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# OUSD Charter Renewal Standards

<b>I. The school is academically sound</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Renewal tier analysis</li><li>• School Performance Analysis (State Dashboard and CORE growth data)</li><li>• Key student group performance comparisons</li><li>• School Quality Review site visit</li><li>• Performance Improvement Plan (if applicable)</li></ul>
<b>II: The school is demonstrably likely to be able to implement the proposed program</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Finances</li><li>• Enrollment trends and demographics</li><li>• Notices of Concern</li><li>• Board health/effectiveness</li></ul>
<b>III: The school's plans for a future charter term are "reasonably comprehensive"</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Required charter petition elements/information</li></ul>
<b>IV: The school is serving all students who wish to attend</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• State-provided enrollment data</li><li>• Any substantiated complaints related to suspension/expulsion violations</li></ul> <p>(NOTE: Ed Code limits consideration to only these data sources.)</p>

# Strengths and Challenges

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## Strengths

- Strong CORE growth in recent years, in both ELA and Math, both overall and for most student groups at the school.
- Performance among a majority of key student groups is above the OUSD average in a majority of years.
- Met all indicators of the School Performance Analysis in all 3 years.
- Low suspension rates, both overall and for all key student groups considered.

## Challenges

- Students with disabilities have consistently performed lower than the OUSD average for this student group.
- Low percentage of students with disabilities at the school: 7%, compared to OUSD average of 13%.

# Renewal Tier Analysis

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- AB 1505 introduced a new 3-tiered system for charter renewal
- State identified the renewal tier (Low, Middle, or High) for each school based on its State Dashboard indicators
- Achieve met **Middle Tier** criteria

## Renewal Decision Requirements - Middle Tier Schools


- Eligible for 5-year renewal term
- May only be denied for academic reasons if the Board makes **all** of the following written findings:
  - The school has failed to make sufficient progress toward meeting standards for students, AND
  - Closure is in the best interest of students, AND
  - The decision provided greater weight to academic performance





### Economically Disadvantaged Hispanic/Latinx Students








### Economically Disadvantaged Students




### English Learner Students




