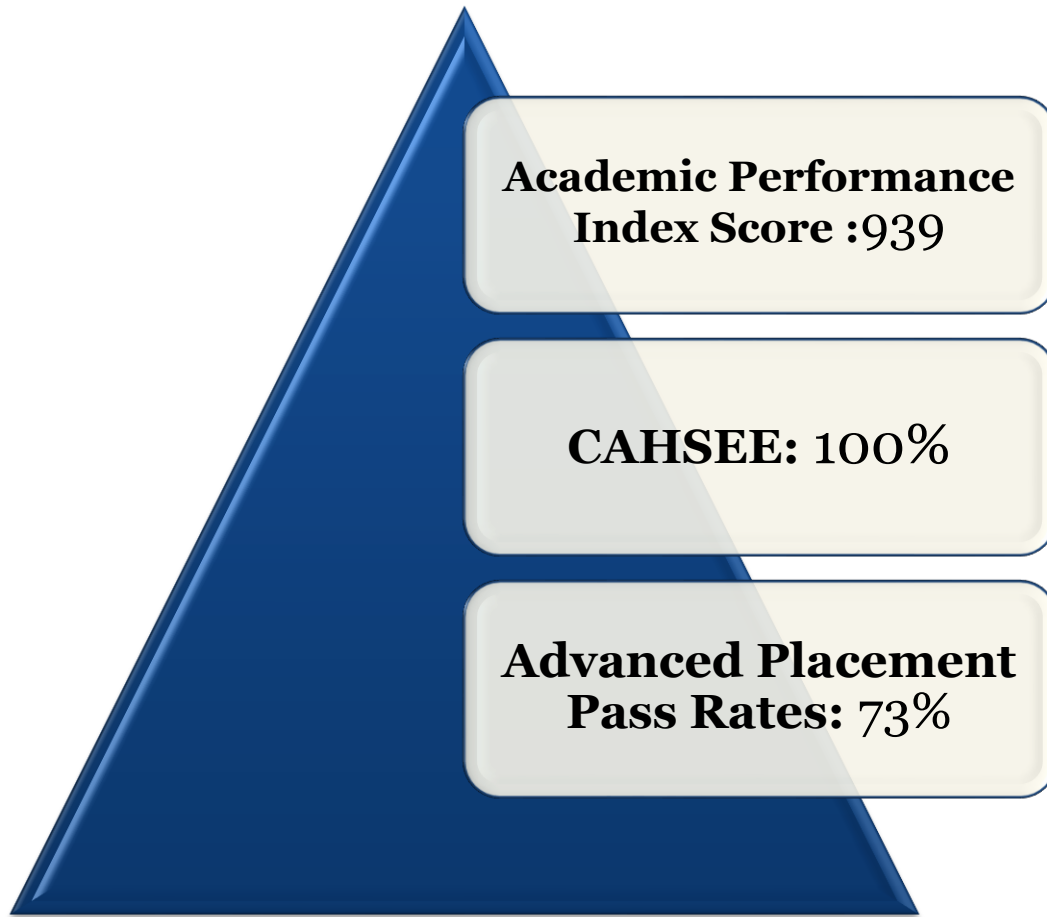
Campus Overview

- OCHS Became the highest performing high school in 2009 with a 955 API
- Early College Program begins in 2008
- OCHS begins sports program in 2009 (BACSAC League) – Boys soccer go undefeated 7-0 in league play 2011
- 100% of student body takes SAT w/ Prep courses.

- 100% College acceptance rate (2010)
- OCHS Received a 3 year WASC Accreditation in 2010.
- Number of AP course offerings have grown every year.
- OCHS is a member school of the National Honor Society
