BACKGROUND

In keeping with the Oakland Unified School District's commitment to the improvement and development of its K-12 facilities, the District has embarked on a groundbreaking plan to create a district-wide modernization of the District's schools.

STRATEGIC ALIGNMENT

Among the key purposes of the District's Facilities Master Plan is to provide an academic environment for the Oakland community that will give every student, educator, and community member using our facilities the best possible opportunity for learning.

Through implementation of the Facilities Master Plan, the District intends to improve the District's facilities in terms of structural integrity, safety, reliability of operating (mechanical) systems, access to modern resources, number and type of appropriate laboratories and specialized instruction rooms, opportunities for physical education, and attractiveness, such that the Oakland Public Schools are second to none. Operation of the District schools under the planned approach is intended to ensure safety, cleanliness, and orderliness for all individuals participating in the learning process.

The basic facility needs of students such as proper lighting, functional roofs, noise control and well maintained buildings, not only convey the message that we value our students and teachers but may foster a sense of school pride and community ownership which may improve attitudes towards learning. The implementation of the Facilities Master Plan is our first step in that direction.

FISCAL IMPACT

The funding source for this project budget is General Obligation Bond-Measure B.





Burckhalter Walkthrough and Preliminary Space Analysis.

October 31, 2011

Exterior Access

- 1. Clarify the flow of drop off traffic—preference to pull up to the school from the south end of Burckhalter, exiting right to Sunnymere Avenue or left to Seminary
- 2. Present of a Crossing Guard to assist neighborhood kid who walk to school

Classroom Use/Reconfiguration

- 3. On the East side of the Building A Level One. Potential to create three classrooms out of two existing, storage and support space (Total 2700 sf)
- 4. Potential additional classroom from underused teacher lunch/break space and kitchen (total 679 sf)
- Potential additional small classroom with the use of the exiting Music Room (Total 429 sf)—Stage is currently used for music and works well.
- 6. Room 1 is currently unused (part of number 3)
- 7. Room 3 and Room 24 are currently being used by small SDC classes—opportunity to move one SDC's into smaller classrooms (e.g. music room or in another one of the additional created classrooms.
- 8. Room 3 is a current underutilized classroom. Faith network uses the space to tutor students 2 afternoons out of the week. Other space can easily support this function.

Outdoor

- Building B- Cafeteria, is a somewhat constrained space. There are currently 2.5 lunch periods and a better used of outdoor seating (with the addition of a covered area could relieve the congestion. Further the space could be utilized as and outdoor teaching area.
- 10. The southern edge of the campus play area if rarely used. Suggestion to groups several of the bench seats—possibly under a covered canopy to maximize their use.
- 11. The community garden is desired to expand to closely meet that of the size and scope of the Lakeview garden. Possible relocation of the garden raised beds to an area away from the busy Edwards Avenue to better support a teaching environment. Possible locations near exiting drain for water runoff.
- X The X marks the former location of portable builds when the school was closed to address an issue of mold.

Potential space issues

Multipurpose space can only accommodate 330 people—(50 short of the 380)

Add Scope New Lunch
