**Background &**Due to COVID-19, all voters received a vote-by-mail ballot. However,

physical spaces were needed to serve as accessible voting locations.

physical spaces were needed to serve as accessible voting locations rather than a traditional polling place. Any voter in Alameda County could vote at the voting locations. For November 2020 General Election, voting at the voting location occurred over 4 days rather than just on Election Day. Ten OUSD schools served as accessible voting

locations, with Prescott School being one of them.

**Fiscal Impact** Payment of \$200 to offset minor additional maintenance costs.
