

Subject: **Dedicating an Easement to the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District at the Ascend Elementary School Site.**

ACTION REQUESTED

Public Hearing and Adoption by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 1415-0132, Dedicating an Easement to the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District at the Ascend Elementary School Site.

BACKGROUND

The Oakland Unified School District (“District”) owns real property located at 3709 E. 12th Street, Oakland, CA 94601, commonly known as Ascend Elementary School (“School Site”). The San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District, a California rapid transit district (“BART”), intends to retrofit the original BART transit system to withstand major seismic events in the City of Oakland as part of its Earthquake Safety Program, including improving the foundation underlying the piers supporting the aerial structures. The School Site is within BART’s Earthquake Safety Program area. BART desires to purchase from the District a temporary construction easement for certain portions over, through and on the School Site for \$14,460. Although the proposed Easement is for a period of fourteen (14) months between June 2015 and August 2016, possession and use of the temporary easement area is anticipated to be required for a period of three (3) months within the said fourteen (14) month period. The District does not need the Easement area for classroom buildings or educational purposes. The District’s Governing Board adopted Resolution No. 1415-0097, by two-thirds of its members, on November 19, 2014, declaring its intent at the December 10, 2014 Regular Meeting to grant the requested easement.

Today, pursuant to law, the Board is required to hold a Public Hearing to receive comments, including any objections, regarding the proposed granting of said easement, and then to determine whether to (or not to) grant the requested easement.

FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact or implications associated with the approval of these documents.

**DEDICATING AN EASEMENT TO THE
SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA RAPID TRANSIT DISTRICT AT THE
ASCEND ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE**

WHEREAS, the Oakland Unified School District (“District”) owns real property located at 3709 E. 12th Street, Oakland, CA 94601 (A.P.N.: 033-2159-001 through 004 and 033-2160-001 through 017), commonly known as Ascend Elementary School (“School Site”); and

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District, a California rapid transit district (“BART”), intends to retrofit the original BART transit system to withstand major seismic events in the City of Oakland as part of its Earthquake Safety Program, including improving the foundation underlying the piers supporting the aerial structures, and BART desires to purchase from the District for Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty dollars (\$14,460) a temporary construction easement for certain portions over, through and on the real property owned by the District, as identified in Exhibit “A” attached hereto, as the School Site is within BART’s Earthquake Safety Program area; and

WHEREAS, the District seeks to dedicate that certain area of the School Site to BART in the form of a temporary construction easement for its Earthquake Safety Program at the School Site (“Easement”), as set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, although the Easement is for a period of fourteen (14) months between June 2015 and August 2016, possession and use of the temporary easement area is anticipated to be required for a period of three (3) months within the said fourteen (14) month period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17556 *et seq.*, the District may dedicate the Easement at the School Site to BART for access, construction and implementation of its Earthquake Safety Program at the School Site; and

WHEREAS, the District does not need the Easement area for classroom buildings or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17557, on November 19, 2014, by two-thirds vote, the District’s Board of Education (“Board”) adopted Resolution No. 1415-0097 entitled “A Resolution of the Governing Board of the Oakland Unified School District Declaring Its Intention to Dedicate an Easement to the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District at the Ascend Elementary School Site”; and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2014, the District gave public notice of a public hearing to be held on December 10, 2014 in accordance with Education Code section 17558; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2014 the District held a public hearing on whether it should adopt this resolution to dedicate the Easement to BART.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board hereby finds, determines, declares, orders and resolves as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The District's Board of Education finds that there are no formal protests to the proposed dedication of the Easement.

Section 4. This resolution to dedicate the Easement is in accordance with the procedures of Title 1, Division 1, Part 10.5, Chapter 4, Article 15 of the Education Code and the Board hereby authorizes and directs Superintendent or Superintendent's designee to execute the Easement dedicating the Easement to BART and to deliver it.





Grantee shall give Grantor at least 30 days advance written notice prior to entry and shall restore the surface of the easement area if damaged during construction.

