input. The Road Show is to inform the community about the District's Facility Master Plan and the needs that have been determined and to provide input from stakeholders across the District. He said given the Committee's historical prospective with the Bond and the previous Bond and going forward, will shape the input process regarding which projects are important.

Chairperson Williams encouraged Committee Members to attend one or more meetings. She said if there is the chance for Public Comments, Committee Members can talk about what they have seen; what's going on in the District; how important the work is; and the good work that is being done by the District.

Randy Horn said he will prepare a packet together with a list of upcoming meetings as well as the handouts distributed during the meetings and have the Board Office email the packet to Committee Members.

Odest Logan wanted to know if the cost savings were overall, by site, by project; prior to construction or during construction. He said that might be something that is covered if a presentation is made to the Committee.

Andrea Dawson talked about State Matching Funds for Measure "B".

Ms. Boskoff said it is never dollar for dollar. The money coming back from the State is not Measure "B" money. She said the matching funds were a result of Measure "B" funds, they have to be used for capital improvements and can go back to the project it came from. She said that is why it's not under the Committee's purview. She said it is important for the Committee to know how much comes back in because it does grow the size of the Bond and there is no reason why the Committee doesn't know how much was brought back in.
