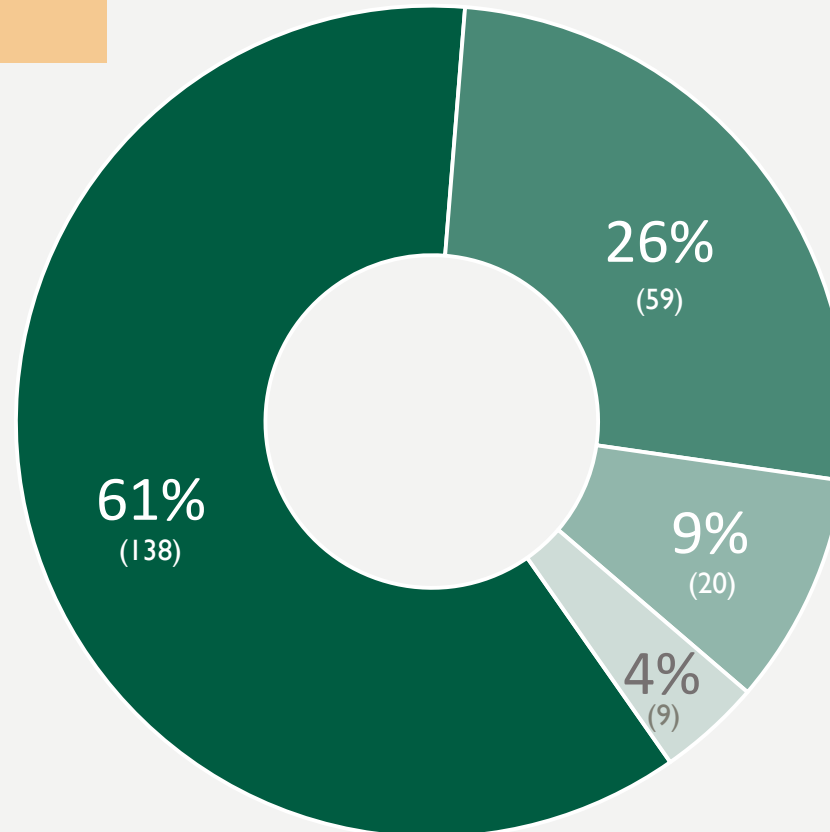

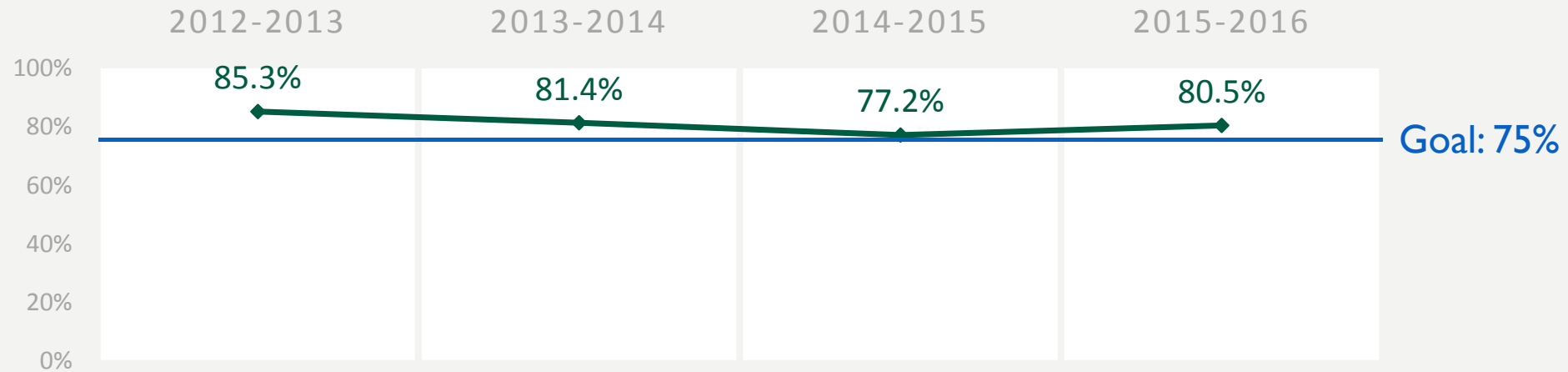

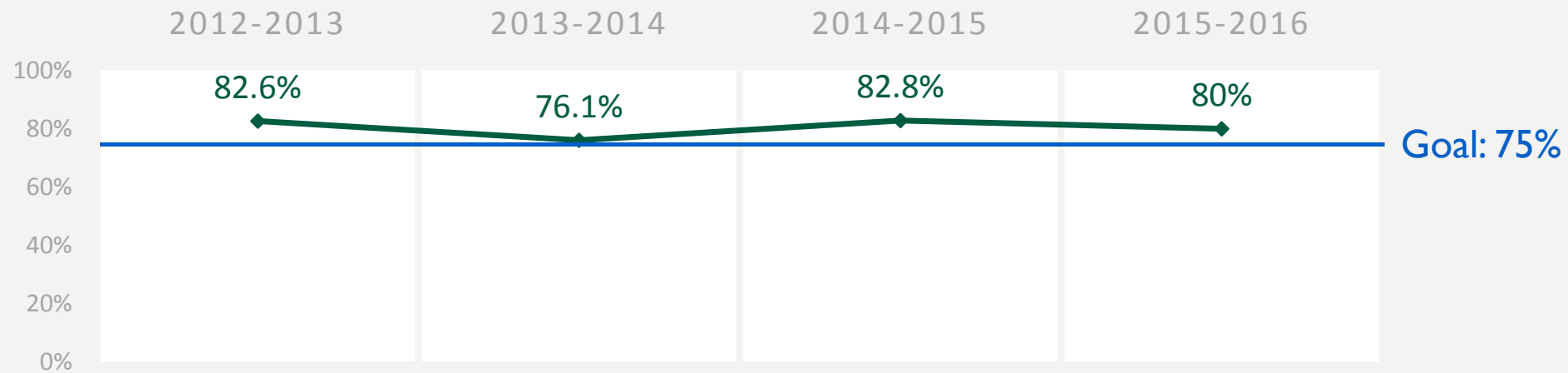

