

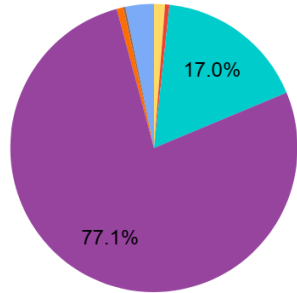


Aspire Golden State College Preparatory Academy: Charter Renewal Term 2026-2031

We approach every facet of education through an equity lens and prioritize our efforts through three main focus areas.



INCLUSION MODEL FOR ALL LEARNERS

We ensure all scholars are meaningfully engaged in an inclusive model. Students with IEPs (special education) are integrated authentically in mainstream classrooms



SOCIAL EMOTIONAL WELLNESS AND STRONG RELATIONSHIPS

We cultivate communities that foster inclusive and joyful learning environments. All students have at least 1 adult on campus who is an advocate and support (advisory model supports this school design element)

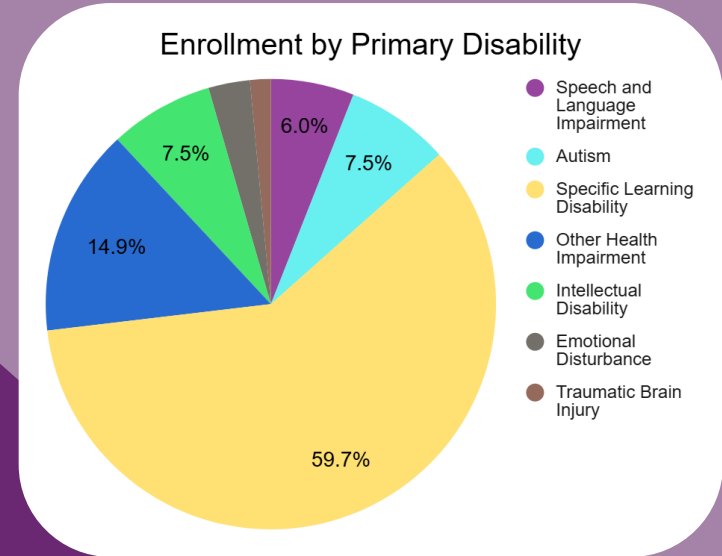


COLLEGE AND CAREER FOCUSED

We equip students with the skills, knowledge, and experiences needed to succeed in higher education and the workforce. Through academics, career exploration, and real-world learning opportunities such as internships and dual enrollment, students graduate prepared to thrive in college, career, and life.

