Improve Leadership

The Board of Education seeks to:

- Establish a career ladder of teacher leadership roles focused on supporting Priority Schools and new teachers.
- Allow teachers with exemplary performance to engage in an alternative to evaluation that enables them to provide meaningful instructional leadership to their school or District-wide.