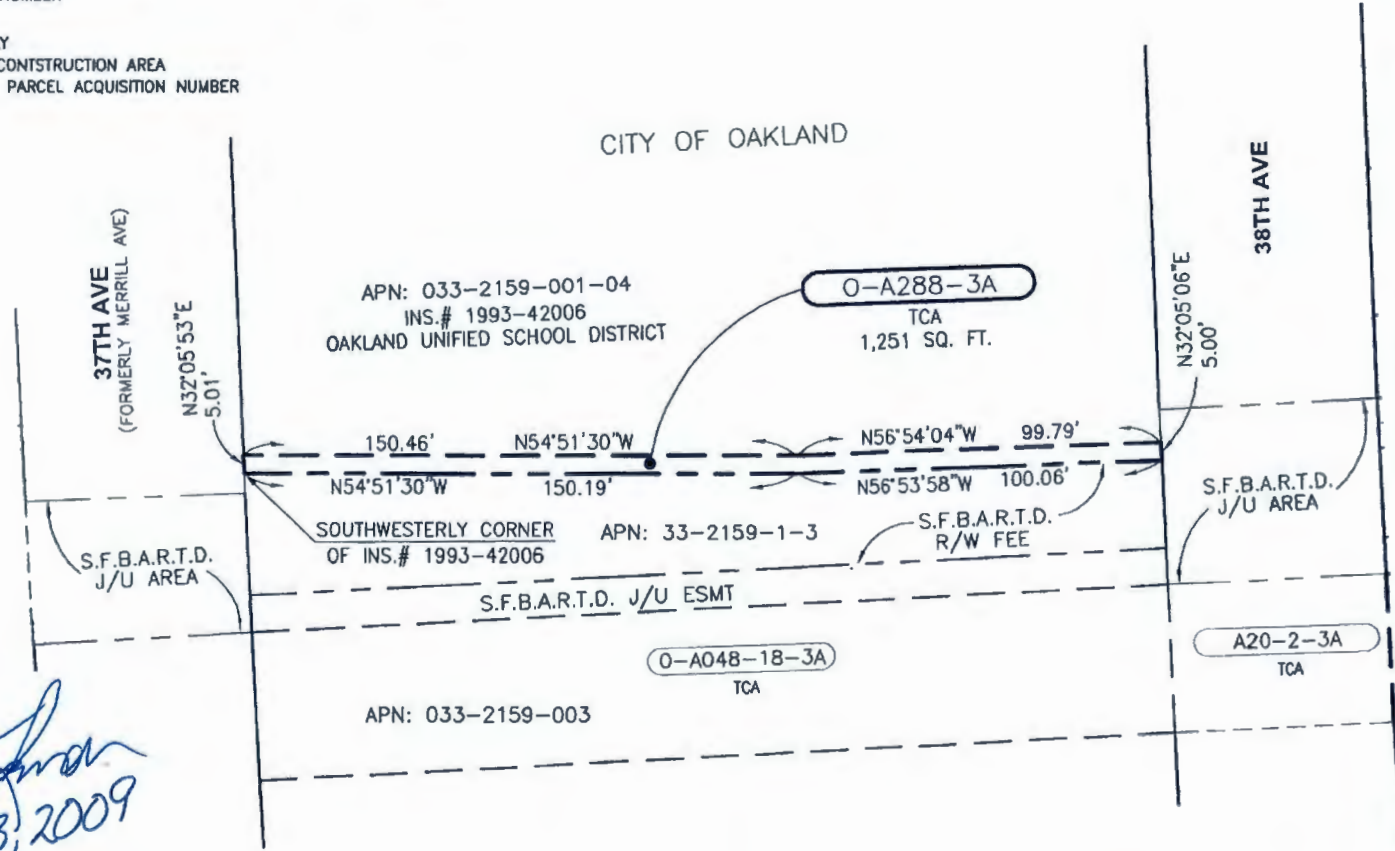

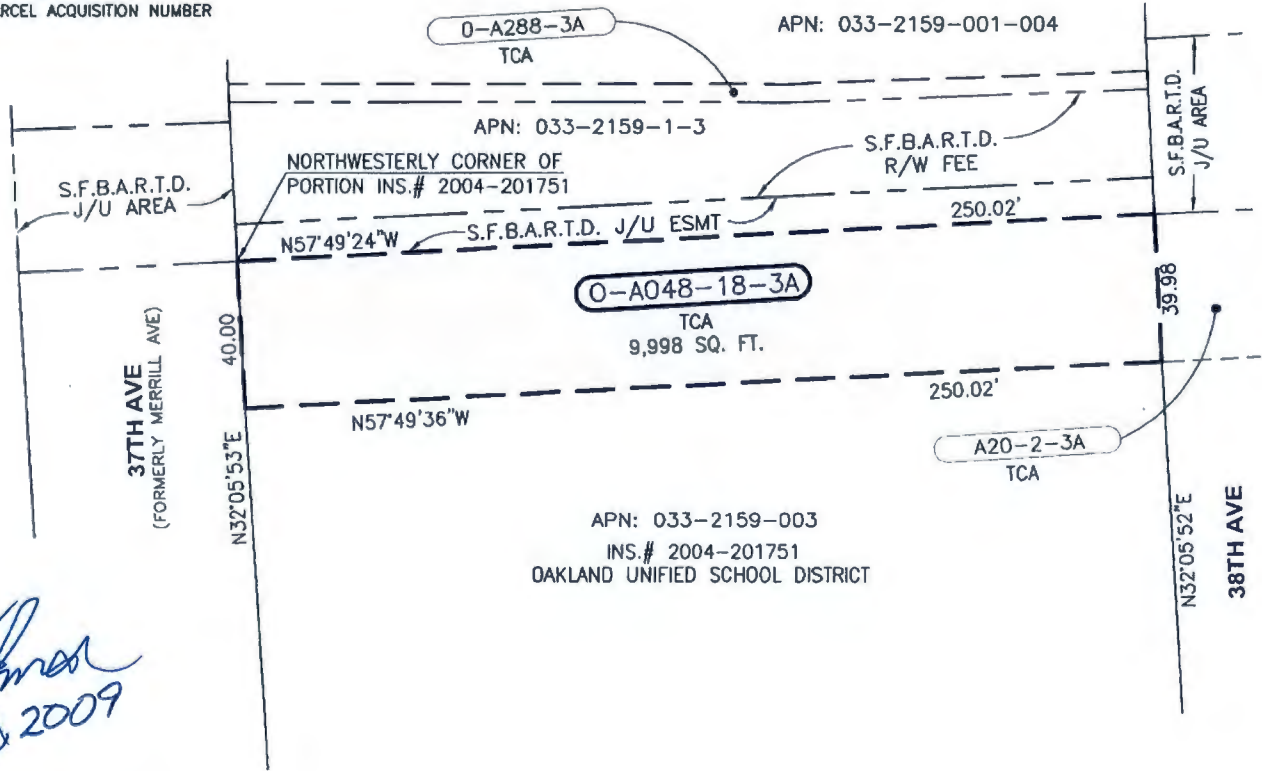

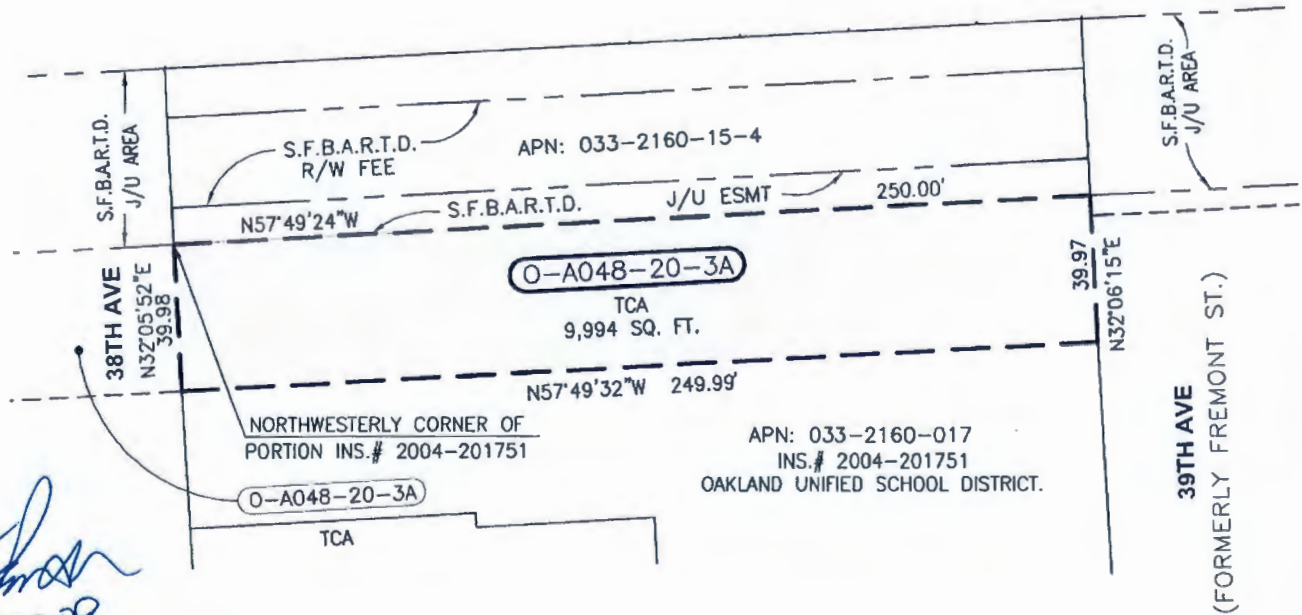

WHEREAS, the District does not need the Easement area for classroom buildings or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the District may dedicate or convey the Easement if, after adoption of this Resolution of Intent and publication of notice, the District’s Governing Board adopts, in a regular open meeting (“Public Hearing”), by a two-thirds vote of all its members, a resolution authorizing and directing the Superintendent, or Superintendent’s designee, to execute and deliver the Easement; and

WHEREAS, notice of the Governing Board’s intent to dedicate the Easement (“Notice”) shall be given pursuant to Education Code section 17558 by posting copies of this Resolution of Intent signed by the members of the Governing Board, or majority thereof, in three (3) public places in

the District not less than ten (10) days before the date of the Public Hearing, and by publishing the Notice once not less than five (5) days before the date of the Public Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the District, if there is one, or if there is no such newspaper published in the District, then in an newspaper published in the county in which the District or any part thereof is situated and having a general circulation in the District; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing shall be held on December 10, 2014, at 4:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in the Great Room located at the La Escuelita Education Center located at 1050 2nd Avenue, Oakland, CA 94606-2291.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District's Governing Board hereby finds, determines, declares, orders and resolves as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The real property upon which the Easement is to be located is not needed for school classroom buildings or educational purposes.

Section 3. The District intends to dedicate or convey the Easement.

Section 4. The Superintendent and Superintendent's designee is hereby authorized to provide public notice as required by Education Code section 17588.

Section 5. The District's Governing Board shall hold a public hearing on December 10, 2014, at 4:00 p.m., at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard and shall consider authorizing the dedication and conveyance of the Easement from the District to BART in accordance with the Easement attached hereto as Exhibit "A".