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVES 17% OF OUR STUDENTS

- One-fourth of these students receive more than 450 service minutes weekly

 - Other Transition Services



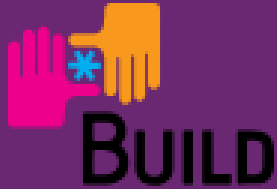

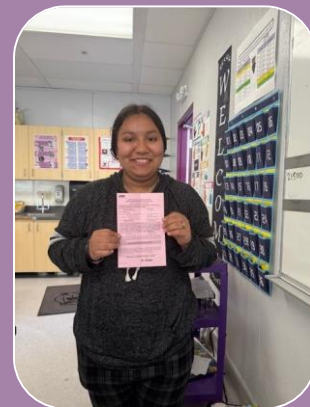
ENTREPRENEURSHIP PATHWAY

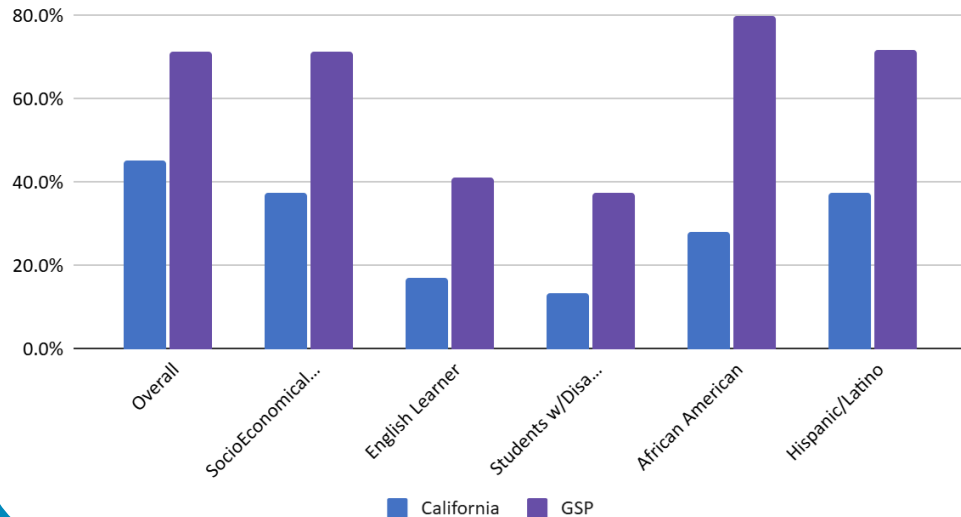

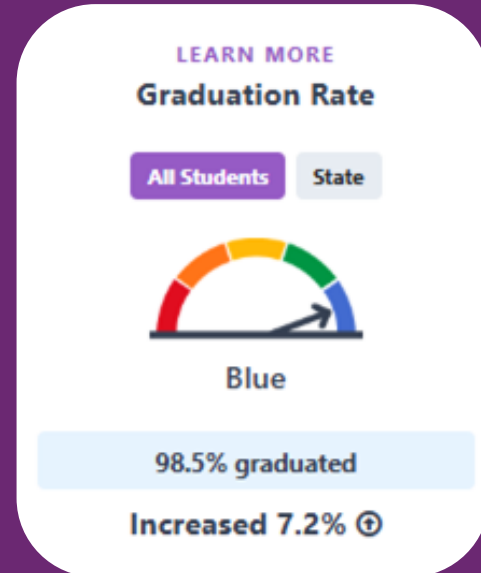

