Facilities Planning & Management remains committed to providing impactful summer internship opportunities that foster skill development for students pursuing interests in planning, design, and construction.

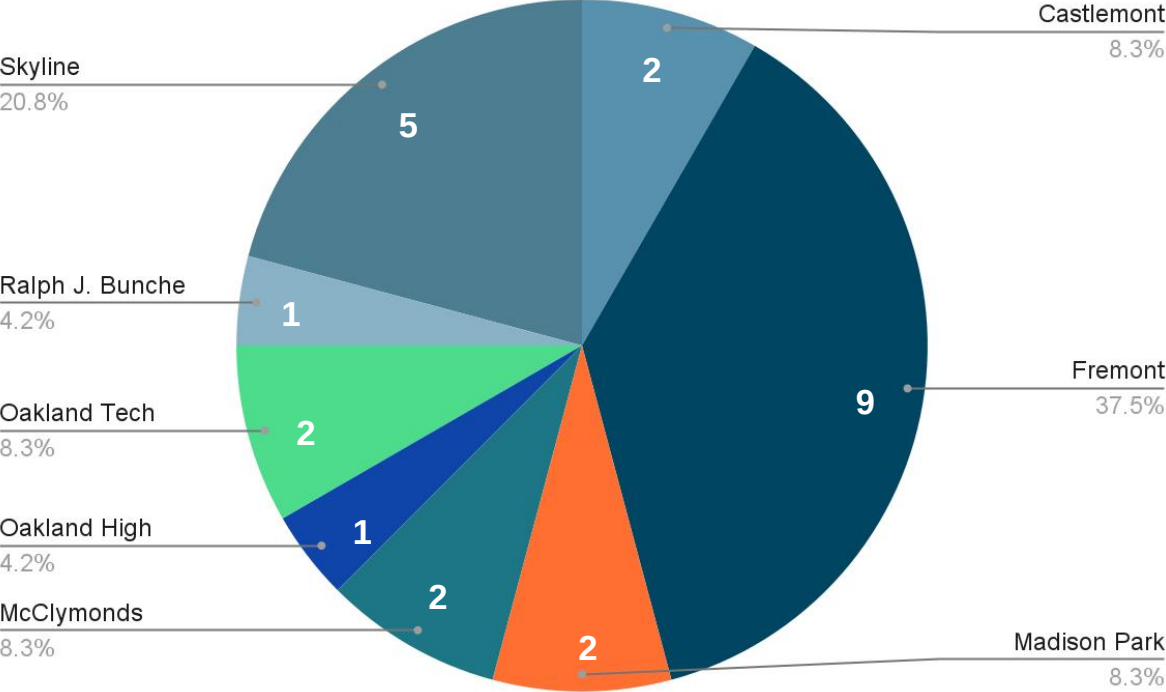

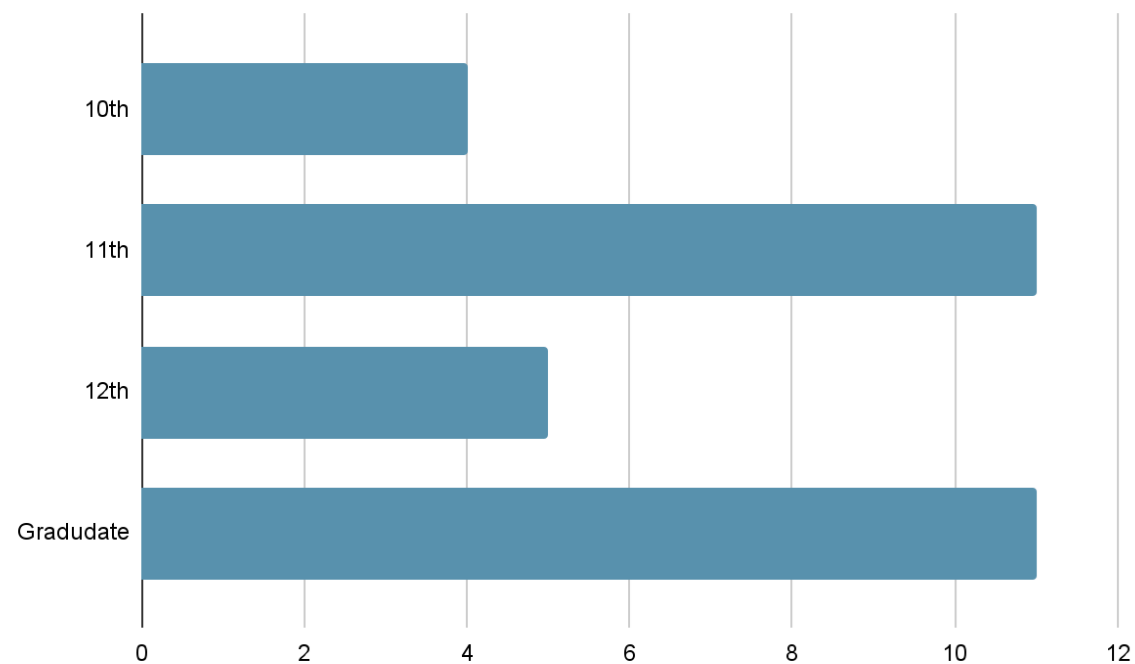

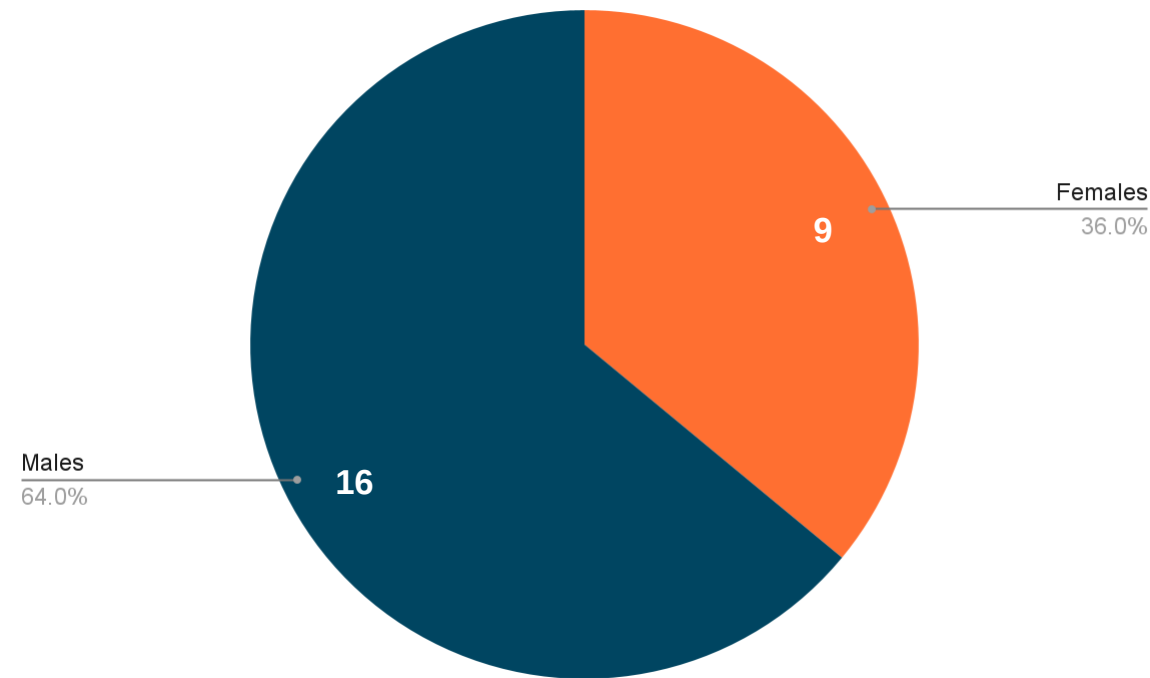

2022

Facilities relaunched its summer internship program.

3 external firms offered positions.

3 students were awarded positions.

\$15 per hour base rate of pay

2023

Professional development and mentorship were added to the program.

3 external firms offered positions.

