Montclair Elementary School is an addition to a campus originally containing a 1940's school building, auditorium, and a variety of temporary structures arranged around an asphalt playground. The new L-shaped structure replaces most of the temporary structures and contains a 2-story classroom wing attached to a multipurpose building. Large portions of the asphalt playground were replaced with terraced planting and community gardens. The resultant "building in a garden" provides spaces that communicate with the outdoors; gives ample access to light, air and views; and weaves nature into the curriculum.
