Program activities include ice breakers, moderate hiking, social and emotional learning activities (journaling, mindfulness, cultural discussions) and warm-up and cool-down exercises.

Her Footprints participants will be 6th or 7th grade girls from Frick Academy in good academic standing (2.5 GPA by December 2014 and positive progress reports). To be accepted into Her Footprints hiking program, interested students will complete a short application process.

Based on discussions Frick Academy (the OUSD site for Her Footprints) and a review of their goals, we expect the following outcomes during the 2017-18 school year:

- Conduct at least 8 monthly hikes in the San Francisco Bay Area, between October 2017 and June 2018 with 6th grade girls from Frick Academy students.
- By June 2018, at least 60% of Her Footprints participants have attended at least 5 monthly hikes.
- By June 2018, 60% of participating girls will report being comfortable trying new things.
- By June 2018, 80% of participants will report increased leadership skills.
- By June 2018, all girls participating in Her Footprints will have a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- By June 2018, all girls participating in Her Footprints will move on to the next grade level.
- By June 2018, all girls participating in Her Footprints will have 75% fewer behavioral issues (outof-school suspensions, detention) compared to 6th grade girls not participating in Her Footprints.
- By June 2018, all girls participating in Her Footprints will have 80% fewer chronically absences compared to 6th grade girls not participating in Her Footprints.
