Director VanCendric Williams and Director Mike Hutchinson, co-sponsors of the legislation, made the presentation. Board members and the Superintendent generally agreed that the positive academic outcomes for African-American and Brown students in the District are unsatisfactory. Board Members, and the Superintendent, spent approximately one hour and fifteen minutes debating general elements of the proposal, some expressing the opinion that the new proposal replicates work already being done by the Strategic Plan and City Wide Plan; questioned the lack of detailed costs, while the proponents argued that the proposal is a statement of values, moral values to address the historic and on-going under achievement of Black and Brown students and that all elements of the proposal are necessary to address and correct the educational disparity of said students. Near the end of the debate, the authors - Williams and Hutchinson - having heard the statements of their colleagues, and the Superintendent, agreed to pare down the proposal and bring it back for further consideration at a Time Certain, February 24, 2021, formally agreed to by Board adoption of Legislative File 21-0513, Enactment No. 21-0500.




