Other Specialized Services

Specialized Services Option A: In-school Academic Assistance

Academic reading and math assistance provided by trained tutors throughout entire school year.

- 1a. Academic support will be focused on increasing English proficiency of limited English proficient children by providing high quality language instruction and educational tutoring.
- 2a. Academic support will be focused on providing assistance to low achieving students.

Cost: \$23,000 for daily sessions throughout the school year; service for up to 20 youth per tutor.

Specialized Services Option D: Operational and Programmatic Support

Additional year-long administrative and program support to ensure seamless delivery of services and strong program operations.

Cost: \$21,000 for daily assistance from throughout the school year.