4 students were awarded positions.

\$15 per hour base rate of pay

2024

Facilities partnered w/ ECCCO*. B&G and Custodial positions were funded.

3 external firms offered positions.

13 internal positions were offered through Buildings & Grounds and Custodial Services.

16 students were awarded positions.

\$16 per hour base rate of pay

2025

Created a student advisor role to support interns throughout their internship experience.

2 external firms offered positions.

2 students were awarded positions.

\$18 per hour base rate of pay

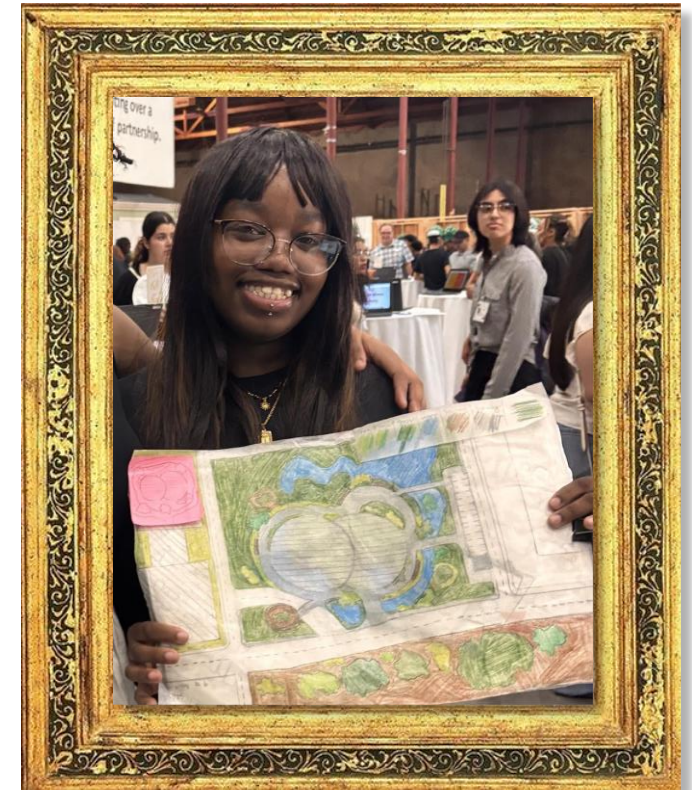