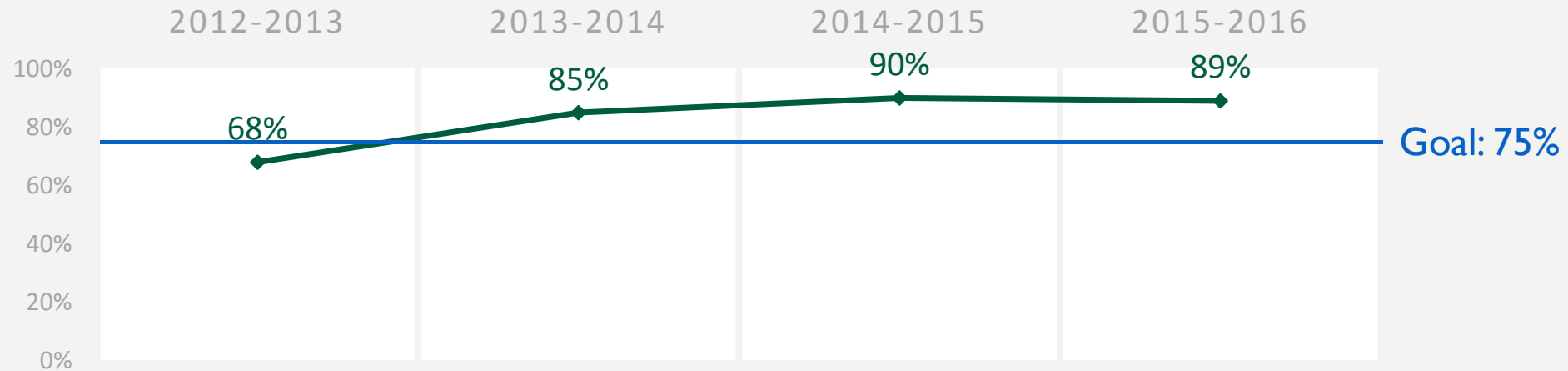


ACADEMIC GROWTH READING (2015-16) – STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT SUBGROUPS

