In a 2012 study of athletes from Kansas, Lumpkin and Favor found "high school athletes earned higher grades, graduated at a higher rate, dropped out of school less frequently, and scored higher on state assessments than did non-athletes". Similar conclusions were reached at Univ of N. Carolina Chapel Hill in a 2017 study which found that school sports participation was significantly associated with academic achievement, positive body-image perceptions, and self-esteem.
