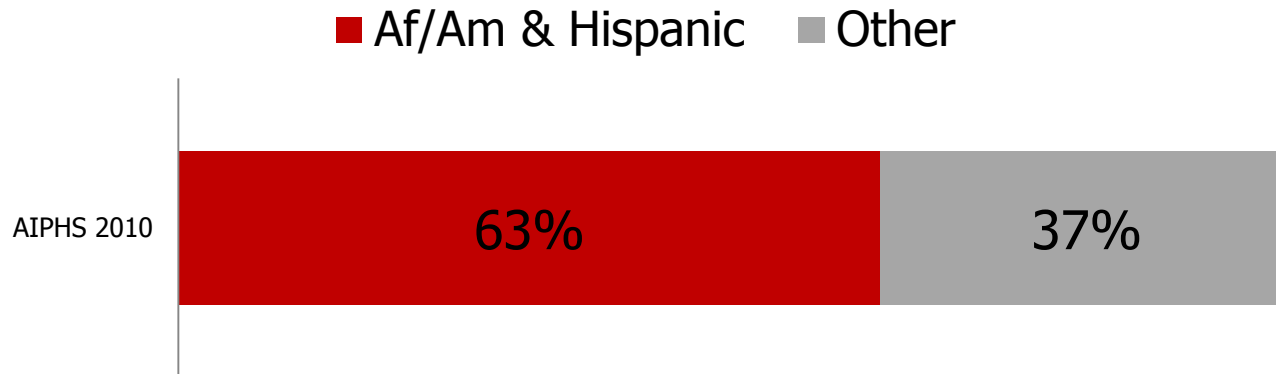

# Access to AP Exams and Performance Results for Public High School Graduates

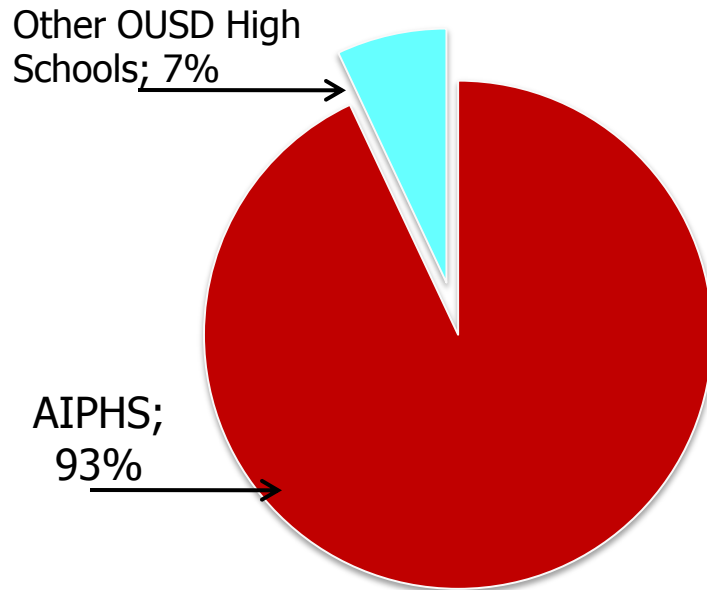


## Graduates with Passing AP Scores by Ethnicity

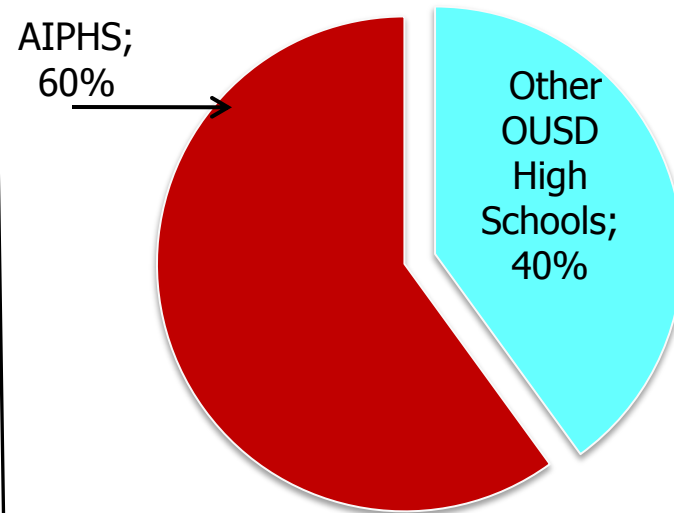


# Total African-American & Hispanic Students Passing AP Exams(OUSD, 2010)