ACADEMIC GROWTH MATH



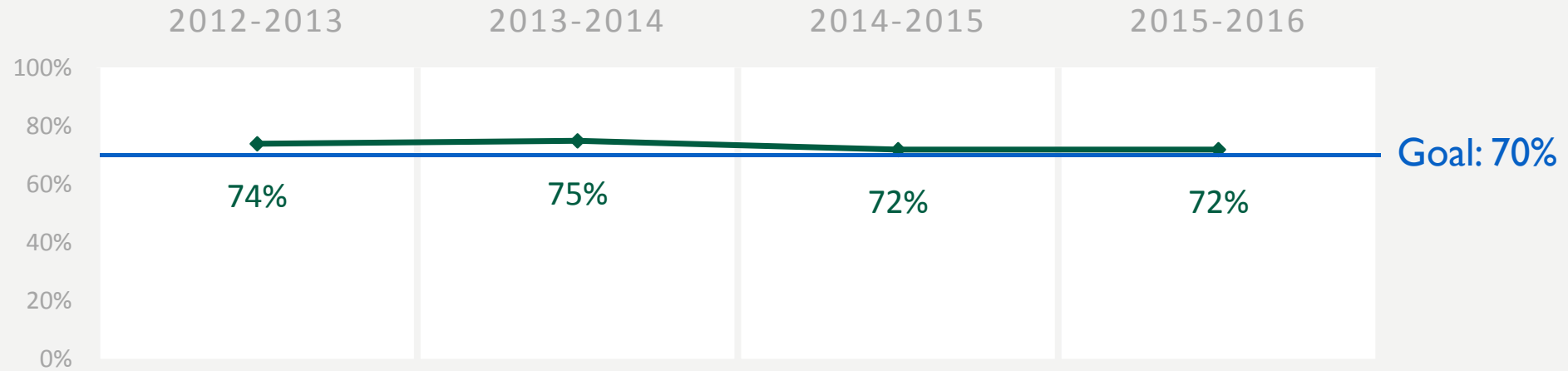
ACADEMIC GROWTH MATH (2015-16)

STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT SUBGROUPS



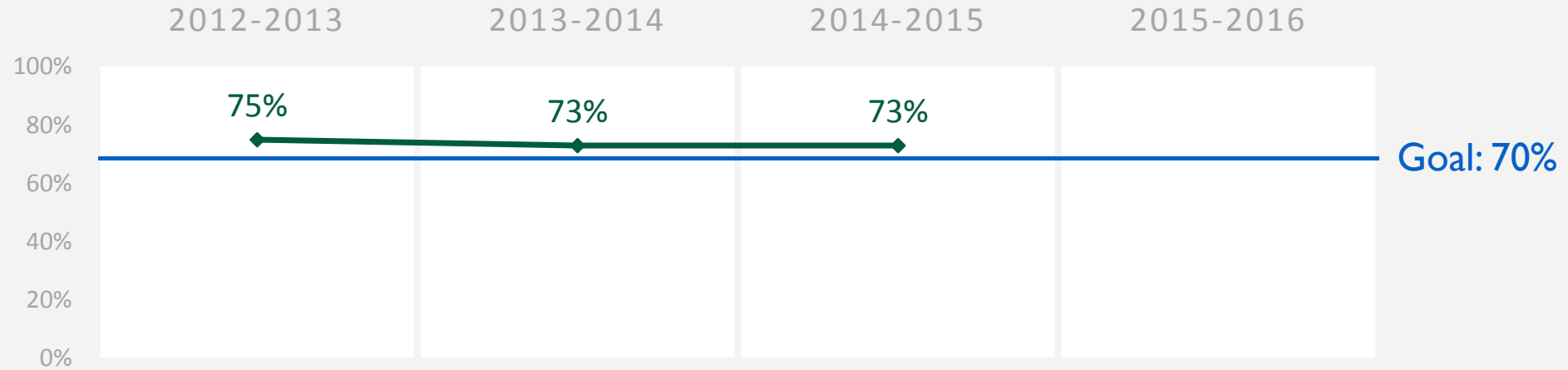
