Action Requested Conduct a Public Hearing on the BCTC initial proposals (attached) for a full Successor Agreement, effective July 1, 2014.

Background Pursuant to Section 3547 of the Educational Employment Relations Act, before representatives of the BCTC and the District may begin negotiations for a new Agreement, the parties are required to present their initial proposals for public review and comments ("sunshining") on the proposals.


