SUBJECT: Application for One (1) Preliminary Education Specialist Teaching Credential

ACTION REQUESTED

Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1213-0181, recommending approval for One (1) Preliminary Education Specialist Teaching Credential.

BACKGROUND

The District Intern Certificate Program was enacted in 1983 under a major education reform law. This statute created an alternative route into teaching through District developed and administered teaching internships. Santiago Bustamante was a participant in the Oakland Practitioner Teacher Program (OPTP), which formerly was the Oakland Unified School District's District Internship Program designed specifically for teachers selected and recruited by the former Oakland Teaching Fellows and similar programs to teach in Mild/Moderate and Moderate/Severe special education settings. The program structure, prepared teachers to increase student achievement and to succeed in high-need schools in the Oakland Unified School District. The program was developed to create a credentialing program aligned with the needs of first-year special education teachers in high need schools. Mr. Bustamante has now completed all requirements under California Education Code 44328. District Internship Program credentials must be approved by the school district's Governing Board. The Commission awards the Preliminary Credential to interns upon the recommendation from the school district's Governing Board.

DISCUSSION

One (1) individual has successfully completed the requirements under California Education Code 44328 and is being recommended for a Preliminary Education Specialist Teaching Credential, so he may continue working in the District for the 2013-2014 school year with the appropriate credential.

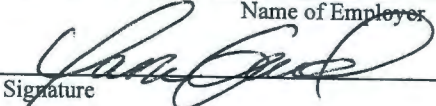

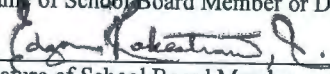
