PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will be located in a renovated portion of the basement at Oakland Technical High School to provide a new, larger health care facility that will replace the existing portable that houses the Health Clinic. The design of the new clinic will meet state healthcare facility requirements and will be a licensed clinic.

The Health Clinic will support two main functions, a medical/dental zone and a mental/behavioral zone. The layout will help to limit noise and allow for privacy and a quieter zone.

There will be two main entries to the clinic. The reception desk will be located in the center of waiting area and will have visual site lines of both entries to the clinic so staff can see clients/students entering the clinic.

The new Health Clinic will feature:

- Offices for medical/dental staff and health education, mental/behavior health, and a site supervisor
- Large and small conference rooms for meetings
- Student lounge area for students to gather for activities and events

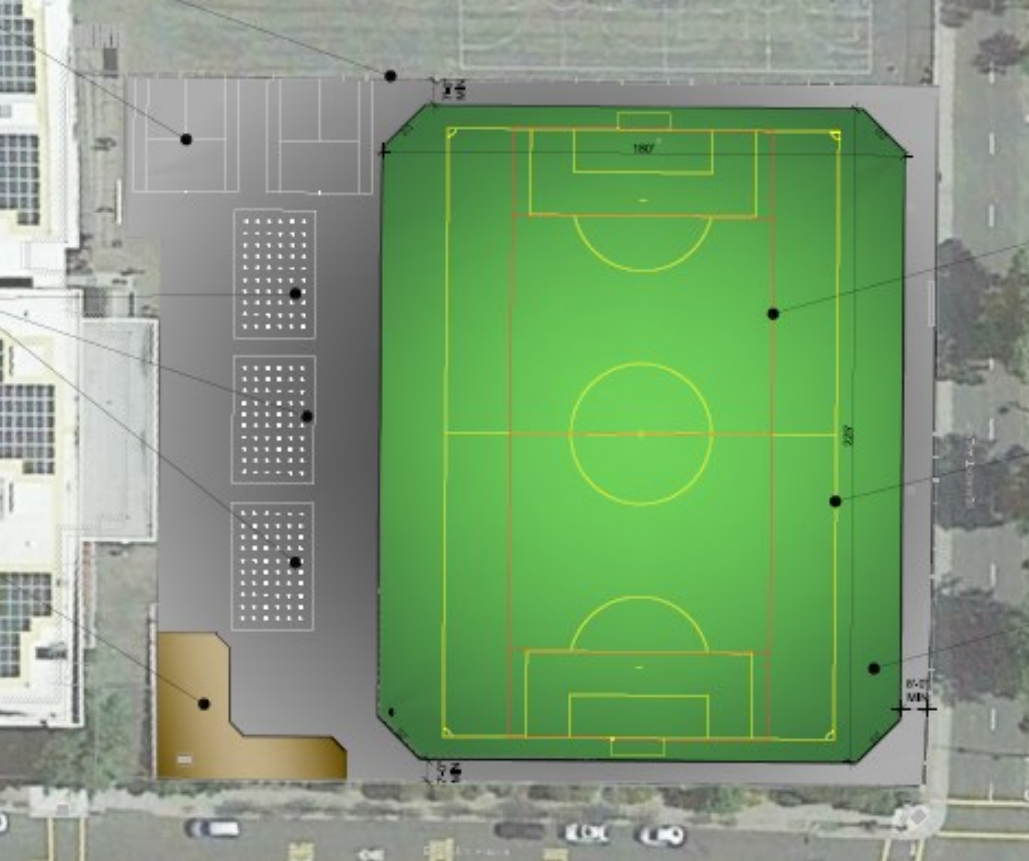

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Edna Brewer students and staff will have access to a new synthetic turf field in the lower yard area, adjacent to the gym. The existing asphalt play yard will be replaced with a turf field. The project may also include striping for two half size tennis courts and line up stations marked on the asphalt against the existing retaining wall. Parts of the remaining asphalt in the lower yard area will also be painted with markings to support physical education classes. New landscaping will be planted in a corner of the lower play yard.
