School Mission



- School Leadership Lighthouse Parent Advisory Committee, Lighthouse Staff Positions




Teachers as Learners

- Ongoing Support & Development Mentoring, Instructional Coaching, & Model Classrooms




Our Results Academic Performance Index






Our Results ELA Proficiency Levels
