PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES: MATH

- ◆ Bi-monthly grade level collaboration and review of assessment data (3rd Wednesday of the month)
- ◆ Teachers were led through a process of 'unpacking' the standards during a math collaboration meeting.
- ◆ Grade levels identified the 'high leverage' mathematics standards in preparation for the upcoming CST exam.
- ◆ Math coaching grades 3-4
- ◆ During testing K-1 math coaching



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIES: READING

- ◆ Teachers attend Dates with Data and facilitate their team meetings.
- ◆ Teachers attended a Saturday session for mapping lesson 3-4 hour sessions.
- ◆ Our Open Court coach visits each classroom each week. She has facilitated work in strengthening their use of the comprehension strategies.
- ◆ Schoolwide we have focused staff development meetings on fluency, reading professional articles on fluency and discussing high leverage fluency strategies.



PARENT INVOLVEMENT

- ◆ The school sends out bi-monthly parent updates with regard to the academic program, SAIT initiatives and testing.
- ◆ Parents participate in SSC.
- **◆** SARC/SART meetings.
- ◆ A few parents volunteer daily.
- **→** Two literacy nights have been held.