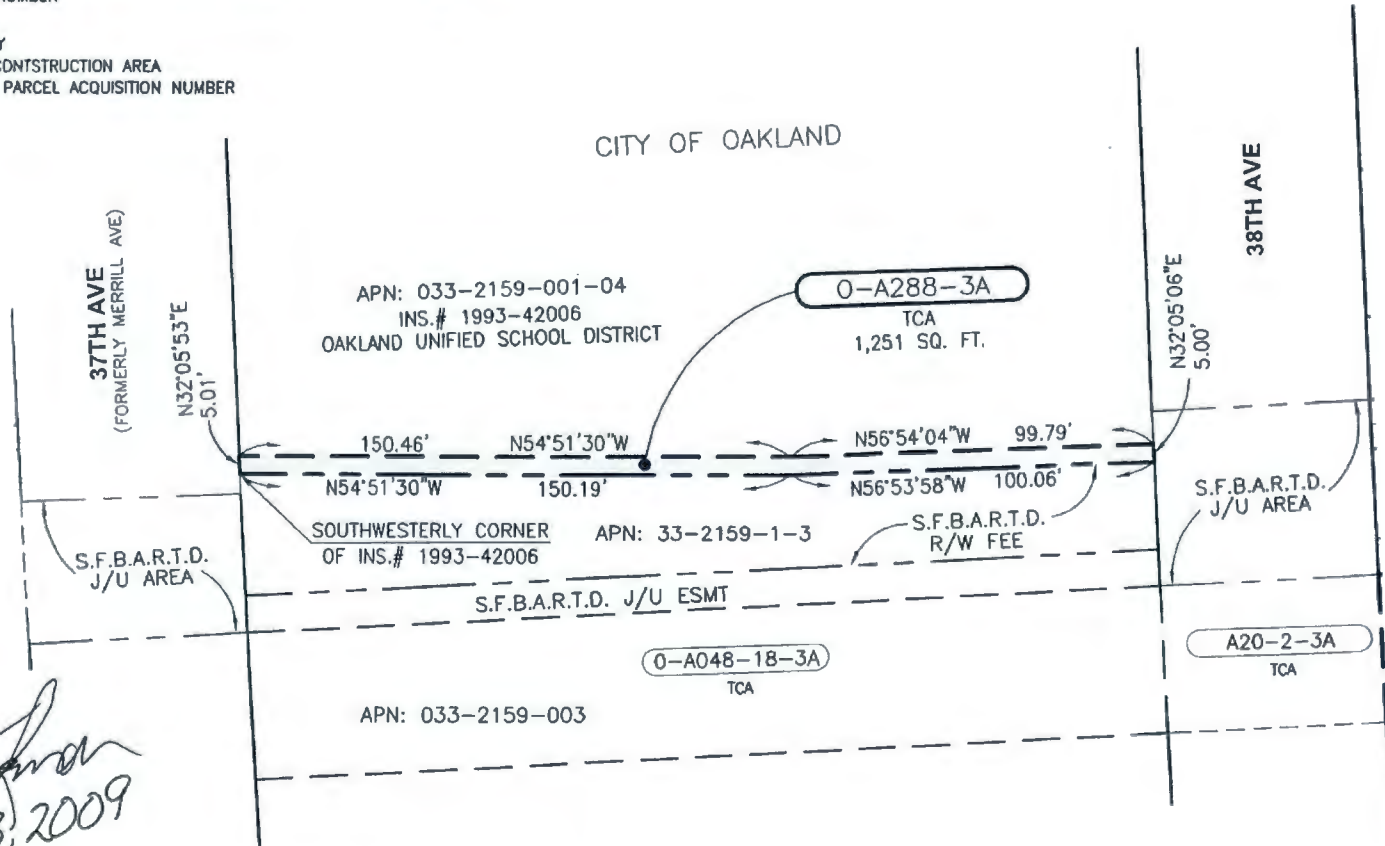

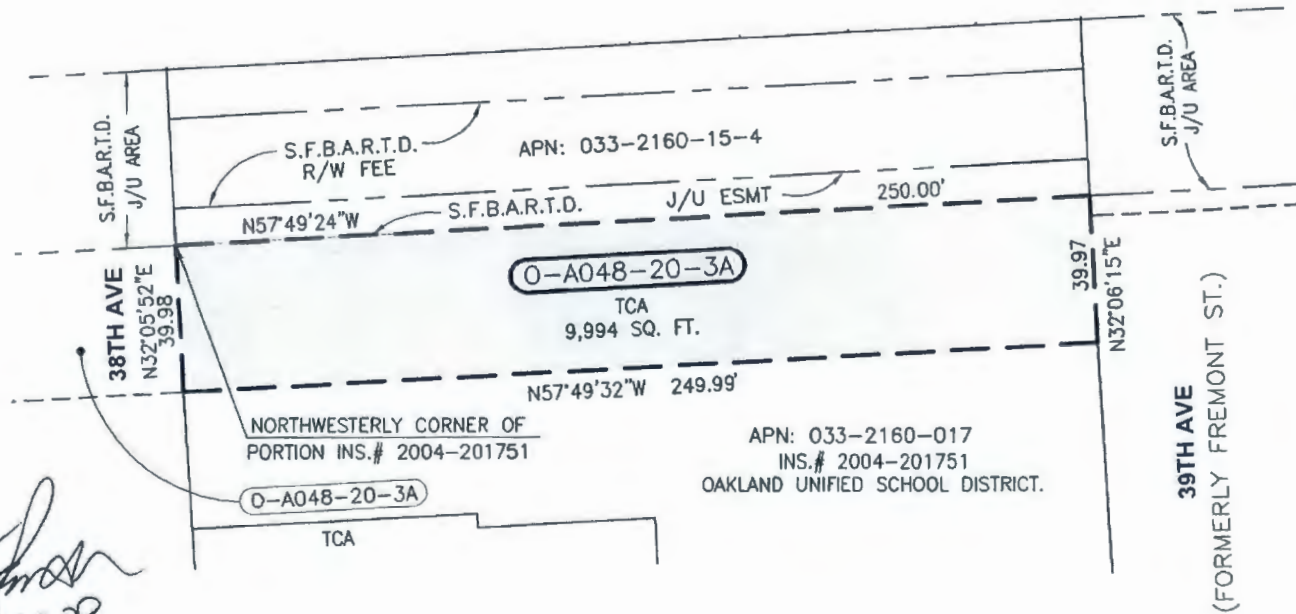