2024 Career & College Indicator

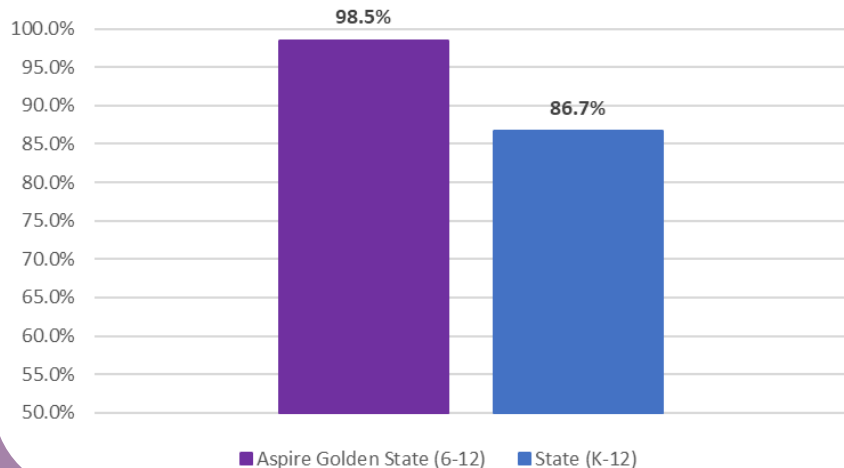




HIGHEST GRADUATION RATE IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND



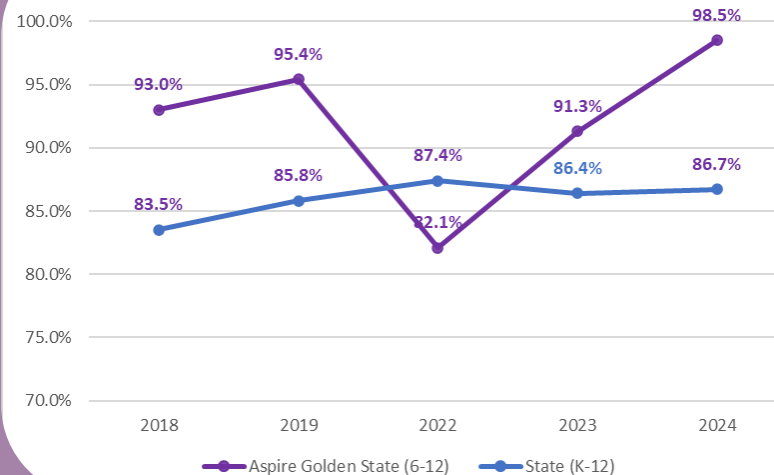
2024 Dashboard Graduation Rate

Dashboard Graduation Rate Over Time

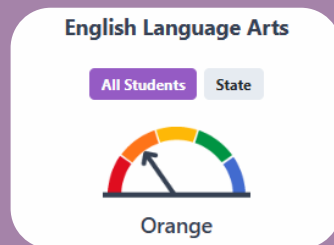

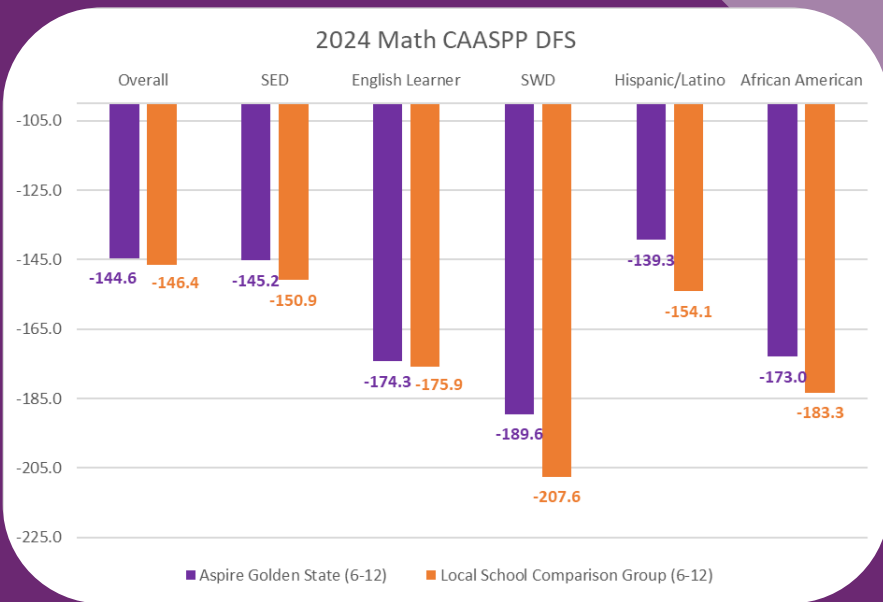

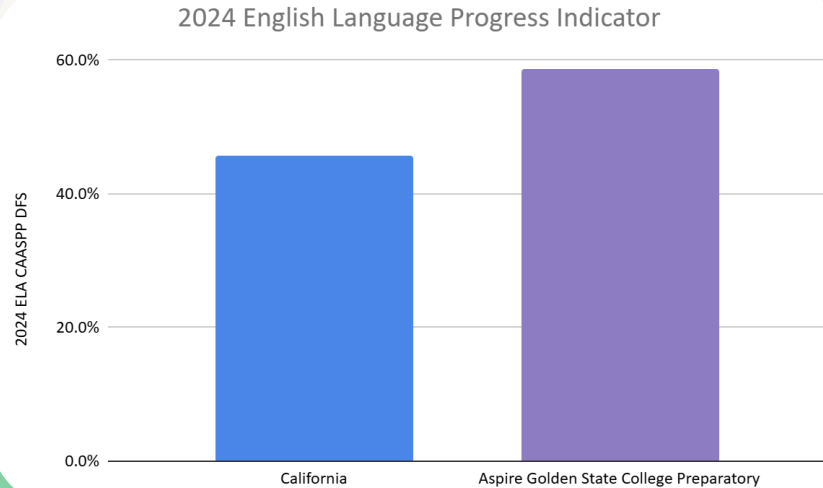
