<b>Ask of the Board</b>	Adoption by the Board of Education of Resolution No. 2526-0029 - Career Technical Education Advisory Committee: Number of Members Eleven and Naming Said Members/Terms Thereof.
<b>Background</b>	<p>Perkins Funds provides support to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) in support of development of Career Technical Educational Programs. The Oakland Unified School District received approximately \$520,864.00 for the 2025-2026 School Year from this program to support its CTE Programs.</p> <p>Education Code Section 8070 requires the governing board of a school district participating in a career technical education program to appoint an Advisory Committee, of stakeholders, to develop recommendations on the program and to provide liaison between the district and potential employers.</p> <p>The Board of Education, most recently, on November 13, 2024, adopted Resolution No. 2425-0188 Career Technical Education Advisory Committee: Number of Members Fifteen and Naming Said Members/Terms Thereof, establishing a fifteen (15) member Committee and naming persons thereto. A fifteen (15) member Committee, in hindsight, is more than adequate for the purposes. Accordingly, the Board is requested to adopt Resolution No. 2526- 0029 Career Technical Education Advisory Committee: Number of Members Eleven and Naming Said Members/Terms Thereof, superseding Resolution No. 2425-0188 (Legislative File No. 24-2825, Enactment No. 24-2099, November 13, 2024), retroactive to July 1, 2025.</p>

**Career Technical Education Advisory Committee: Number of

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress passed the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act - *Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act* (“Perkins V”) to provide federal funding of Career Technical Education (“CTE”) programs; and

**WHEREAS**, *Perkins V* requires all eligible recipients of *Perkins V* funds to complete a Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (“CLNA”), incorporating input from a diverse group of stakeholders, the results of which CLNA must be included in the application for funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Education Code Section 8070 requires that the governing board of each school district participating in a CTE program appoint a CTE advisory committee to develop recommendations on the program and to serve as a liaison between the district and potential employers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education, on November 13, 2024, adopted Resolution No. 2425-0188 - Career Technical Education Advisory Committee: Number of Members Fifteen and Naming Said Members/Terms Thereof; and,

**WHEREAS**, in hindsight, a fifteen (15) person membership is more than needed for the establishment of the required Career Technical Education Advisory Committee,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Education hereby adopts this Resolution, establishing and appointing a Career Technical Education Advisory Committee, pursuant to Education Code Section 8070, composed of eleven (11) members, retroactive to July 1, 2025, and appointing an incumbent person named or a first time appointee to a vacancy, as named in Exhibit A, attached, to said Committee for the term stated; and,
