With the beautification project as a starting point we were able to change the student's perspectives of alternative education. Our school site was drab, dull, and depressing. With the simple addition of plants, greenery, and the picking up of dead leaves and foliage we have made a transition to school pride, that has helped us affect attendance, and thereby increase work completion and graduation.
