The suspects then pulled out what appeared to be a firearm and the victim heard shots. Victim advised he knew who the suspects were because they all attend the school. On 10OCT18, all three suspects arrived on campus. Officers took custody of the suspects.

Officers responded to a report of a large fight and shots fired which involved Caslemont students on 88th Ave. Upon arrival officers located a victim with a gunshot wound. The victim was identified as a Caslemont staff member. The suspect was identified as a Caslemont student, and a warrant for his arrest was later issued. Suspect had relationship with officer assigned to Caslemont, suspect contacted the officer and turned himself in to the officer.
